1. Release 3.2.0

- Now the package creator feature uses the domain name from the http context to generate the Profile3.xml inside the installer package
- We have removed the ip validations to allow domain names to be configured in each server config (axl, cucm, ldap)
- We have fixed the axl and cucm validation from configuration section.
- Fixed problem with dial rules when digits to remove is equals to 0.
- We have improved the user experience removing the SHA key in sftp configurations.
- We have improved the user experience removing the “Update Available” link in About page.
- We have improved the user experience adding a new cleaner process to clean calls older than certain amount of time
- We have improved the user experience adding a new way of synching the web console up.
- We have improved the previous sync process.
- We have improve the user experience with a new tool to increase the server log level.
- We have added a new level of configuration flexibility allowing the groups to be configured with voice mail configurations, partitions and queued services.
- We have added a cucm and axl server failover policy compatible with desktop console operator.
- We have improved the user experience displaying the extension in operators list and view.
- We have fixed several usability issues.
- We have fixed reporting issues.
- We have migrated our installer to be x64 compatible.



Known Issues: the validation of configurations tied to axl and cucm is not working at update time
