We provide a solution to allow you to download Amazon pricing information to your phone, so you can check any item's market price super fast without an Internet connection. This allows you to scout (find valuable items to resell later) any time and anywhere. It will tremendously save you several hours in scouting every month and allow you to compete in any major sales event.

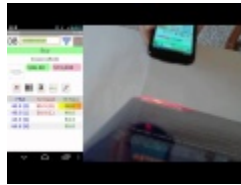

You also need a barcode scanner to allow you to quickly enter item's number directly into FBAScan app or ASellerTool software, so you can **check one item in less than a second**.

MWS Limitations on FBA/Used/New Price Display for Database Search

Issue:

Database search is missing some FBA offers or used/new prices are not continuous (missing one or more prices in between)

Explanation:

Amazon MWS program sorts the lowest 20 used and lowest 20 new prices into different groups based on the condition, seller rating and fulfillment channel, and only returns the lowest price from each group (not complete 20 prices) to our scouting app. This imposes **some limitations to display complete and continuous prices** on our app. This same limitation apply to any other scouting vendors.

- The program will not be able to display used FBA price if it is higher than the 20th used price, or new FBA price if it is higher than the 20th new price.
- The program will not be able to always display continuous prices, but will return lowest used and new price. This is due to Amazon only return lowest price from each group after it sorts the lowest 20 prices into different group.

✿ Use live search for more research: FBAScan app will be able to return lowest used FBA price and lowest new FBA price when you do live search on this item. FBAScan app will also return continuous used and new prices after live search.

✿ See complete FBA offers: If you still do not see enough FBA offers after database and live search, you can tap the FBA column header to open the Amazon FBA Offers page to see the complete list of FBA offers. You can also enable 'Auto Show FBA Offers Page' in Menu -> [Settings](#) to automatically open this page after each scan.

FBAScan for Android

FBAScan is an app running on your Android phone. It allows you to check any item's Amazon pricing information from an offline database. This offline database search does not require an Internet connection, so you can check one item every second. Optionally you can also search live on Amazon US, Canada, other European countries, and sites like eBay, Google, Bookscout, CamelCamelCamel.

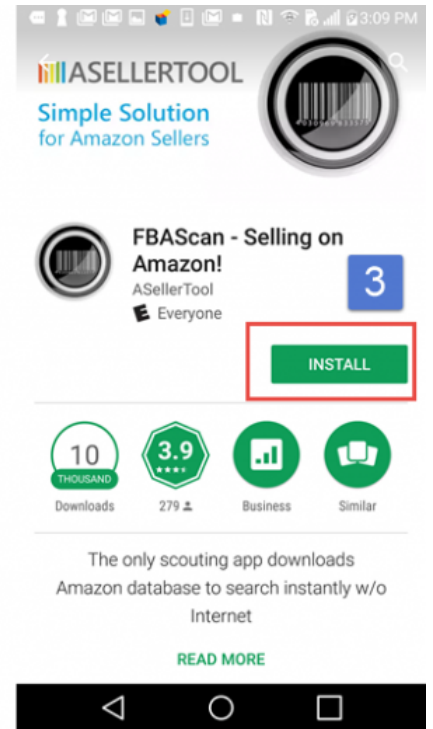
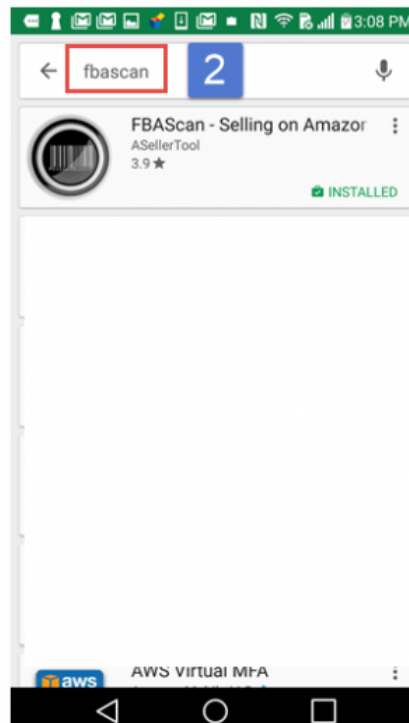
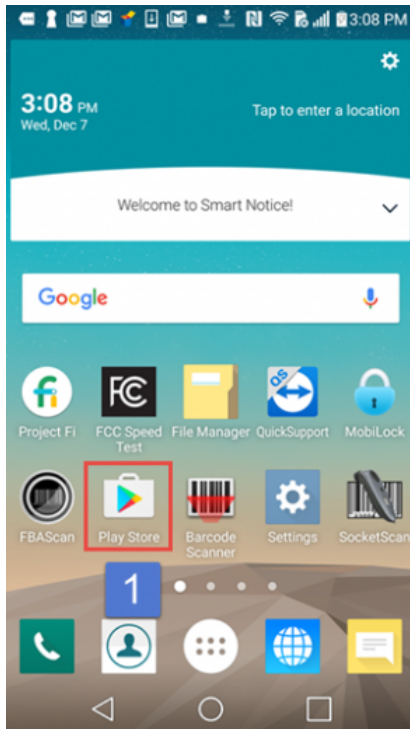
Socket 7Ci or 8Ci scanner allows you to enter item's number much more quickly into FBAScan app. Socket scanner and offline database will dramatically cut down your scouting time, so you can hit more places or spend less time to scout.

When FBAScan starts, you tap **Not registered yet? Sign up here** at the top of the account screen, and enter a User ID, e-mail address, and the country for Amazon marketplace pricing. After tapping the **Register** button, you will receive a confirmation email with instructions on activating the service. Please follow that email carefully.

When FBAScan starts, you can enter your existing user ID, password and email in the account screen. If you forget your user ID, or password, you can click [here](#). You can check your account status by tapping **Check** button on the screen.

✿ **Canadian Users:** If you want to see live pricing information from Amazon Canada, you need to **sign up your MWS account** with ASellerTool [here](#). After sign up your MWS account, you can then select Canada from the country list in the account screen. FBAScan will return Amazon CA pricing information.

✿ **European Users:** If you want to see live pricing information from Amazon UK, Germany and other European countries, you need to **sign up your MWS account** with ASellerTool [here](#). After sign up your MWS account, you can then select an European country from the country list in the account screen. FBAScan will return Amazon pricing information from your selected country.

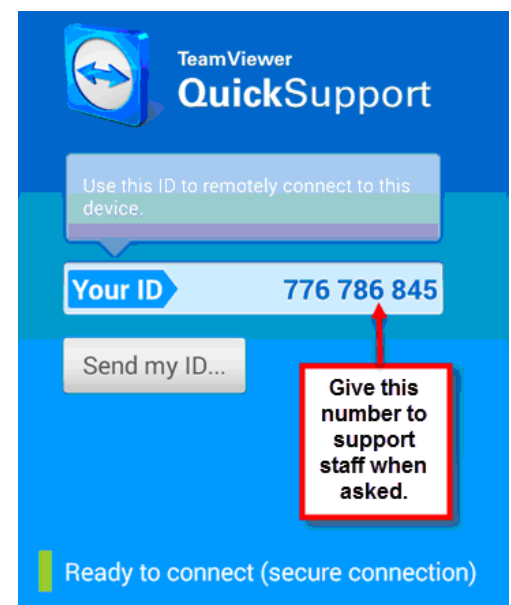
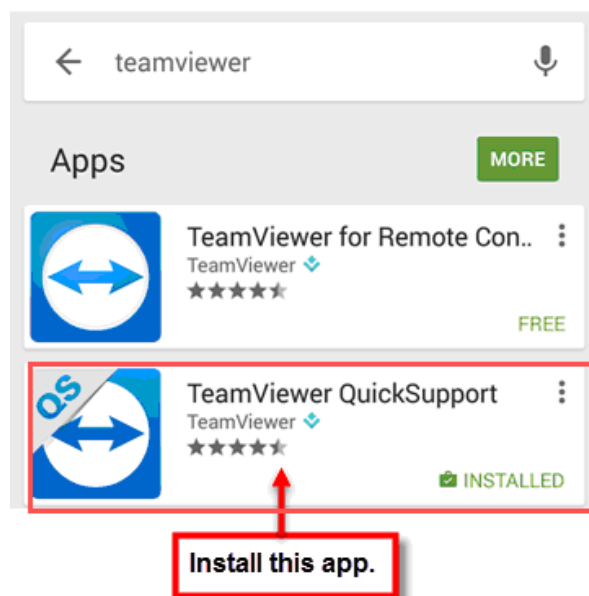

Number/Title Entry

You can enter ISBN/UPC numbers with an external barcode scanner, camera, or the numpad. You can enter a title or ASIN with the standard keyboard.

Bluetooth Barcode Scanner (Recommended)

We recommend using an external Bluetooth barcode scanner to enter a number instantly. Buying a Bluetooth scanner is a very good investment that will save you time and effort tremendously.

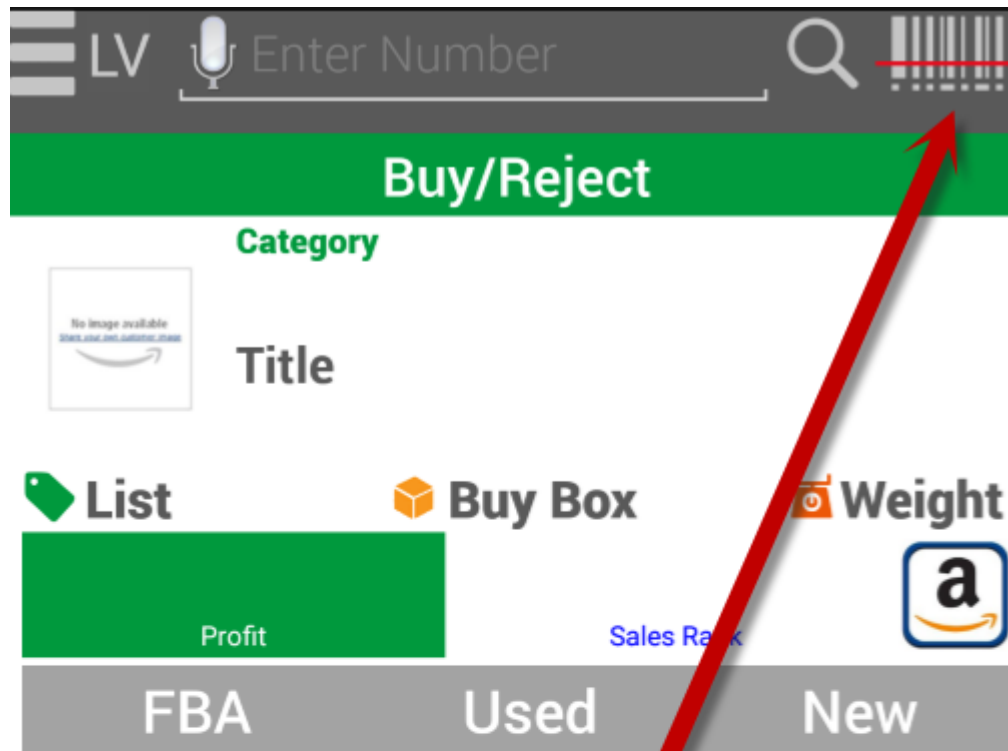

Camera (Not Recommended)

You can tap the barcode symbol, or shake the phone (enable in Menu -> Settings -> Shake to Open Camera) to launch the phone's camera to capture a barcode. The camera is much slower compared to using a scanner and consume your phone's battery very quickly.

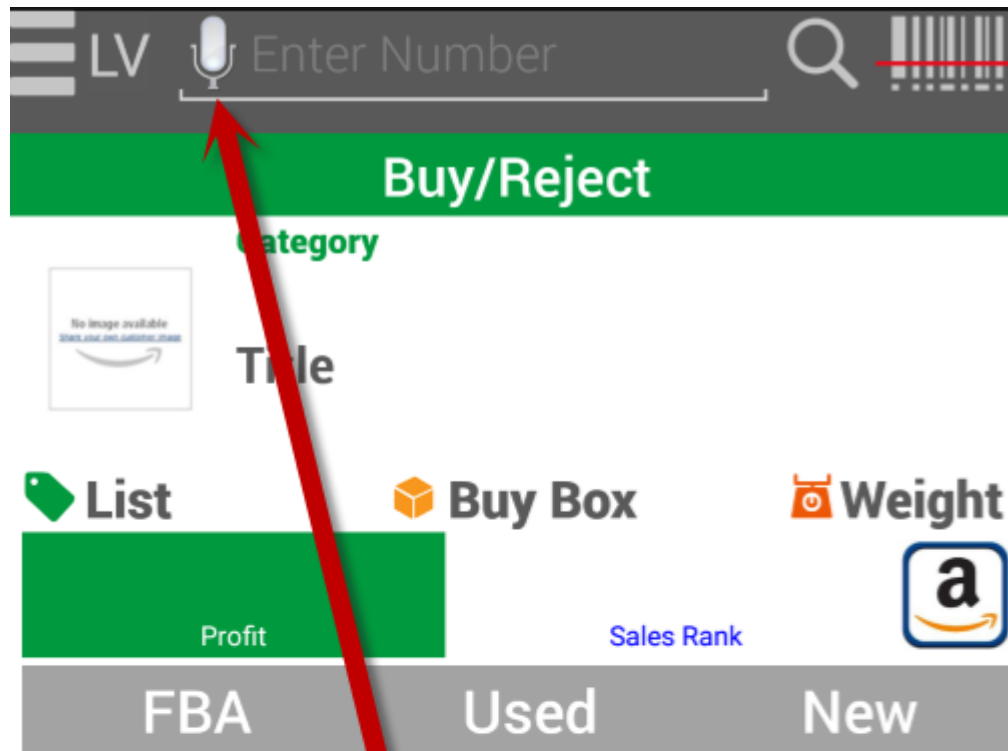

To search for titles via voice, tap the microphone icon.

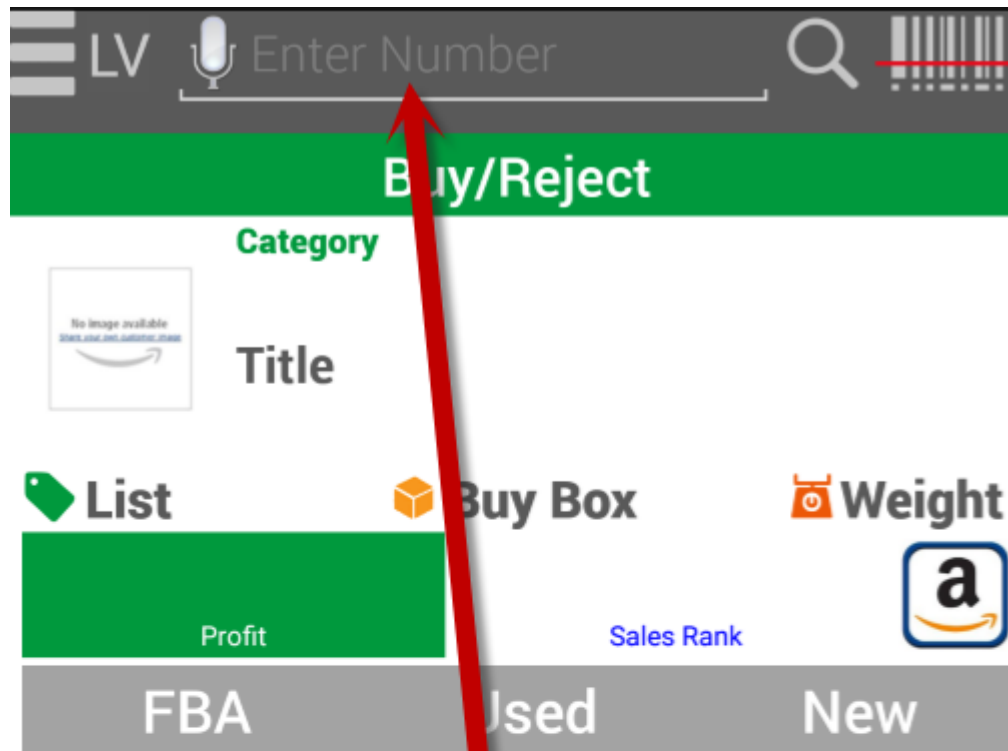


**Tap here to speak

Numpad

If an item does not have a barcode to scan, you can tap inside **Enter Number** to open the numpad. If the number ends with the letter X, you can skip it.

numpad to type a number**

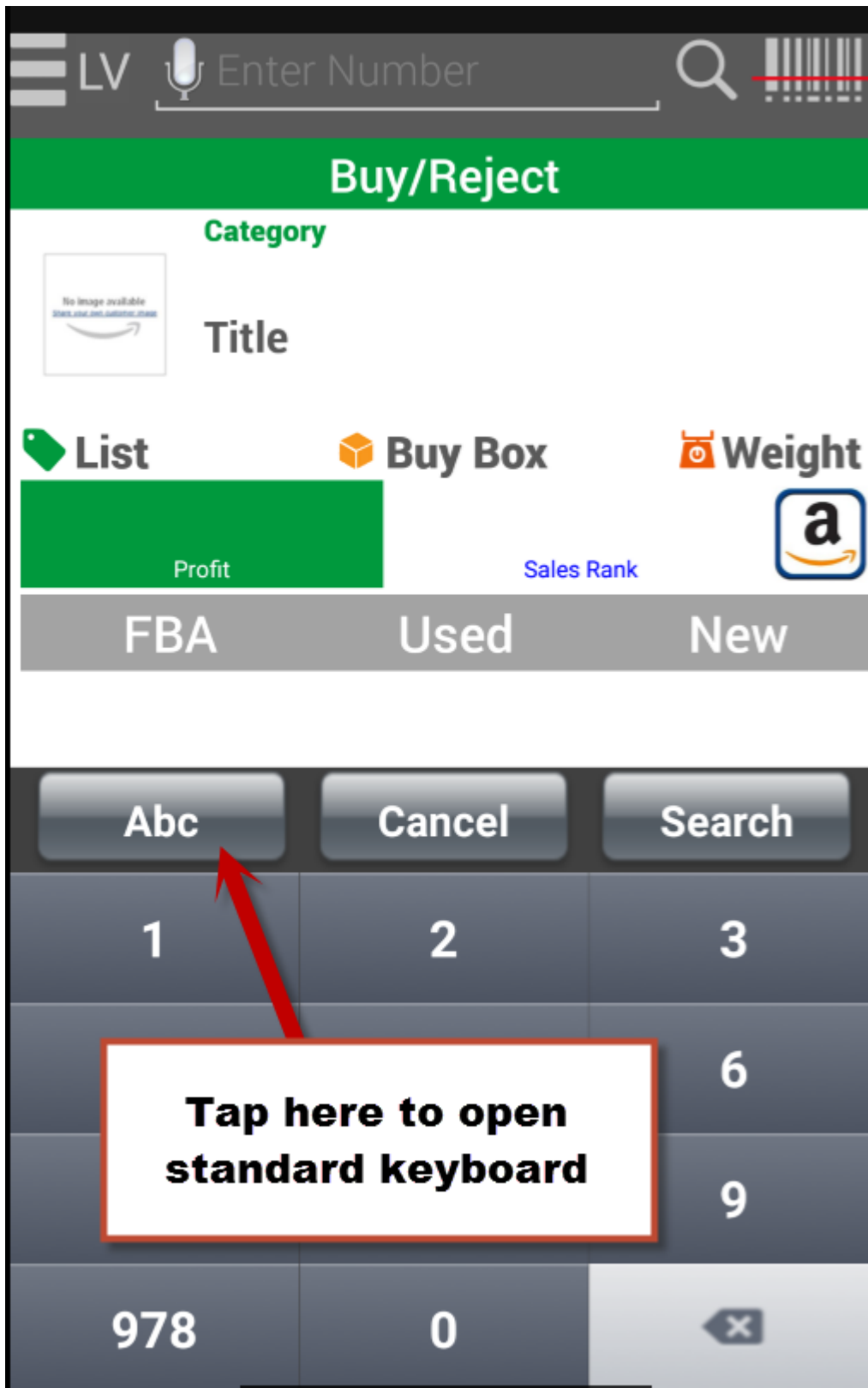


Standard Keyboard

To enter a title or ASIN, you tap **Abc** button on the numpad to open the standard keypad.



If you are connecting a Bluetooth scanner to your phone, you need to turn off the scanner before the standard keyboard can show up.

Operating Modes

FBAScan supports 4 operating modes to search items:

- **DB:** The program will only search from the local database on the phone. No Internet is required, so the result is returned instantly.
- **NF:** (Database + Live Search on Not Found item) If the item is not found in the local database, the program will automatically do a live search on all Amazon items.
- **MR:** (Database + Live Search on Not Found or Buy) If the item is not found or is signaled as 'Buy' based on the trigger (section 4.8 and 4.9), the program will automatically do a live search to get current information.
- **LV:** (Live Search Only) The program will always do a live search.

To set the Operating Mode:

1) Double tap the screen or the 'Menu' icon  on the top left of the screen to open the Menu.

2) Tap 'Operating Mode' from the Menu and select a mode from the list

You can also tap the magnifying glass icon  to do a live search on the current item.

If you mainly search for media items, we recommend setting the mode to 'DB' or 'NF'.

If you search for both media and non media items, we recommend setting the mode to 'NF'.

Optionally, you can use mode 'LV' to review the items you set aside before buying.

Main Screen

The screen shot above shows the number of offers next to conditions; this will only appear in DB mode, not live, and is included in the Live result shown for instructive purposes.

Explanation of the Main Screen:

A: 'Buy', 'Reject', or a custom message based on the trigger ([Basic Triggers](#) or [Advanced Triggers](#)).








B: Category.

C: Product image. You can tap the image to go to the Amazon product page.

D: List Price (MSRP).

E: The Profit based on the current selected price. You can tap on this box to display a detailed breakdown of the profit calculation.

F: FBA prices, conditions, and number of offers in this group are displayed in this column. You can tap 'FBA' to go to the Amazon FBA offers page.







- * Conditions are shown as follows:
-  : New (N)
 -  : Acceptable (A)
 -  : Good (G)
 -  : Very Good (V)
 -  : Like New (L)
 -  : Refurbished
 -  : Collectible (will be attached to other conditions)

G: You can tap on any price to display the profit based on this price in box E.



H: This icon indicates this number has multiple listings on Amazon ([Multiple Listings](#)). You can tap it to see the list.

I: This indicates the item is restricted to your Amazon account ([Restricted Item Notification](#)).

J: Special setting indicator. The screen will display:

- 'Landed' when you enable 'Use Landed Price' in the [Settings](#).
- '\$' when you enable 'Hidden Mode' in the [Settings](#).
- , , , , ,  if you are doing live searches for a country other than the US. ([Setup](#)).

K: Title.

L: Amazon/Buybox price. If Amazon sells this item, it will be the Amazon price, marked with . If the Buybox is held by a third party and Amazon does not sell this item, it will be the Buybox price, marked with  (On the pricing screen, the Buybox will be identified as BB, and the Amazon price as AZ).

M: Weight.

N: The first number is the current sales rank, and the second is the average over the past six months. The average sales rank will give you more accurate information on the popularity of this item. The background color will change based on the current sales rank number.

O: List this item for sale on Amazon.

P: New prices and number of offers in the group are displayed in this column. You can tap 'New' to go to the Amazon new offers page.

Q: Used prices, conditions, and the number of offers are displayed in this column. You can tap 'Used' to go to the Amazon used offers page.

R: You can tap these website icons to check this item on other sites.

* For UPC numbers, you need to do a live search in order to check on websites.

* You need to do a live search to get the item's full title in order to use eBay (Title), eBay (Sold), or Google (Title).

S: Items signaling as 'Buy' will be added to the buy items list automatically. For other items, you can tap this Shopping Cart button to add manually

* If a price is displayed in purple in DB mode, it indicates there is more than one offer at this price in the group. See [Price from Amazon MWS Displayed in FBAScan](#) for more information.

Price from Amazon MWS Displayed in FBAScan

The Amazon MWS service will sort 20 new and used prices into groups based on condition, seller rating, and fulfillment channel. It will then return the lowest price from each group to our program. If a price color is **purple**, it indicates there is more than one offer at the lowest price in that group.

If you enable Menu -> Settings -> 'Number of Offers', the program will display the number of offers in that group next to the price.

Audio and Voice Cue

When an item is checked the first time, the program will play a configurable buy/reject audio cue, based on [Basic Triggers](#) or [Advanced Triggers](#). You can set an audio cue to 'Vibrate'.


When the same item is checked again, you will hear a voice cue. You can change the voice cue content in [Settings](#).


You can lock the phone screen (Menu -> Lock Screen), put the phone in your pocket, use a Bluetooth scanner to scan a barcode, and listen to the audio, voice, or vibrate cue without looking at the screen.

Restricted Item Notification

When the program starts, you can choose to sign into your Amazon account to let the program notify you if an item is restricted to your account (Item I in Figure 3-1 in [Main Screen](#)). You can also request the program save and login to Amazon automatically, so you do not have to log in next time.

Multiple Listings

A UPC number can have multiple listings on Amazon.com. The program will display a list of these listings (Figure 3-3). You can tap an item from this list to see its information, and you can tap the multiple listing button  to go back to the list.

Title Search

After tapping the 'Abc' button on the numpad, you can enter a title on the standard keyboard. A title search will display up to 10 results (Figure 3-4). You can tap an item from this list to see its information, and you can tap the multiple listing button  to go back to the list.

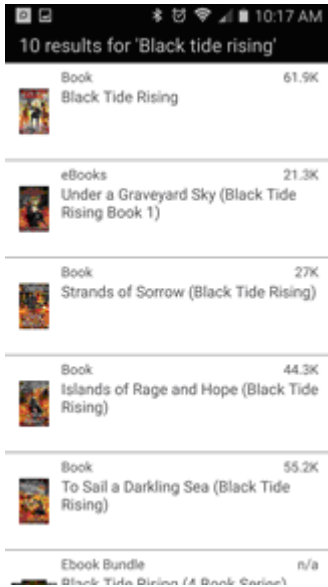

Downloading Database

Before checking an item's information without the Internet, you need to download the pricing database to your phone. Open the Menu and select 'Download'.

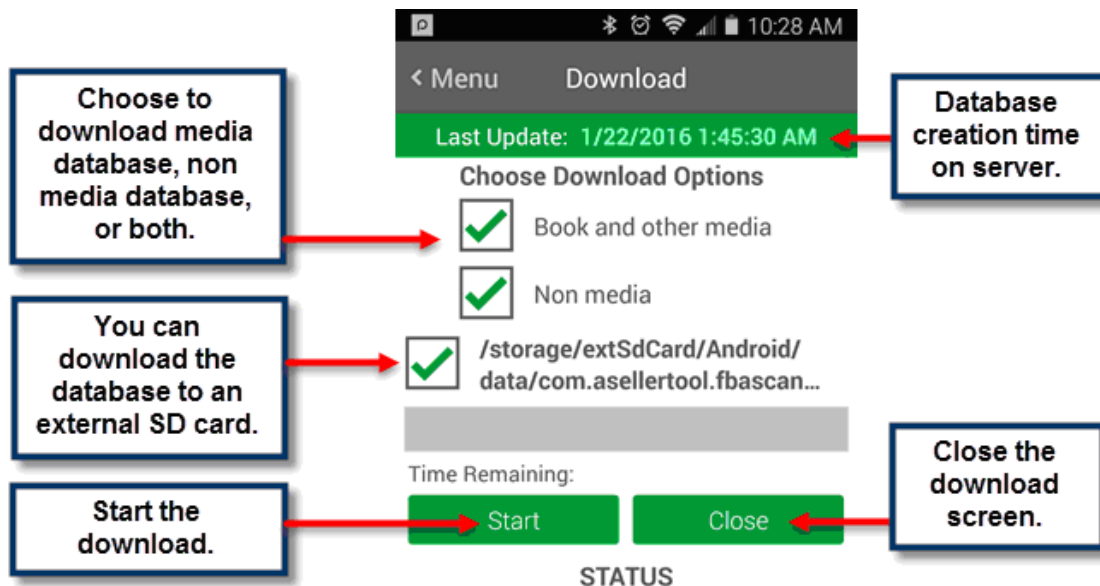

* Keep the download screen open.


* Try not to use a cellular connection, as the file size can be over 2 GB.

* During the download, do not turn on or off the Bluetooth scanner.

! **IMPORTANT:** The app will display a warning message if the database is 7 or more days old.

Buy Items List

This will display the list of items signaled as 'buy' or added manually by tapping on the 'Shopping Cart'  icon.

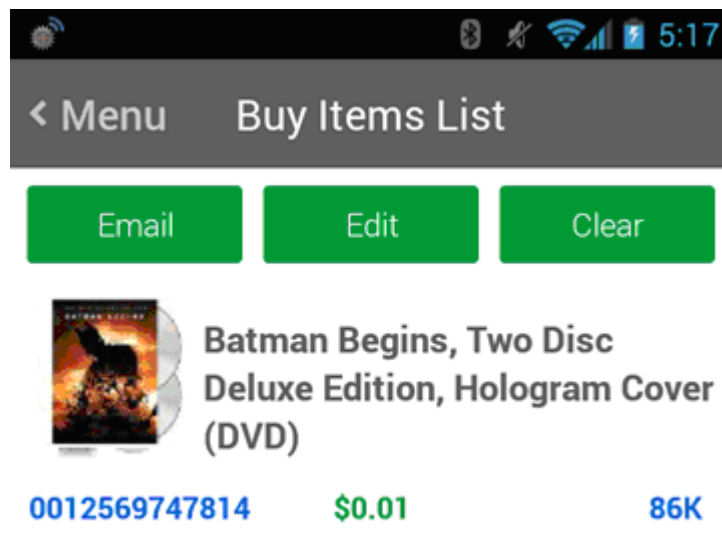

Email: Allows you to email the buy list as a 'buy.txt' file. You can then import this buy.txt file to our Listing Tool to list on Amazon. Please see Part 1 of our Listing Tool tutorial at http://www.asellertool.com/doc/Listing_Tutorial.pdf for more information.


Edit: Allows you to delete items from the Buy List.

Clear: Deletes all items in the Buy List.

Lock Screen

This will lock the screen, so you can put the phone inside your pocket. You use a Bluetooth scanner to scan barcodes, and listen to the audio, voice, or vibrate cue without looking at the screen.

To keep the screen bright in lock mode, enable Menu -> Settings -> 'Keep Screen On in Lock'.

To unlock, tap and hold the 'lock' icon  and drag it outside the circle.

Data Test

After you finish downloading the database, tap this to verify that the database displays the correct price. You can also restart the phone and scan familiar items. If you see a significant price change, you need to do live search to confirm the price change is correct.

Settings

Show Restricted: Display 'Restricted' message (I in Figure 3-1 in [Main Screen](#)) if an item is restricted to your Amazon account.

Display Average Sales Rank: Display the average sales rank over the past six months. This will give you a better indication on the popularity of this item. This is currently **only available** when you do a live search on Amazon US marketplace. For Amazon Canada, UK or other countries, tap the *Camel" icon on the bottom to navigate to CamelCamelCamel website. It will show the graph of sales rank change for the past months.

Disable Sound: The program will not play any sound when scouting.

Auto Show FBA Offers Page: Bring up the FBA offers page for a listing automatically after each scan. The program will automatically do a live search for a listing if it needs to pull up its ASIN.

Adv + Basic Triggers: Use both Basic and Advanced triggers when deciding if an item is a 'Buy'. Advanced triggers will be checked first before Basic triggers.

Show Item Condition: Display the condition next to the price: N (New), L (Like new), V (Very good), G (Good) or A (Average).

Show Number of Offers: Display the number of offers in a group next to the price. This will not be shown for Live look-ups.

Auto Add to Buy List: If enabled, Buy items will automatically be added to the Buy Items List, while Rejected items can be added manually. If disabled, items will have to be added manually.

Fast Open FBA and CCC: Load the CamelCamelCamel and Amazon FBA offers web pages in the background to make them faster to open.

Keep Screen Bright in Lock: Keep the screen bright when you lock the screen.

Use Landed Price (List+Shipping): Display the 'Landed Price' (list price + shipping cost) for non-FBA offers and the list price for FBA offers.

✿ If you are an FBA seller, check this option. The Landed price will be displayed on the screen and used as the offer price by the trigger to signal a buy or reject.

* If you are a [Merchant Fulfilled \(Non FBA\) seller](#), uncheck this option. The listed price will be displayed on the screen and used by the pricing trigger to signal a buy or reject. An FBA price will have its shipping cost deducted before being compared to other non-FBA offers to select the offer price. This is because Amazon Prime members pay list price for FBA offers, but list price and shipping cost for non-FBA offers.

* You can select 'Ignore FBA' to exclude FBA prices and 'Target Non Prime Buyers' to compare FBA offers at their list price. These can be set in either Basic or Advanced triggers.

Hidden Mode: Hide the pricing information from the screen.


Enable Triggers: Displays buy, reject, or other message (A in Figure 3.1 in [Main Screen](#)) on screen, for better visual indication.

Display Rank Color: Display a background color based the current sales rank number ([Sales Rank Color](#)).

Letter for Condition: If this is enabled, the condition symbols will be replaced with letters.

Use Camera: Enabling this will show the 'Camera Capture' button on the top right hand side of the [Main Screen](#).

Shake to Open Camera: Shake the phone to open the camera to capture the barcode.

Mobile Listing: Display 'Mobile Listing' icon . You tap it to list on Amazon.

Use Internal Browser: Use the internal web browser to open Amazon or other site's web pages. If it is not working on your phone, uncheck this option to use the external browser.

Voice Prompt Only: Plays only the voice cue, not the audio cue.

Voice Prompt for Title: Include the title in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Lowest of All: Include the lowest price in the voice cue. If the program is displaying the list price, the FBA price will deduct shipping costs before comparing against non-FBA prices. If the FBA price is the lowest price, the program will speak the price after deducting shipping costs from the FBA price.

Voice Prompt for Lowest FBA: Include lowest FBA price in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Lowest New: Include the lowest new price in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Sales Rank: Include the Sales Rank in the voice cue.

Basic Triggers

The program uses triggers to signal whether the item is a 'Buy' or a 'Reject'. It will play sound and display a message in certain colors based on the trigger result. Basic triggers are for new users and advanced triggers are for experienced users.

Configure Basic Triggers

Tap a category to edit basic triggers for this category.

 The 'Reset' button on the category selection screen will reset all Basic Triggers to default settings.

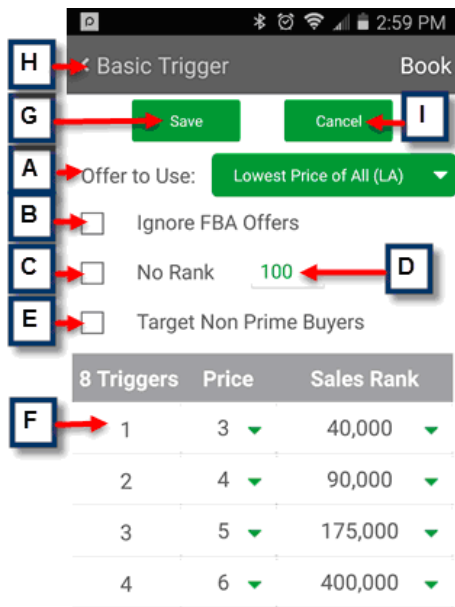

Step 1: Tap the 'Offer to Use' (A) to select which kind of offer price to compare against the minimum price from a trigger.

Explanation of Offer to Use (A in Figure 4-2):

Lowest Price of All (LA): Use the lowest price from all available offers. This is the default setting.

2nd Used Price (2U): Use the second-lowest used price.

3rd Used Price (3U): Use the third-lowest used price.

Lowest New Price (LN): Use the lowest new price.

2nd New Price (2N): Use the second-lowest new price.

3rd New Price (3N): Use the third-lowest new price.

Avg 3 Used Price (AU): Use an average of the three lowest used prices.

Avg 3 New Price (AN): Use an average of the three lowest new prices.

If there are less than 3 used/new prices available, the program will average either the lowest 2 used/new (if 2 offers available), or use the lowest used/new (if 1 offer is available).

Lowest FBA Price (LF): Use the lowest FBA price.

2nd FBA Price (2F): Use the second-lowest FBA price.

3rd FBA Price (3F): Use the third-lowest FBA price.

Lowest Used Profit (UP): Use the lowest profit from Used offers.

Lowest New Profit (NP): Use the lowest profit from New offers.

Lowest FBA Profit (FP): Use the lowest profit from FBA offers.

Step 2: Configure Additional Options

Ignore FBA Offers (B): The program will select the offer price only from Merchant Fulfilled (non-FBA) offers.

No Rank ©: If you also buy items without a sales rank to resell, then check this option and set the minimum price for items without a sales rank in the box (D) next to it. If unchecked, the program will signal items without a sales rank as 'Reject'.

Target Non Prime Buyers (E): FBA offers will not deduct shipping, when comparing against other non-FBA offers to select the offer price. (Non-Prime buyers will pay shipping for both FBA and non-FBA offers).

Step 3: Set Price/Sales Rank for 8 Triggers (F)

There are a total of 8 rows in a Basic Trigger table. Each row is a trigger comprised of the minimum price and maximum sales rank. You tap on them to enter a value.

Step 4: Changes

You tap the Save button (G) to save changes, or the Basic Trigger (H) or Cancel button (I) to cancel changes.

How the Basic Trigger Works

Based on Steps 1 and 2, the program will select an offer price from this item's available offers.

The program will start by comparing against the trigger in the first row. If the selected offer price is \geq the minimum price and the sales rank is \leq the maximum sales rank in the first row, then this trigger will signal the item as 'Buy',

If the trigger cannot signal 'Buy', the program will compare against the trigger from the next row.

The program will repeat this process until either a trigger signals this item as 'Buy', or it goes through all the triggers. In the latter case, the program will signal this item as 'Reject'.

Advanced Triggers

Please refer this topic in our [FBAScan for iPhone](#) section.

Pricing Column Order & Color

You can select which offer (FBA, used, or new) and color to display in one of the 3 pricing columns.

Sales Rank Color

You can configure a background color (item A in figure 3-1 in [Main Screen](#)) based on the current sales rank number. This will give you a visual indication on whether the sales rank number is good or not. You can disable this feature in Menu -> Settings -> Display Rank Color.

Audio

You select which audio clip to play for certain scenarios.



For quieter operation, you can choose the 'vibrate' or 'no sound' option from the sound list for any result listed here.

Explanation of Audio Indicators

Buy: An item is signaled as 'Buy' based on the triggers.

Reject: An item is signaled as 'Reject' based on the triggers.

Invalid Barcode: The input number is not a 10 digit ISBN, a 12 digit UPC, or a 13 digit EAN number.

Error: The program has an error.

Invalid License: The database's license file does not match the smartphone's account information. Please restart the phone and do a fresh data download to fix this issue. If the problem persists, please contact us.

No Seller Listing: An item has no offers.

Watch List: Depreciated.

No New Offer: When a trigger uses a new offer to compare against the minimum price, and there are no new offers.

Not Found: An item is 'Not Found' in the database or not listed on Amazon after a live search.

No Used Offer: When a trigger uses a used offer to compare against the minimum price, and there are no used offers.

Multiple Items: A number has multiple listings on Amazon.

No FBA Offer: When a trigger uses an FBA offer to compare against the minimum price and there are no FBA offers.

FBA as Buy: When a trigger signals an FBA offer as 'Buy'.

No Non FBA Offer: 'Ignore FBA' is enabled in a trigger and an item only has FBA offers.

Restricted Item: Item is restricted to your Amazon account.

FBAScan for iPhone

FBAScan is an app running on your iPhone. It allows you to check any item's Amazon pricing information from an offline database. This offline database search does not require an Internet connection, so you can check one item every second. Optionally you can also search live on Amazon US, Canada, other European countries, and sites like eBay, Google, Bookscout, CamelCamelCamel.

Socket 7Ci or 8Ci scanner allows you to enter item's number much more quickly into FBAScan app. Socket scanner and offline database will dramatically cut down your scouting time, so you can hit more places or spend less time to scout.

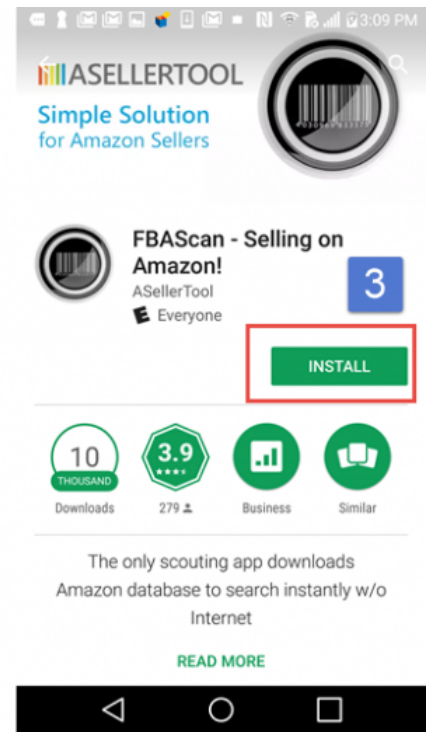
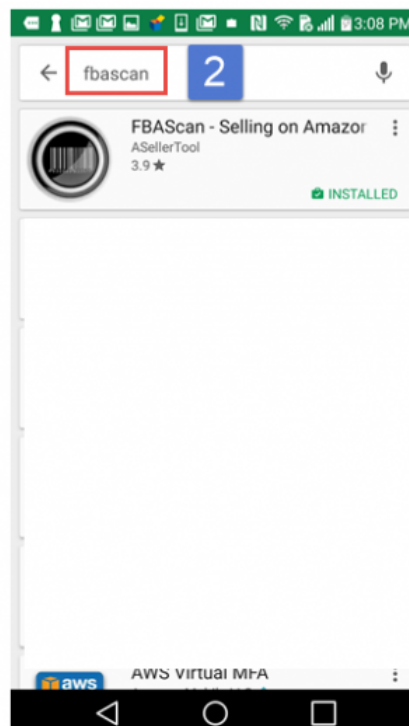
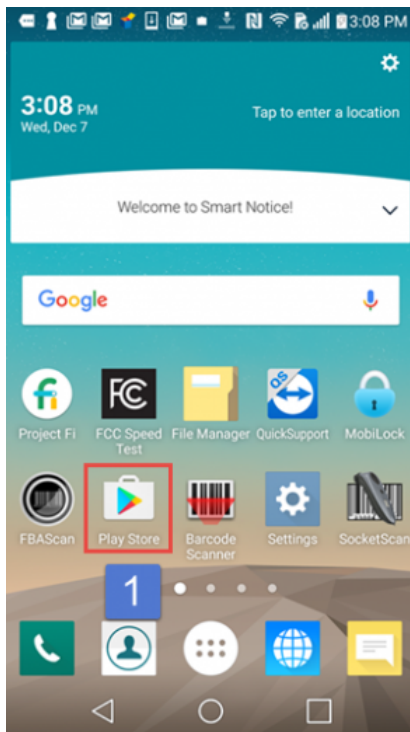

Setting up FBAScan

Entering Account Information

To install the FBAScan app, you search for 'FBAScan' in the App Store. Once you find the app, tap on it, and tap the 'download' button on the top right.

When the program starts, you tap 'New User, click here to register' at the top of the account screen, and enter a User ID, e-mail address, and the country for Amazon marketplace pricing. After tapping the 'Register' button, you will receive a confirmation email with instructions on activating the service.

✿ If you want to see pricing information from Amazon Canada, you need to have an Amazon Canada Professional Merchant account, or a North American Unified account.

✿ If you want to see pricing information from an Amazon EU country's Amazon site, you will need an Amazon EU Professional Merchant account. EU countries are UK, France, Germany, Italy, and Spain.

We offer three service options from \$9.95 a month:

1. Lite: Unlimited Live + Listing + Repricer + Shipment
2. Standard: Local Database + Limited Live + Listing + Repricer + Shipment
3. Professional: Local Database + Unlimited Live + Listing + Repricer + Shipment

Downloading Pricing Database

To check an item's pricing information without an Internet connection, you need to download the pricing database to your phone ([Downloading Database](#)).

Number/Title Entry


You can enter ISBN/UPC numbers with a scanner, camera, or the numpad. You can enter a title or ASIN with the standard keyboard.

Bluetooth Barcode Scanner (Recommended)

We recommend using a Bluetooth scanner with our app to enter a number instantly. Buying a Bluetooth scanner is a worth while investment that will save you time and effort. We sell compatible scanners at <http://www.asellertool.com/packages.html>. The scanner manual is at http://www.asellertool.com/doc/iPhone_Bluetooth_Connection.pdf.

Camera (Not Recommended)

You can tap the barcode symbol , or shake the phone (enable in Menu -> Settings -> Shake to Open Camera) to launch the phone's camera to capture a barcode. The camera is much slower compared to using a scanner.

You need to allow FBAScan to use the iPhone's camera by tapping Settings -> Privacy -> Camera and enabling the FBAScan entry.

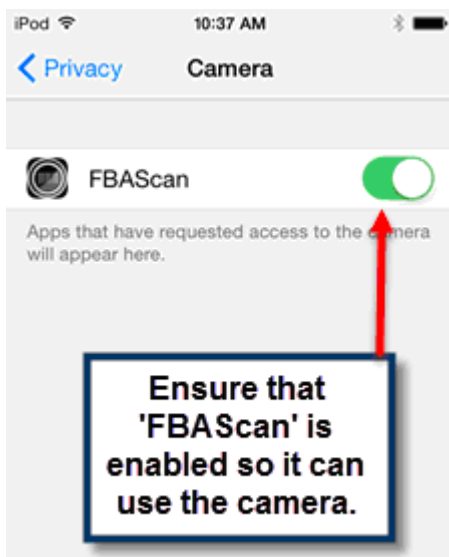

Numpad

If an item does not have a valid barcode, you can tap 'Enter Number' on the screen to open the numpad. If the ISBN number ends with the letter X, you can skip it.

Standard Keyboard

To enter a title or ASIN, you tap  on the numpad to open the standard keypad.

- * If you use a Bluetooth scanner, you need to turn off the scanner before you can use the standard keyboard. Some scanners allow you to double-tap the power button in quick succession to bring the standard keyboard up. Please consult your scanner documentation to see if it supports this feature.

Operating Modes

FBAScan supports 4 operating modes to search items:

- **DB:** The program will only search from the local database on the phone. No Internet is required, so the result is returned instantly.
- **NF:** (Database + Live Search on Not Found item) If the item is not found in the local database, the program will automatically do a live search on all Amazon items.
- **MR:** (Database + Live Search on Not Found or Buy) If the item is not found or is signaled as 'Buy' based on the trigger (section 4.8 and 4.9), the program will automatically do a live search to get current information.
- **LV:** (Live Search Only) The program will always do a live search.

To set the Operating Mode:

1. Double tap the screen or the 'Menu' icon  on the top left of the screen to open the Menu.
2. Tap 'Operating Mode' from the Menu and select a mode from the list.

You can also tap the magnifying glass icon  to do a live search on the current item.

If you mainly search for media items, we recommend setting the mode to 'DB' or 'NF'.

If you search for both media and non media items, we recommend setting the mode to 'NF'.

Optionally, you can use mode 'LV' to review the items you set aside before buying.

Main Screen

Explanation of the Main Screen:

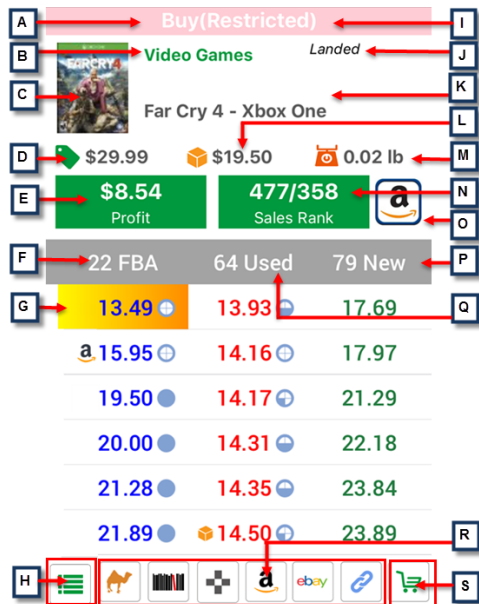

A: 'Buy', 'Reject', or a custom message based on the trigger ([Basic Triggers](#), or [Advanced Triggers](#)).

B: Category.

C: Product image. You can tap the image to go to the Amazon product page.








D: List Price (MSRP).

E: The Profit based on the current selected price. You can tap on this box to display a detailed breakdown of the profit calculation.

F: FBA prices, conditions, and number of offers in this group are displayed in this column. You can tap 'FBA' to go to the Amazon FBA offers page.



Conditions are shown as follows:








-  : New (N)
-  : Acceptable (A)
-  : Good (G)
-  : Very Good (V)
-  : Like New (L)
-  : Refurbished
-  : Collectible (will be attached to other conditions)

G: You can tap on any price to display the profit based on this price in box E.



H: This icon indicates this number has multiple listings on Amazon ([Multiple Listings](#)). You can tap it to see the list.

I: This indicates the item is restricted to your Amazon account ([Restricted Item Notification](#)).

J: Special setting indicator. The screen will display:

- ‘Landed’ when you enable ‘Use Landed Price’ in the [Settings](#)).
- ‘’, when you enable ‘Hidden Mode’ in the [Settings](#).
- ‘, , , , , ’, if you are doing live searches for a country other than the US. ([Setting up FBAScan](#)).

K: Title.

L: Amazon/Buybox price. If Amazon sells this item, it will be the Amazon price, marked with . If the Buybox is held by a third party and Amazon does not sell this item, it will be the Buybox price, marked with  (On the pricing screen, the Buybox will be identified as BB, and the Amazon price as AZ).

M: Weight.

N: The first number is the current sales rank, and the second is the average over the past six months. The average sales rank will give you more accurate information on the popularity of this item. The background color will change based on the current sales rank number.

O: List this item for sale on Amazon.

P: New prices and number of offers in the group are displayed in this column. You can tap ‘New’ to go to the Amazon new offers page.

Q: Used prices, conditions, and the number of offers are displayed in this column. You can tap ‘Used’ to go to the Amazon used offers page.

R: You can tap these website icons to check this item on other sites.

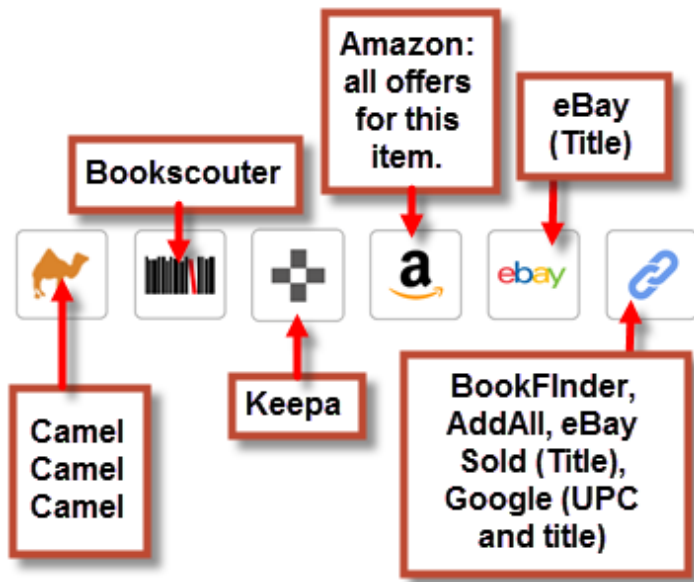

* For UPC numbers, you need to do a live search in order to check on websites.

* You need to do a live search to get the item's full title in order to use eBay (Title), eBay (Sold), or Google (Title).

S: Items signaling as 'Buy' will be added to the buy items list automatically. For other items, you can tap this Shopping Cart button to add manually.

* If a price is displayed in purple in DB mode, it indicates there is more than one offer at this price in the group. See [Price from Amazon MWS Display in FBAScan](#) for more information.

Price from Amazon MWS Displayed in FBAScan

The MWS service from Amazon will sort 20 new and used prices into groups based on condition, seller rating, and fulfillment channel. It will then return the lowest price from each group to our program. If a price color is **purple**, it indicates there is more than one offer at the lowest price in that group.

If you enable Menu -> Settings -> 'Number of Offers', the program will display the number of offers in that group next to the price.

Audio and Voice Cue

When an item is checked the first time, the program will play a configurable buy/reject audio cue, based on [Basic Triggers](#) or [Advanced Triggers](#). You can set one audio cue to 'Vibrate'.


When the same item is checked again, you will hear a voice cue. You can change the voice cue content in [Settings](#).

You can lock the phone screen (Menu -> Lock Screen), put the phone in your pocket, use a Bluetooth scanner to scan a barcode, and listen to the audio, voice, or vibrate cue, without looking at the screen.

Restricted Item Notification

When the program starts, you can choose to sign into your Amazon account to let the program notify you if an item is restricted to your account. (Item I on Figure 3-1 on the [Main Screen](#)). You can also request the program save your Amazon login information, so you do not have enter it manually next time.

Multiple Listings

A UPC number can have multiple listings on Amazon.com. The program will show a list of these listings (Figure 3-3). You can tap an item from this list to see its information, and you can tap the multiple listing button  to go back to the list.

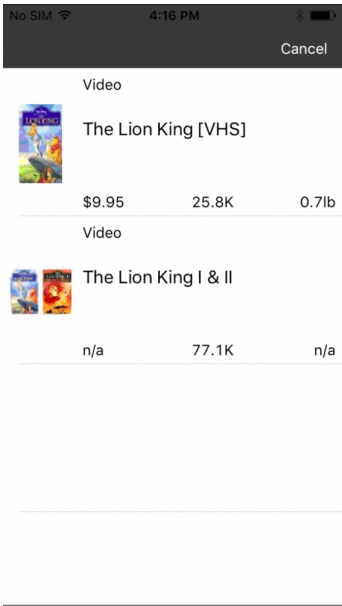

Title Search

After tapping the ‘Abc’ button on the numpad, you can enter a title on the standard keyboard. A title search will display up to 10 results (Figure 3-4). You can tap an item from this list to see its information, and you can tap the multiple listing button  to go back to the list.

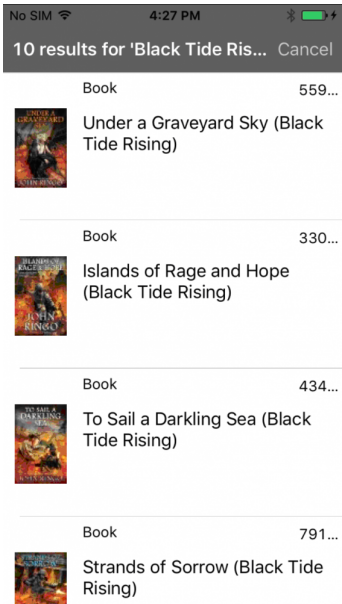
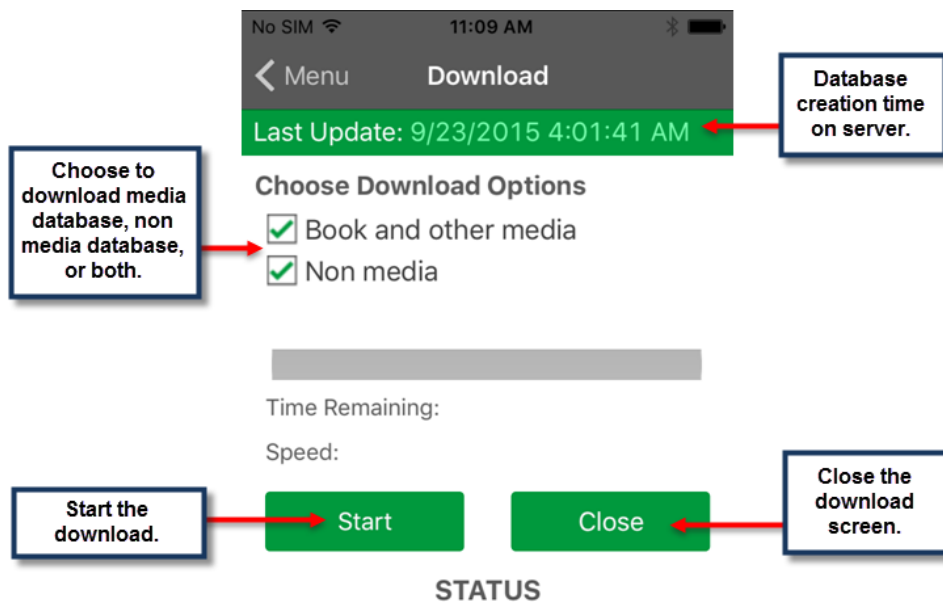

Downloading Database

Before checking an item's information without the Internet, you need to download the offline pricing database to your phone first. If you sign up for the standard database plan, then you need to download database and set operating mode to **DB**. We recommend users to download database the **night before go out scouting**.


From FBAScan main screen, tap the **Menu** icon (3 horizontal lines) and select **Download**.

- * 1. Keep the download screen open.
- 2. Use WiFi network, and not a cellular connection, as the file size can be 1 GB or more
- 3. During the download, do not turn on or off the Bluetooth scanner.

! The pricing information from Amazon marketplace keeps changing very frequently. If your database is older than 3 days, it will not give you a reliable price reading on what the item is currently selling for. You can check your database creation time below. It is highly recommended that you always **download database the night before you go out scouting**. The app will display a warning message if the database is more than 7 days old.

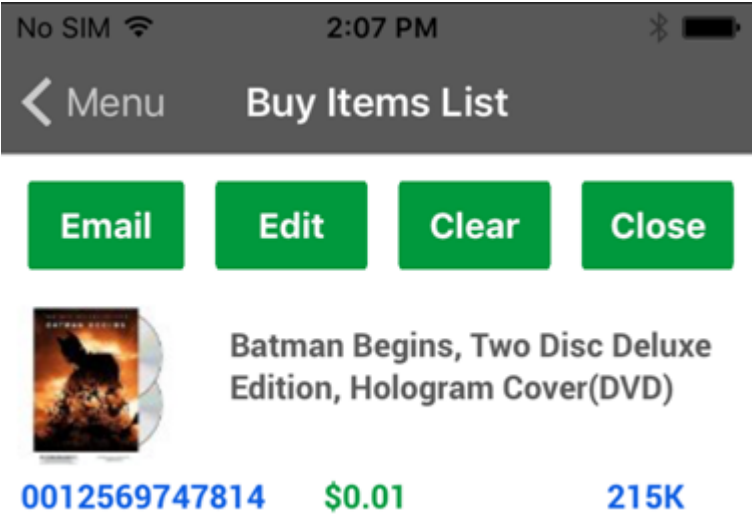

Email: Allows you to email the buy list as a 'buy.txt' file. You can then import this buy.txt file to our Listing Tool to list on Amazon. Please see Part 1 of our Listing Tool tutorial at http://www.asellertool.com/doc/Listing_Tutorial.pdf for more information.

Edit: Allows you to delete items from the Buy List.


Clear: Deletes all items in the Buy List.

Close: Returns to the main screen.

Lock Screen

This will lock the screen, so you can put the phone inside your pocket. You use a Bluetooth scanner to scan barcodes, and listen to the audio, voice, or vibrate cue without looking at the screen.

To keep the screen bright in lock mode, enable Menu -> Settings -> 'Keep Screen On in Lock'.

To unlock, tap and hold the 'lock' icon  and drag it outside the circle.

Settings

Display:

Show Restricted: Display 'Restricted' message (I in Figure 3-1 at the [Main Screen](#)) if an item is restricted to your Amazon account.

Display AVG Sales Rank: Display the average sales rank over the past six months. This will give you a better indication on the popularity of this item.

Disable Sound: The program will not play any sound.

Auto Show FBA Offers Page: Bring up the FBA offers page for a listing automatically after each scan. The program will automatically do a live search for a listing if it needs to pull up its ASIN.

Adv + Basic Triggers: Use both Basic and Advanced triggers when deciding if an item is a 'Buy'. Advanced triggers will be checked first before Basic triggers.

Show Item Condition: Display the condition next to the price: N (New), L (Like new), V (Very good), G (Good) or A (Average).

Show Number of Offers: Display the number of offers in a group next to the price.

Auto Add to Buy List: If enabled, Buy items will automatically be added to the Buy Items List, while Rejected items can be added manually. If disabled, items will have to be added manually.

Fast Open FBA and CCC: Load the CamelCamelCamel and Amazon FBA offers web pages in the background to make them faster to open.

Bright Screen in Lock: Keep the screen bright when you lock the screen.

Landed Price(List + Ship): Display the 'Landed Price' (list price + shipping cost) for non-FBA offers and the list price for FBA offers.



If you are an FBA seller, check this option. The Landed price will be displayed on the screen and used as the offer price by the trigger to signal a buy or reject.

* If you are a Merchant Fulfilled (Non FBA) seller, uncheck this option. The listed price will be displayed on the screen and used by the pricing trigger to signal a buy or reject. An FBA price will have its shipping cost deducted before being compared to other non-FBA offers to select the offer price. This is because Amazon Prime members pay list price for FBA offers, but list price and shipping cost for non-FBA offers.

* You can select 'Ignore FBA' to exclude FBA prices and 'Target Non Prime Buyers' to compare FBA offers at their list price. These can be set in either [Basic Triggers](#) or [Advanced Triggers](#).

Hidden Mode: Hide the pricing information from the screen.

Enable Triggers: Displays buy, reject, or other message (A in Figure 3-1 at the [Main Screen](#)) on screen, for better visual indication.

Display Rank Color: Display a background color based the current sales rank number ([Sales Rank Color](#)).

Letter for Condition: If this is enabled, the condition symbols will be replaced with letters.

Use Camera: Enabling this will show the 'Camera Capture' button on the top right hand side of the [Main Screen](#).

Shake to Open Camera: Shake the phone to open the camera to capture the barcode.

Mobile Listing: Display 'Mobile Listing' icon . You tap it to list on Amazon.

Use Internal Browser: Use the internal web browser to open Amazon or other site's web pages. If it is not working on your phone, uncheck this option to use the external browser.

Voice Prompt:

Voice Prompt Only: Plays only the voice cue, not the audio cue.

Voice Prompt for Title: Include the title in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Lowest of All: Include the lowest price in the voice cue. If the program is displaying the list price, the FBA price will deduct shipping costs before comparing against non-FBA prices. If the FBA price is the lowest price, the program will speak the price after deducting shipping costs from the FBA price.

Voice Prompt for Lowest FBA: Include lowest FBA price in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Lowest New: Include the lowest new price in the voice cue.

Voice Prompt for Sales Rank: Include the Sales Rank in the voice cue.

Linea Pro Scanner Sound:

Enable Sound: A Linea Pro scanner will play a sound after scanning an item.

Basic Triggers

The program uses triggers to signal whether the item is a 'Buy' or a 'Reject'. It will play sound and display a message in certain colors based on the trigger result. Basic triggers are for new users and advanced triggers are for experienced users.

Configure Basic Triggers

Tap a category to edit basic triggers for this category.

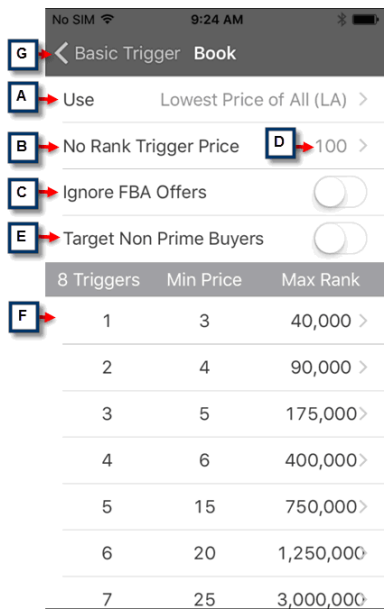

Step 1: Tap the 'Offer to Use' (A) to select which kind of offer price to compare against the minimum price from a trigger.

Explanation of Offer to Use (A in Figure 4-2):

Lowest Price of All (LA): Use the lowest price from all available offers. This is the default setting.

2nd Used Price (2U): Use the second-lowest used price.

3rd Used Price (3U): Use the third-lowest used price.

Lowest New Price (LN): Use the lowest new price.

2nd New Price (2N): Use the second-lowest new price.

3rd New Price (3N): Use the third-lowest new price.

Avg 3 Used Price (AU): Use an average of the three lowest used prices.

Avg 3 New Price (AN): Use an average of the three lowest new prices.

If there are less than 3 used/new prices available, the program will average either the lowest 2 used/new (if 2 offers available), or use the lowest used/new (if 1 offer is available).

Lowest FBA Price (LF): Use the lowest FBA price.

2nd FBA Price (2F): Use the second-lowest FBA price.

3rd FBA Price (3F): Use the third-lowest FBA price.

Lowest Used Profit (UP): Use the lowest profit from Used offers.

Lowest New Profit (NP): Use the lowest profit from New offers.

Lowest FBA Profit (FP): Use the lowest profit from FBA offers.

Step 2: Configure Additional Options

Ignore FBA Offers (B): The program will select the offer price only from Merchant Fulfilled (non-FBA) offers.

No Rank ©: If you also buy items without a sales rank to resell, then check this option and set the minimum price for items without a sales rank in the box (D) next to it. If unchecked, the program will signal items without a sales rank as 'Reject'.

Target Non Prime Buyers (E): FBA offers will not deduct shipping, when comparing against other non-FBA offers to select the offer price. (Non-Prime buyers will pay shipping for both FBA and non-FBA offers).

Step 3: Set Price/Sales Rank for 8 Triggers (F)

There are a total of 8 rows in a Basic Trigger table. Each row is a trigger comprised of the minimum price and maximum sales rank. You tap on them to enter a value.

Step 4: Changes

You tap the Basic Trigger button (G) to save changes.

How the Basic Trigger Works

Based on Steps 1 and 2, the program will select an offer price from this item's available offers.

The program will start by comparing against the trigger in the first row. If the selected offer price is \geq the minimum price and the sales rank is \leq the maximum sales rank in the first row, then this trigger will signal the item as 'Buy',

If the trigger cannot signal 'Buy', the program will compare against the trigger from the next row.

The program will repeat this process until either a trigger signals this item as 'Buy', or it goes through all the triggers. In the latter case, the program will signal this item as 'Reject'.

Advanced Triggers

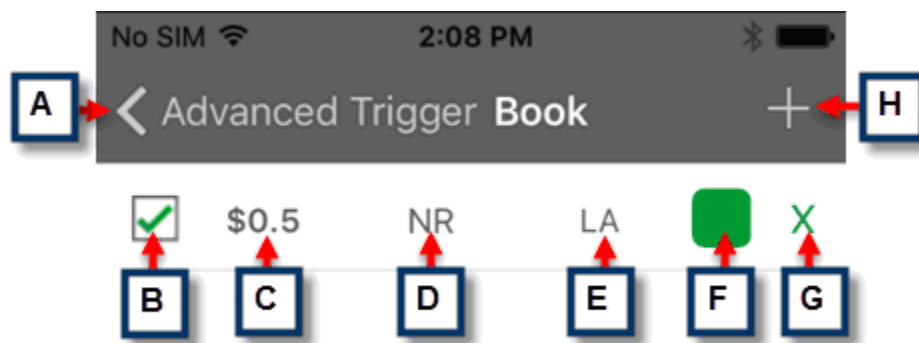
Advanced Triggers allow experienced sellers to have more customization to set up a trigger.

* If you enable any Advanced Triggers in a category, the Basic Triggers for the same category will not be used. If you want to use **Only Basic Triggers** in a category, you need to disable or remove all Advanced Triggers in the same category. If you want to use **Advanced and Basic Triggers**, you need enable the **Adv + Basic Triggers** option in [Settings](#) [here](#).

Existing Triggers List:

Tap Menu -> Advanced Trigger -> Select any category, you will see the list of current triggers for this category.



A: Go back to the category selection screen.

B: Enables or disables this trigger.

C: Minimum offer price.

D: Maximum sales rank. NR means 'No Rank'.

E: Which offer to use to compare against minimum offer price. LA stands for use lowest of all offers to compare against the minimum offer price C.

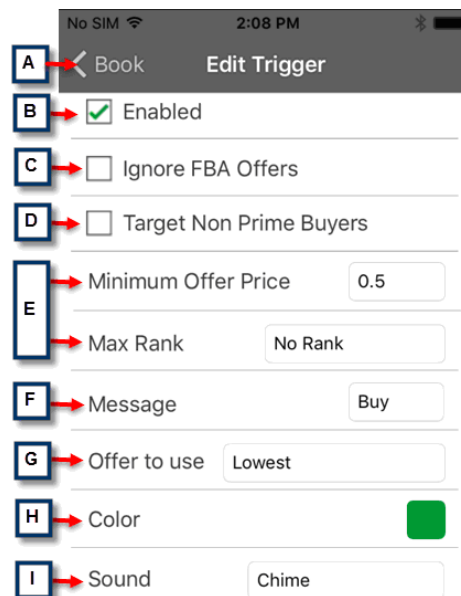
F: Background color in the decision box (I in Figure 3-1 at the [Main Screen](#)), when this trigger signals the item as 'Buy'.

G: Delete this trigger.

H: Create a new trigger.

To edit an existing trigger, tap that trigger from the list.

Create a New Trigger:



A: Tap here to go back to the main screen.

B: Enable or disable this trigger.

C: If enabled, the program will select the price from Merchant Fulfilled (Non-FBA) offers only, ignoring any FBA offers.

D: If enabled, FBA offers will not deduct shipping cost when comparing with other Non-FBA offers to select the offer price.

E: Set the minimum offer price and maximum sales rank for this trigger to signal a buy.

F: Message to appear in the decision box (I in [Main Screen](#)) if this trigger signals the item as Buy.

G: Choose which offer to compare against the minimum offer price (E) in this trigger.

H: Color in the decision box (I in [Main Screen](#)) if this trigger signals the item as a Buy.

I: Sound or vibration the app will play if this trigger signals the item as a Buy.

After you setup this trigger, you tap the 'Back' button (A) to save it.

How it Works:

1. After you scan an item's barcode to the app, the app will get the Amazon market place offers either from an offline local database or the Internet for this item.
2. The app will use the first trigger from the list. Based on this trigger's settings, the program will select an offer price from the offers' list. If the **selected offer price is \geq Minimum Offer Price** and **sales rank is \leq Max Sales Rank**, then this trigger will signal the item as 'Buy'. The program will display this trigger's 'Buy' message, its color on screen and play its sound.
3. If this trigger cannot give 'Buy' signal, the program will use the next trigger from the list. The program will repeat this process above until a trigger can signal the item as 'Buy', or it goes through all the triggers in the list and every trigger gives the reject signal.
4. If you enable the **Adv + Basic Triggers** option in **Settings**, the app will continue to use Basic Triggers to check. If not enabled, then the program will then signal this item as 'Reject'.

Pricing Column Order & Color

You can select which offer (FBA, used, or new) and color to display in one of the 3 pricing columns.

Sales Rank Color

You can configure a background color (item A in Figure 3-1 at [Main Screen](#)) based on the current sales rank number. This will give you a visual indication on whether the sales rank number is good or not. You can disable this feature in Menu -> Settings -> Display Rank Color.

Audio

You select which audio clip to play for certain scenarios.

 You can choose the 'vibrate' option from the list.

Explanation of Audio Indicators:

Buy: An item is signaled as 'Buy' based on the triggers.

Reject: An item is signaled as 'Reject' based on the triggers.

Invalid Barcode: The input number is not a 10 digit ISBN, a 12 digit UPC, or a 13 digit EAN number.

Error: The program has an error.

Invalid License: The database's license file does not match the smartphone's account information. Please restart the phone and do a fresh data download to fix this issue. If the problem persists, please contact us.

No Seller Listing: An item has no offers.

Watch List: Depreciated.

No New Offer: When a trigger uses a new offer to compare against the minimum price, and there are no new offers.

Not Found: An item is 'Not Found' in the database or not listed on Amazon after a live search.

No Used Offer: When a trigger uses a used offer to compare against the minimum price, and there are no used offers.

Multiple Items: A number has multiple listings on Amazon.

No FBA Offer: When a trigger uses an FBA offer to compare against the minimum price and there are no FBA offers.

FBA as Buy: When a trigger signals an FBA offer as 'Buy'.

No Non FBA Offer: 'Ignore FBA' is enabled in a trigger and an item only has FBA offers.

Restricted Item: Item is restricted to your Amazon account.

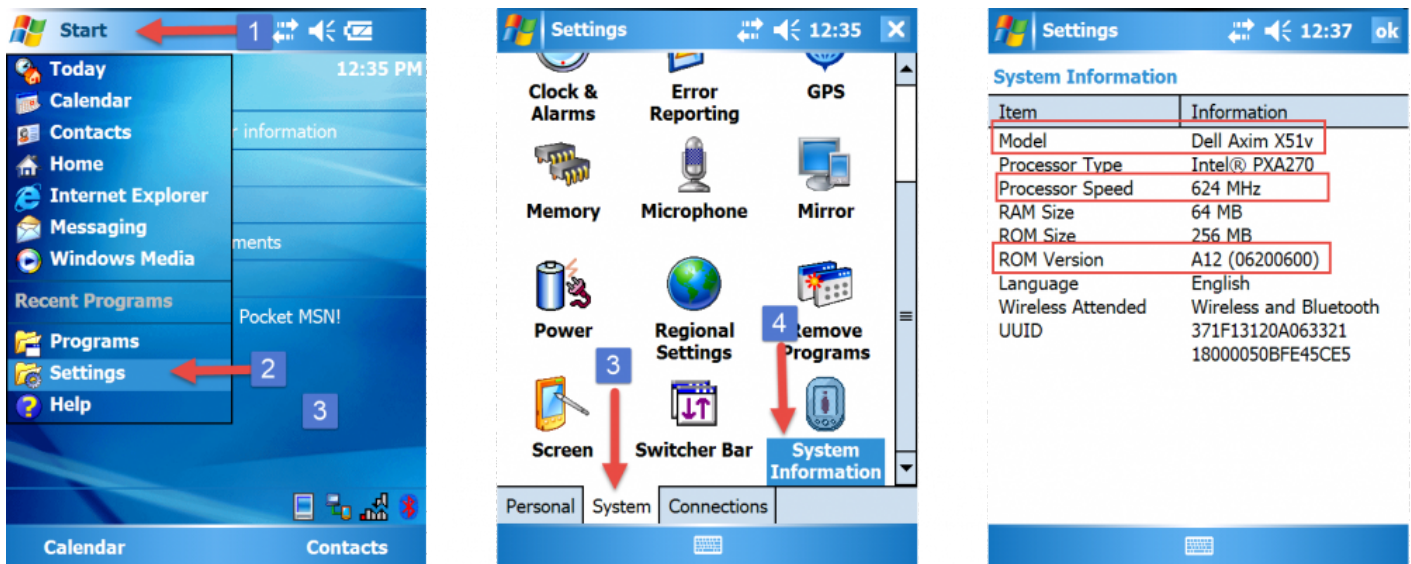

Cloning (X51/X51V Only)

The easiest way to install our software is to use “SD Card Cloning” method. This will set up a Dell X51/X51v PDA with all the needed software and correct settings for the best use.

! This method will completely erase any other information or programs stored on the X51.

To use this method, you need to have a Dell Axim X51 or X51v PDA. Tap “Start” on the PDA, then “Settings” -> “System” -> “System Info”. You will want to get the following information:

1. Download the appropriate zip file for your PDA model and [extract](#) on your computer.
2. Copy the whole folder 2577 into a spare SD card (not the card you are using to download database), so the SD card also has 2577 folder.
3. Insert the SD card back into the PDA.
4. After a few seconds, a screen will come up for the cloning process. Click next until the device resets.

4. Which offer to use (formerly 'Pricing Trigger') has been merged into the 'Buying Criteria' section, and is now set individually for each category. For example, you can set the program to use the lowest price of all offers for books, and the 2nd lowest price used offer for DVDs.

Changes in 10.0

1. The database now includes virtually all Amazon categories, including things like Electronics, Watches, Computer Components, and more.
2. The 'Buying Criteria' section has been renamed 'Basic Trigger'. New options for ignoring FBA prices and targeting non-Prime buyers have been added to the Basic Trigger screen.
3. A new 'Advanced Triggers' feature allows you to create fully customizable triggers. Please see Chapter 5 for more information.

Changes in 10.2

1. The 'Listing' function has been added to the PDA program, which will allow batch listing with a PDA and scanner
2. The 'Data Test' function in the Select Menu will now display the date and time the database was generated.
3. A 'Tips' section has been added to the select Menu, with various tips and tricks on the best practice of the PDA scouting program.
4. The PDA will now display if a DVD is a Restricted Item on Amazon.com for some sellers.

Entering Barcodes

Using a CF Scanner

In order to scan barcode using a CF Scanner, make sure the scanner is inserted into the Compact Flash (CF) slot on the top of the PDA, and then press the "SocketScan" button on your PDA. If you bought the scanner package from us, you can press any physical buttons to use the scanner. If you have your own PDA, you need to install the SocketScan program, and assign a trigger button. Please see the full installer tutorial at http://www.asellertool.com/doc/PDA_Install.pdf (Section 1.5).

Using a Bluetooth Scanner

You can also use SocketMobile handheld Bluetooth scanner to scan the barcode. Please see http://www.asellertool.com/support/7M_v3_setup.htm . While using the Bluetooth scanner, you can either put the PDA in your pocket and use an earpiece to listen to audio cues, or use an armband to attach the PDA to your arm.

Using the Numpad

If there is no barcode to scan, then you can manually input the number by tapping the 'NUM' button.

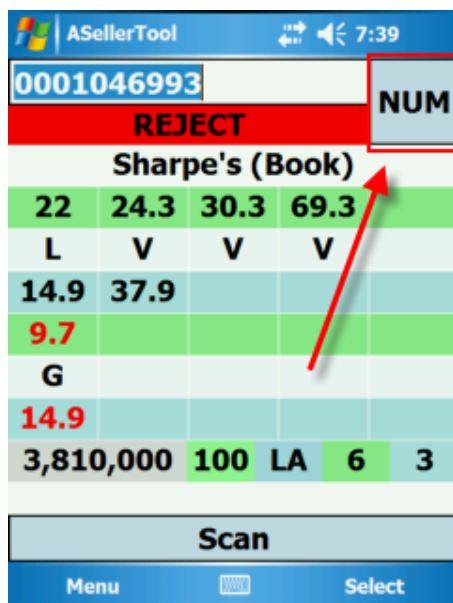

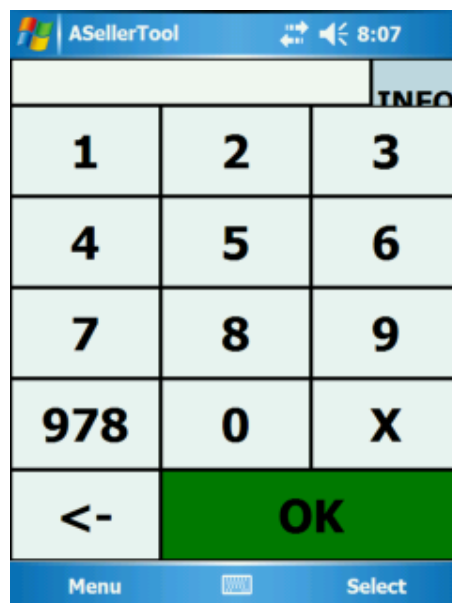

Press the 'OK' button to search for the number entered. To return to the main screen without searching, press the 'INFO' button on the top right hand side.

If you are entering a 13 digit EAN barcode beginning with '978', you can tap the '978' button.

If the number ends with the letter 'X', you can skip it and tap the "OK" button.

Tap the Back Arrow button (<-) to delete previous entered number.

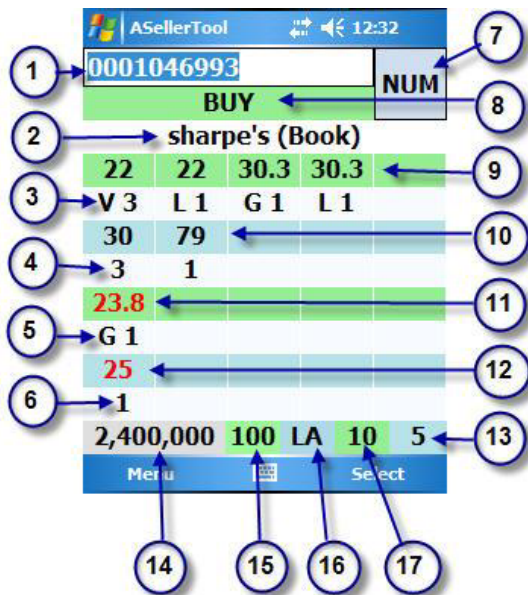

1. The current number entered.

2. Shows a shortened title for the current item, and its category.

3. Condition for used offers and number of offers in this group:

- Letters are used to indicate the condition

L = Like New

V = Very Good

G = Good

A = Acceptable



If "Display number of Offers in Group" is checked in Program Settings, next to the letter will be a number to indicate number of offers in this group. If a letter/number is colored Orange, there are more than one offer at the lowest price in this group. For more information on groups, please see [Pricing Display](#).

4. Number of new offers in this group.

5. Conditions for used FBA offers and number of offers in this group.

6. Number of new FBA offers in this group.

7. Numpad for manual input.

8. Showing the 'Buy Decision' or other special message.

9. Showing the lowest used price, followed by up to 4 lowest used prices from each group.

10. Showing the lowest New Price, followed by up to 4 lowest new prices from each group.

11. Showing Used FBA prices.

✿ If you uncheck “Display FBA Offers Separately” in Program Settings, FBA prices will also be displayed and colored in Red.

12. Showing New FBA Prices.

✿ If the price in 8, 9, 10, or 11 is displayed in Orange, this means that there is more than one offer at the lowest price in this group.

13. Total number of offers in new condition (Cap is at 255 offers).

14. Amazon sales rank.

15. Battery level Indication.

16. Indicates which offer is used by the program to reach a buy or reject decision.

17. Total number of offers in used condition (Cap is at 255 offers).

Lowest Price in Offer Group

For each item, Amazon will get 20 lowest prices in both used and new condition, then sort them into different groups based on condition, fulfillment channel (FBA or merchant), and seller rating. Amazon will then return only the lowest price from each group back to our program. So our program will only display lowest price from each group.

As a result, our program will display the lowest used and lowest new price, followed by the lowest used price from the next 4 used offer groups, and the lowest new price from the next 4 new offer groups.



Due to the limitation of Amazon MWS API, these are not the continuous lowest five used and new prices and this limitation apply to all other scouting software companies who legally use Amazon's systems as well.

Usually, each group contains one or two offers, so the program should still give you a good estimate of the market value for this item.

Use Landed or List Price

Non FBA Sellers Should Use List Price

If you fulfill your order yourself, then you are a Non FBA seller. You need to go to menu -> program setting -> uncheck "Used landed price". The program will display listed prices without adding shipping cost. By doing so, FBA offers will subtract shipping cost first before comparing with other non FBA offers on listed price, to decide which offer price to use for the trigger. This is because Amazon prime buyers do not need to pay shipping cost for FBA offers, but pay shipping for non-FBA offers.

If you are targeting non-prime buyers only, you can enable the 'Target Non Prime Buyers' option in both Basic and Advanced Triggers. This will make the program not subtract shipping from FBA offers, since non-Prime buyers need to pay shipping for both FBA and non-FBA offers.

You can also enable the 'Ignore FBA Offers' option, which will exclude FBA offers from being considered when selecting the offer price. More information on these options can be found in [Basic Trigger](#) and [Advanced Trigger](#).

FBA Sellers Should Use Landed Price

If you are an FBA seller, you need to go to Menu -> Program Setting -> Check "Used Landed Price". The program will display landed price (list price + shipping cost). Non FBA offers will add shipping cost and FBA offers will not add shipping cost. Since Amazon prime buyers do not need to pay shipping cost when they buy FBA offers.

The offer price used in the trigger will be the landed price (list price + shipping).

A Note on Restricted Items

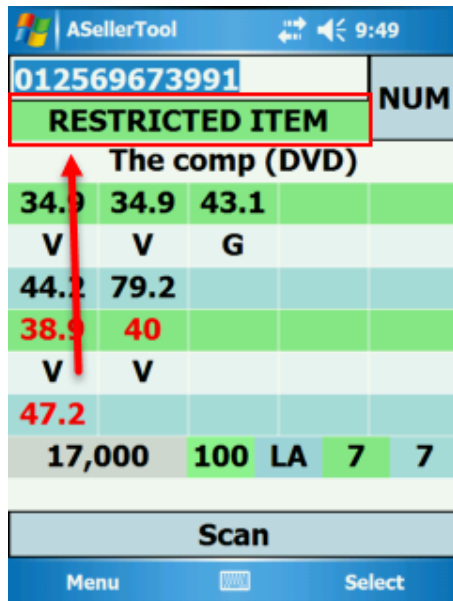

If an item appears as a 'Restricted Item', that means that Amazon will not allow certain sellers to list this item for sale, while other sellers can list this item.

If you see an item appear as a Restricted Item on the PDA, then it is possible that you may not be able to list this item on Amazon.

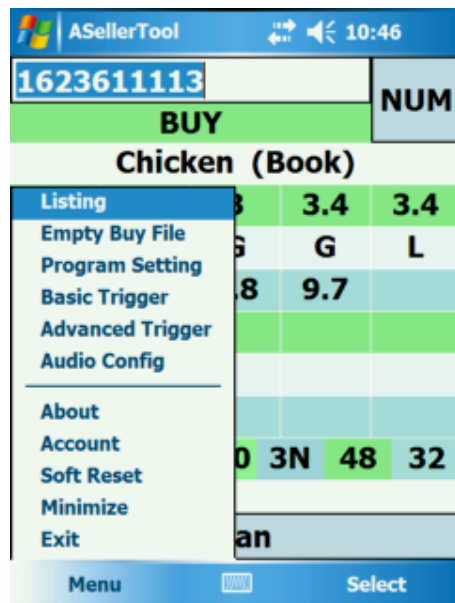

Listing: Allows you to scan and list with the PDA.

Empty Buy File: Let you clear the barcodes saved as buy during scanning.

Program Setting: Configure this software.

Basic Trigger: Setup pricing offer used, pricing and rank buying criteria in a default format.

Advanced Trigger: Setup individual triggers with customizable pricing offers and buy signals.

Audio Config: Configure audio indications to different scanning results.

About: Show the version number and also check SD card status

Account: Setup your account, display device license key and also enable or disable Hidden Mode.

Soft Reset: Allow you to reboot your PDA

Minimize: Allow you to minimize ASellerTool PDA software on your PDA

Exit: This will end ASellerTool program.

Listing with PDA

The Listing function allows you to use the PDA and scanner to quickly list items on the spot, without hauling them to your computer. You can also use the scanner to scan customized descriptions for each item.

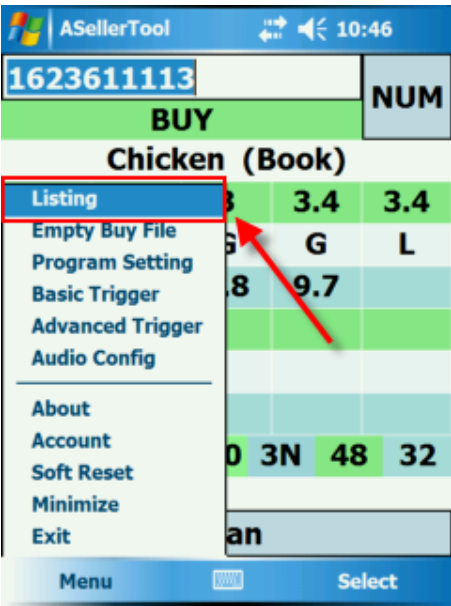

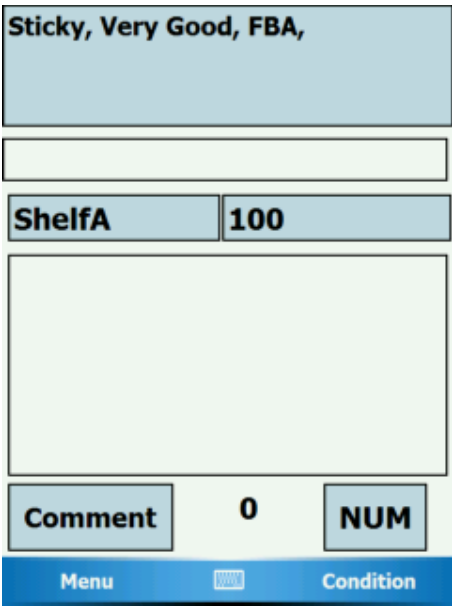

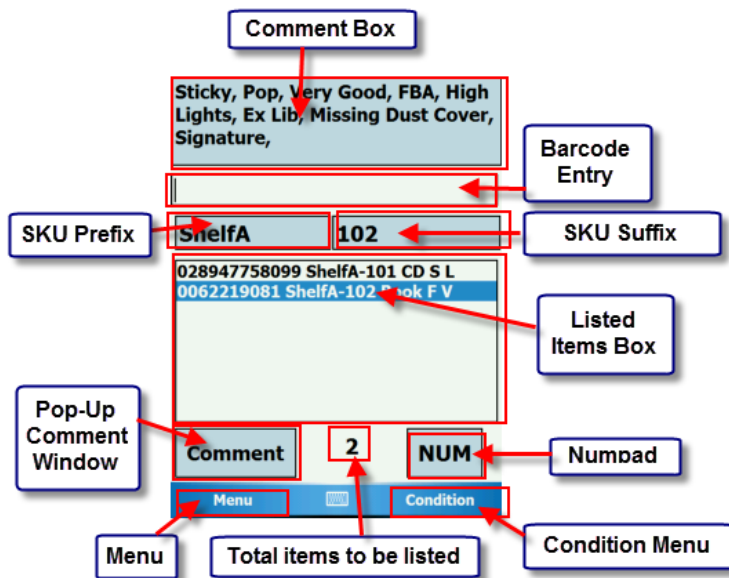

Comment Box: This shows what comments are currently applied for a selected item, as well as the fulfillment channel, condition, and any special commands that have been enabled.

Barcode Entry Bar: This is where you scan item's barcodes, customized comment or command barcodes.

SKU Prefix: Usually serves as a location for an item (i.e. Shelf A, Box 1). To modify the prefix, tap this box.

SKU Suffix: A number that increases for each item scanned. To modify the suffix, tap

this box. With a SKU Prefix and Suffix, you can find a sold item easily.

Listed Items Box: List of items to be uploaded. The format is below:

UPC/ISBN, SKU Prefix-SKU Suffix, Category, Fulfillment Method, Condition.

For Fulfillment methods, 'S' = Self-Fulfill, and 'F' = FBA.

For Conditions, 'N' = New, 'L' = Like New, 'V' = Very Good, 'G' = Good, and 'A' = Acceptable.

Comment Pop-Up Button: Allows you to choose from a list of comments for the currently selected item.

Total items to be listed: The number of items to be listed in the current batch.

Numpad Button: Tapping this button will bring up a numpad for manual entries of ISBNs or UPCs if an item does not have a barcode to scan.

Menu: This will bring up the command Menu, which allows you to toggle various special commands, as well as close the program.

Condition Menu: Allows you to select the condition for an item.

✿ With the exception of the 'Close', 'About', 'Copy Description', and 'Import Comment' commands, all other commands have corresponding barcodes that can be scanned to enable or disable them (scan again), so you do not need to touch the screen. These barcodes can be found in the [PDA Listing Command Barcodes](#)

FBA: This command will set the fulfillment method from 'FBA' to 'Self-Fulfill' and vice versa.

Pop Up: This option will cause the Comments window to appear automatically after each item scanned, allowing you to select comments for this item.

Sticky: This option will cause comments for the last item to be carried over to the next item of the same category.

Copy Description: This command will copy the description of the currently selected items to following items of the same category.

Start Listing: Starts listing for a new batch.

End Listing: Ends listing for a current batch, and creates a file on the SD card. You can then put the SD card into your computer and our Listing Tool will upload your listed items.

Import Comment: Import a new comment file generated from the Listing Tool

Delete: Deletes the currently selected item from the List.

Close: Closes the Listing function. Make sure that you 'End Listing' first to save your work before closing the program.

About: Gives the current version of the software, as well as the current version of the Comment file used.

How Listing Works

Step 1: Print out the Command Barcodes from [PDA Listing Command Barcodes](#) and the Special Comment Barcode sheet generated from Listing Tool program. This will allow you to scan them to set condition, fulfillment channel, descriptions to the listed item.

Step 2: Export your Comment file from the Listing Tool to the SD card, then place the SD card into your PDA. Start Asellertool, and tap menu, then listing (Figure 21 at the [Listing Screen](#)). The PDA software will use the new comment file.

Step 3: Scan the 'Start Listing' command barcode or select 'Start Listing' from the menu (Figure 25 at the [Listing Menu](#)) to start listing.

Step 4: Scan your first item, then scan FBA and condition command barcode to set fulfillment channel and condition for this item.

Step 5: Scan comment barcodes to apply customized descriptions for this item.

Step 6: Repeat step 4 and 5 to list rest of the items

Step 7: Scan the 'End Listing' command barcode or select 'End Listing' from the menu (Figure 25 at the [Listing Menu](#)) to end listing.

Step 8: Tap Menu and Close, then remove the SD card from the PDA, and insert it into the computer. Listing Tool will read the SD card and list the items to Amazon. Please check the listing tool tutorial for more information. <http://www.asellertool.com/support/ListingTool.htm>

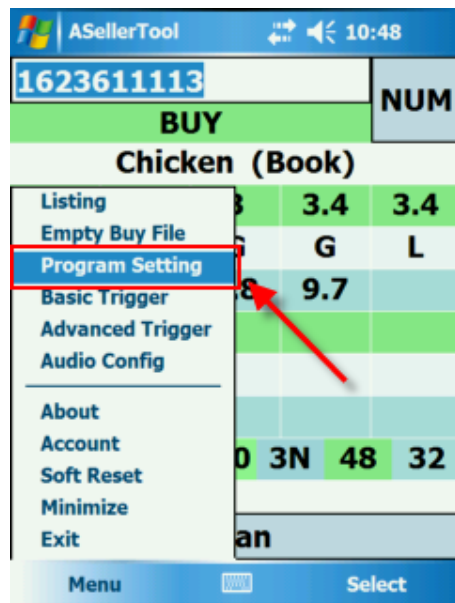

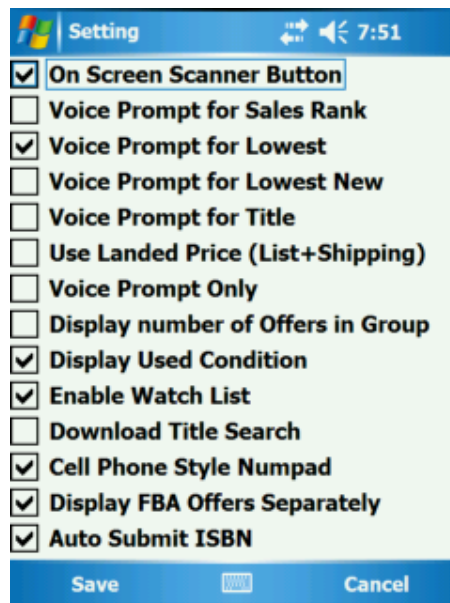

The following is an explanation of what each setting does from top to bottom.

On Screen Scanner Button: Check marking this button will cause an on-screen scanner button to appear on the touch screen, which will activate the connected laser scanner when pressed. You should ensure that either 'Display number of offers in Group' /or/ 'Display FBA Offers Separately' is unchecked, to provide enough room for this button on the main screen. This

is disabled by default.

Voice Prompt for Sales Rank: Allows the program to say the Sales Rank for the current item. This is disabled by default.

Voice Prompt for Lowest: allows the program to say the lowest price listed for the current item. If 'Use Landed Price' is unchecked, it will subtract the shipping from any FBA offers displayed before calculating the lowest price. If an FBA item is the lowest price, the letters 'FBA' will be audibly added to the verbal cue. This is enabled by default.

Voice Prompt for Lowest New: Program will say the lowest new price for the current item. If 'Use Landed Price' is unchecked, it will subtract the shipping from any new FBA offers displayed before calculating the lowest price. If an FBA item is the lowest new price, the letters 'FBA' will be audibly added to the verbal cue. This is disabled by default.

Voice Prompt for Title: Program will say the shortened title for the current item. This is disabled by default.



To activate any voice prompts, an item must be scanned twice, or 'Voice Prompt Only' should be checked.

Use Landed Price (List + Shipping): Will show the 'Landed Price' of an item (the listed price of an item plus shipping) to all new and used Non FBA offers. The shipping cost is the standard Amazon would charge for the item. This is disabled by default (Use list price).



For FBA sellers, check this option, so Pricing Offer will use landed price.



For Non FBA sellers, uncheck this option, so Pricing Offer will use listed price and all FBA offers will subtract shipping cost before comparing with non FBA offers.

Voice Prompt Only: If this is checked, the program will only give voice prompts in audio when an item is scanned, instead of first giving a buy/reject signal, and then the voice prompt on the second scan. This is enabled by default.

Display # of Offers in Group: This option will show the number of offers in each group, according to the Explanation of Pricing Data in the main screen section. Unchecked, it will simplify things by showing the condition of the items in said group, as well as removing the New Group Quantity and FBA New Group Quantity rows from the main screen. This is disabled by default.

Display Used Condition: Condition of item for Used merchant fulfilled and FBA items will be indicated beneath the corresponding price. This is enabled by default.

Enable Watch List: Enables those barcodes set in the Watch List, when scanned, to show up in the Buy decision screen as 'Watch List' instead of 'Buy' or 'Reject'. This is disabled by default.

Download Title Search: ensures that the Pre-ISBN title search files are downloaded with the ISBN/UPC barcode files, either when downloading directly to the PDA, or to the SD card using a Data Downloader. This function is discussed later in this tutorial. This is disabled by default, and is depreciated with the current PC Downloader, version 10.2 .

Cell Phone Style Numpad: When check-marked, this will show the Manual Entry Screen as a standard number pad common to most cellular phones:

If this box is unchecked, the numbers will be reversed in the Manual Entry Screen:

This is disabled by default.

Display FBA Offers Separately: Items in the Used and New prices that are marked as 'FBA' shown in (shown in **Red**), as well as their Group Quantities and Conditions will show up as four rows underneath the New Group Quantity row. If this is unchecked, the FBA prices will be shown as part of the New or Used groups they are originally from in **Red**. This is enabled by default.

Auto Submit ISBN: any manually entered ISBN will be automatically submitted when manually entered, instead of having to press the 'OK' button to submit it. You may want to ensure this is off if you find barcodes being submitted prematurely. This is enabled by default.

Save: Tapping this will save all changes to Program Setting and return you to the program after a few seconds.

Cancel: Tapping here will cancel any changes you have made to the Program Setting screen and will return you to the program in few seconds.

Basic Trigger

By default, the Basic Triggers are used to decide if an item is a buy, or reject.

Configure Basic Trigger

To configure Basic Triggers, follow the steps below:

- **Step 1:** Enter the Basic Trigger screen. Tap 'Menu', followed by 'Basic Trigger' (Figure 5).
- **Step 2:** Tap the category to edit (Figure 6).
- **Step 3:** Choose which offer price to use (Figure 7, Figure 8).

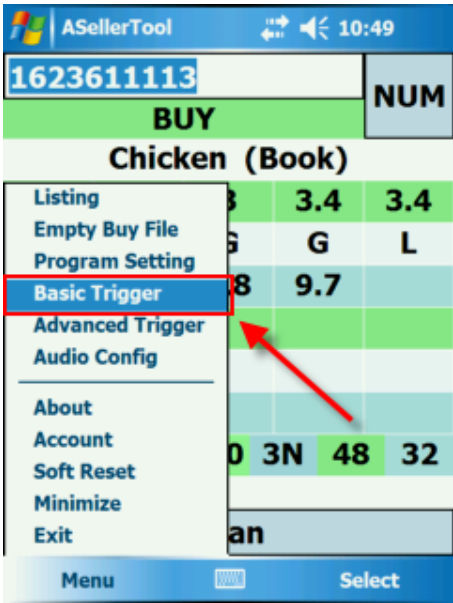

List of Offer Prices Available:

Lowest (LA): This will use the lowest price. The offer box will show 'LA'. This is the default setting.

2nd Used (2U): This will use the second-lowest Used price. The offer box will show '2U'.

3rd Used (3U): This will use the third-lowest Used price. The offer box will show '3U'.

Lowest New (LN): This will use the lowest New price. The offer box will show 'LN'.

2nd New (2N): This will use the second-lowest New price. The offer box will show '2N'.

3rd New (3N): This will use the third-lowest New price. The offer box will show '3N'.

AVG 3 Used (AU): This will use a calculated average of the three lowest Used prices. The offer box will show 'AU'.

AVG 3 New (AN): This will use a calculated average of all of the three lowest new prices. The offer box will show 'AN'.



If 3 Used/New prices are not available, the program will average either the lowest 2 Used/New, or simply the lowest Used/New.

Lowest FBA (LF): This will use the lowest FBA price. The offer box will show 'LF'.

2nd FBA (2F): This will use the second-lowest FBA price. The offer box will show '2F'.

3rd FBA (3F): This will use the third-lowest FBA price. The offer box will show '3F'.

- **Step 4:** Set the Trigger Options

No Rank: When checked, if an item has no sales rank, and the offer price is greater than or equal to the price next to the No Rank checkbox, the item will be a 'buy'.

Ignore FBA Offer: When checked, FBA offers will be excluded from offers being considered for the offer price.

Target Non-Prime Buyers: When checked, FBA offers will not deduct shipping when compared with other non-FBA offers to select the offer price.

- **Step 5:** Set Price/Sales Rank Table

Each row in the table is a trigger comprised of the minimum price, and maximum rank. They can be set by tapping on them, and selecting an appropriate value from the drop down.

- **Step 6:** Saving Changes

Save: The save button will save any changes you have made to the criteria.

Cancel: The cancel button will discard any changes you have made to the criteria.

How It Works

The program will start by comparing the selected offer price and the item's sales rank, shown in Figure 7 at [Configure Basic Trigger](#).

When an item is scanned, the program will select an offer price, based, in this order, on whether to ignore FBA Offers, to target non-Prime members, and which offer price to use. Once it selects the offer price, it will also collect the items sales rank.

The program will start by comparing the selected offer price and the item's sales rank against the content in the first row of the price/sales rank table, shown in Figure 7 at [Configure Basic Trigger](#).. It will check if the offer price is greater than or equal to the Minimum Offer Price. It will also check the sales rank if it is less than or equal to the Max Sales Rank.

If the comparison is successful for this current row, the program will return with the 'Buy' message and sound to indicate that this item is a 'Buy'.

If the check is not successful, the program will move down to the next row, and run the same check. The program will repeat this process until a row gives a buy signal, or until it goes through all the rows in the table. The program will return with a 'Reject' when no rows give a 'buy' indication.

Overview

Advanced Triggers are for experienced sellers who want more customization when setting a trigger.

! If any Advanced Triggers are enabled for a category, the Basic Triggers for that category will not be used. If you want to use Basic Triggers for a category, please make sure no Advanced Triggers are enabled within that category.

For each trigger, you can set:

- 1) Whether or not to ignore FBA offers.
- 2) Whether or not to target non-Prime buyers.
- 3) The minimum price that the offer price must be equal to or greater than.
- 4) The maximum sales rank the item's sales rank must be equal to or less than.
- 5) Which offer to use as offer price (Lowest of All, Lowest of New, etc.).
- 6) The message, background color, and sound that the program will use when this Trigger determines the item is a buy.

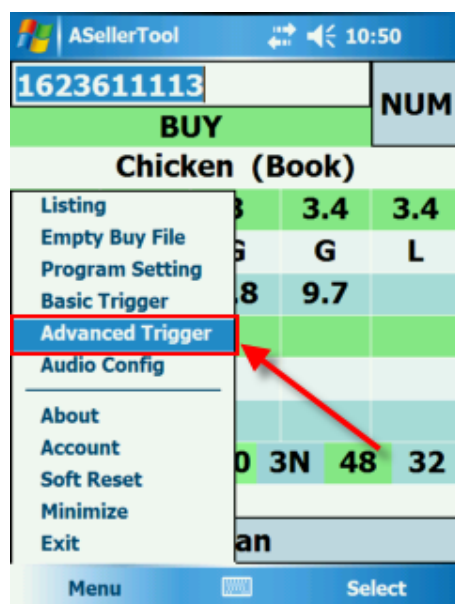

Creating New Trigger

Step 1: Choose Category.

Tap 'Menu', then 'Advanced Trigger' (Figure 9 at [Configure Basic Trigger](#)), and then tap a category (Figure 12)

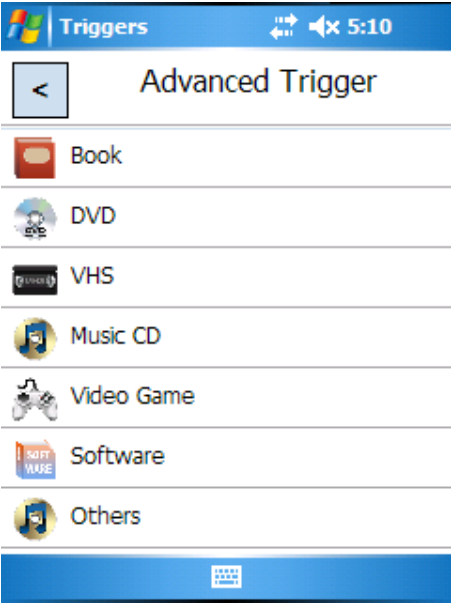

You can tap the 'Back' button (<) to return to the main screen.

Once a category is selected, the program will show a list of existing triggers for that category (Figure 13).

- **Step 2:** Review current triggers.

The information displayed in the Trigger List is as follows:

- 1) **Minimum Offer Price**
- 2) **Max Sales Rank**
- 3) **Offer to Use**
- 4) **Buy Message**
- 5) **Buy Color**

- 6) **Delete:** Tapping this X will delete this.

7) **Enable:** Enables/disables this trigger

- **Step 3:** Create new Trigger/Edit existing Triggers.

To create a new trigger from the trigger list screen, tap the 'plus' button (+). To edit an existing trigger, tap that trigger from the Trigger List screen.

At the top of the Trigger Configuration screen (Figure 14 on Advanced [Trigger Configuration](#)), tapping (<) will cancel changes and take you back to the Trigger list screen. Tapping **OK** will save changes, and, if this is a new trigger, add it to the list.

Trigger Configurations:

1) **Enable:** Enables/disables this trigger to determine if an item is a buy or reject.

2) **Ignore FBA Offer:** When checked, this trigger will not consider FBA offers. Only Merchant Fulfilled Prices will be used to select the offer price.

3) **Target Non-Prime Buyers:** When checked, shipping will not be deducted from FBA offers when compared with Merchant Fulfilled offers to select the offer price.

4) **Minimum Offer Price and Max Sales Rank:** The item's offer price must be greater than or equal the minimum offer price, and the item's sales rank must be less than or equal to this Max Sales Rank in order

for this trigger to decide this item is a buy.

5) **Message:** The message that will appear in the Buy Decision section if the item is a buy based on this trigger.

6) **Which Offer to Use:** The offer price that the program will use to check against the Minimum Price.

7) **Color:** The color for the Buy Decision section if the item is a buy based on this trigger.

8) **Sound:** The audio that plays if the item is a buy based on this trigger.

How It Works

When an item is scanned, the program will start by using the trigger from the top of the list, shown in Figure 13 on [Creating New Trigger](#) in Advanced Trigger.

When an item is scanned, the program will select an offer price, based on whether to ignore FBA Offers, to target non-Prime members, and which offer price to use. Once it selects the offer price, it will also collect the items sales rank.

The program will start by comparing the trigger's selected offer price and the item's sales rank against the content set within the top trigger, shown in Figure 13 on [Creating New Trigger](#) in Advanced Trigger. It will check if the offer price is greater than or equal to the Minimum Offer Price. It will also check the sales rank if it is less than or equal to the Max Sales Rank.

If the comparison is successful, the program will use this trigger's 'Buy' message, color, and sound to indicate that the item is a buy based on this trigger.

If the check is not successful, the program will move down to the next trigger in the list, and run the same check. The program will repeat this process until a trigger gives a buy signal, or until it goes through all the triggers on the list. The program will return with a 'Reject' when no triggers in the list give a 'buy' indication.

Audio Configuration

When the PDA scans an item and gets a certain result, an audio cue will play from the PDA's speakers or headset depending on the user's preference. These audio cues are a good way to tell quickly whether an item is a good buy and are particularly useful if you are using a Bluetooth scanner with the PDA in a pocket or otherwise having its screen obstructed from view.

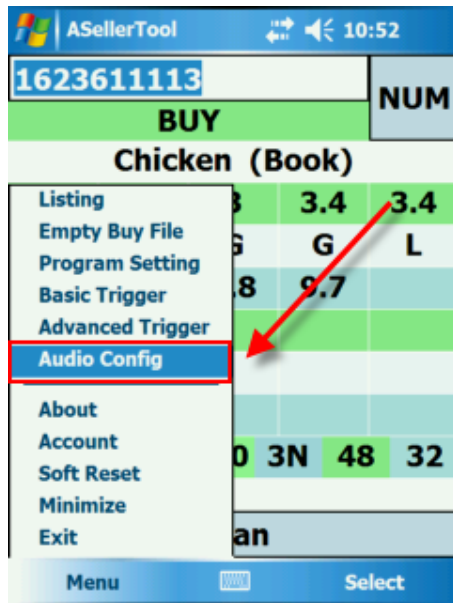

Buy: This sound will be played when a 'BUY' rating is given.

Reject: This sound will be played when a 'REJECT' rating is given. **Not Found:** This sound will be played when an item is Not Found in the database. You may hear this sound, or the words 'Not found'.

FBA: This sound will be played if your Trigger is set to look for an FBA offer and one is found as a Buy.

No FBA: This sound will be played if your Trigger is set to look for an FBA offer and there are none.

No Non FBA: This sound will be played if your Trigger is set to ignore FBA offers, and there are no Merchant Fulfilled offers lists.

No New: This sound will be played if your Trigger is set to look for a new offer and there are none.

No Used: This sound will be played if your Trigger is set to look for a used offer and there are none.

Watch List: This sound will be played when an item on your Watch List is scanned, providing that the Watch List has been enabled in Program Setting.

✳ All categories here will need to be set to different sounds in order to function; setting any categories here to the same sounds will produce an error.



Additionally, if you find the sound is cut off before it can play fully, check your sound configuration by tapping the Menu button on the bottom left hand side, and select Minimize. Then, tap the Start Menu on the PDA's top left hand side, followed by Settings, and then the Sounds & Notifications icon. On this screen, make sure all check boxes *except* for Programs are *unchecked*.

Save: Pressing this button on the bottom left will save the changes made to the audio configuration, and return you to the main screen.

Cancel: Pressing this button on the bottom right will discard any changes made to the audio configuration, and return you to the main screen.

About

The About window will show some small amount of information about the program and pricing database that is currently on the PDA.

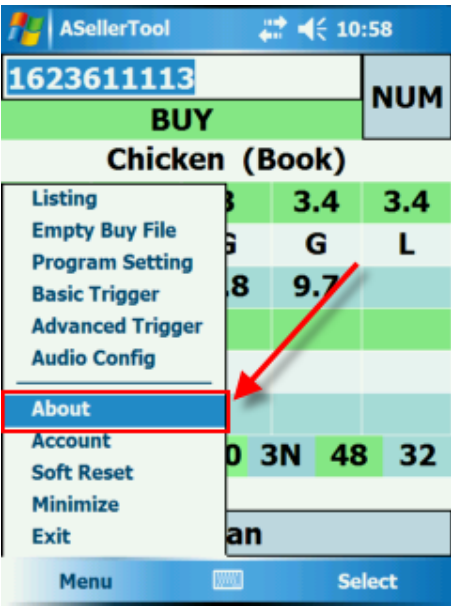

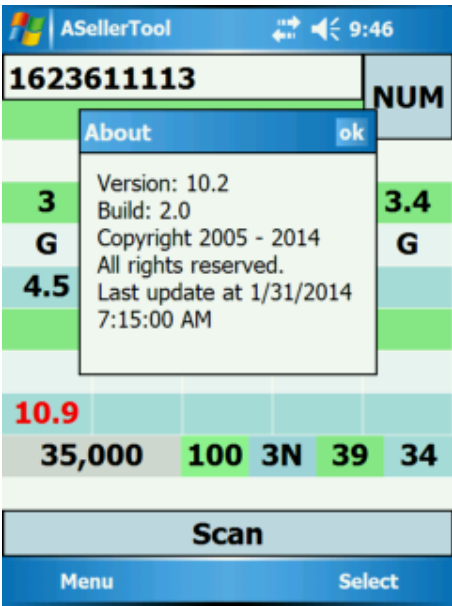

Version: This is the current version of the program installed on the device itself. The build number underneath is for internal use and is not needed by the User.

Last Update at: This will show the data and time of the last update performed. It will also state if an SD card cannot be detected in the PDA, or if an SD card is detected, but no data files are found. It should be noted that there might be problems with the pricing

database even if a last update date is shown here. Make sure you soft reset your PDA after each download to be certain of functionality.

Account

This screen shows you the current account credentials entered into the PDA, as well as the ability to enter 'Hidden Mode'.

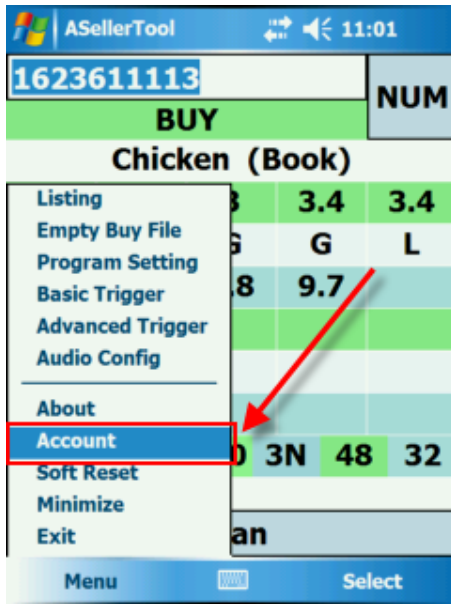

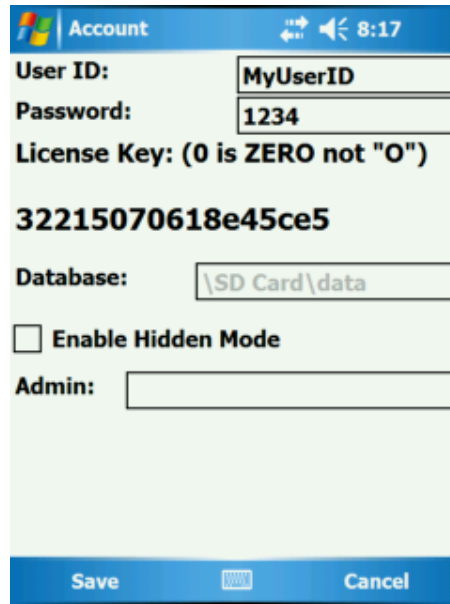

User ID: This is current User ID set inside the PDA. This field can be changed if you do decide to switch the User ID/Password combination in the PDA to another combination.

- ✿ Make sure that any letters in the User ID are in lower case, to prevent download or database errors.

Password: This is the current Password set inside the PDA. This field can be changed if you do decide to switch the User ID/Password combination in the PDA to another combination.

- ✿ Make sure that any letters in the Password are in lower case, to prevent download or database errors.

Device ID/License Key: This can be a string of letters, or letters and numbers. It may be referred to in other programs or documentation either as a 'Device ID', or a 'License Key'. This is used to identify the specific device you are using. It is permanently set in a PDA, and cannot be changed. If a customer needs to change the license key attached to their account, they should contact ASellerTool. Please note, as this screen states, there are no letter 'o's in the Device ID, only the number zero (0).

Database: This box currently shows what path the program is looking in for the pricing database. This can be useful in determining if the PDA is looking at the right directory for the data, or if it's looking at the wrong memory card, or an 'extra' SD Card folder.

Enable Hidden Mode/Admin: These two fields are used to enable and disable Hidden Mode on the PDA. When enabled, Hidden Mode removes all information about a book, including pricing, conditions, amount in groups, number available, and sales rank. Only the item's title and a 'BUY', 'REJECT' or 'WATCH LIST' rating will appear.

Save: Pressing 'Save' at the bottom left of the screen will save any changes made to the Account screen. You will then be returned to the program's main screen.

Cancel: Pressing 'Save' at the bottom right of the screen will discard any changes made to the Account screen, and return you to the program's main screen.

Enabling/Disabling Hidden Mode

Hidden mode can be enabled or disabled by going to the account screen, checkmark 'Enable Hidden Mode', and then enter a password in the Admin box. When you click 'Save' on the bottom left hand side of the screen, Hidden Mode will be enabled with the same password that you set into the Admin box. To disable it, go back to the account screen, remove the checkmark next to 'Enable Hidden Mode', and then enter the same password you used when you set Hidden Mode up. When you press 'Save', you will go back to the main screen, with Hidden Mode disabled.



Make sure you remember your Hidden Mode password! If you forget this password, you will not be able to disable Hidden Mode without contacting ASellerTool and going through a remote support session. It is advised that you make the password something simple to remember, or make a note of it somewhere you can access.

Data Test: Check downloaded database, if pricing information appears, that means the data is good and can be used.

Buy: If an item is showing 'Buy', then it is automatically added to the buy.txt file. If it does not give you a buy signal, you can click this item to manually add this item to the buy.txt file.

Main: Allows you to go to main screen

Title: Allows you to go to the title search screen.

Tips: Opens up to the Tips Screen.

Watch List: Setup your watch list.

Data Test

You can verify that the data on your SD card is working properly by selecting the 'Data Test' feature in the select Menu. This will check the licenses and data files afresh to ensure all information is intact and functioning properly.

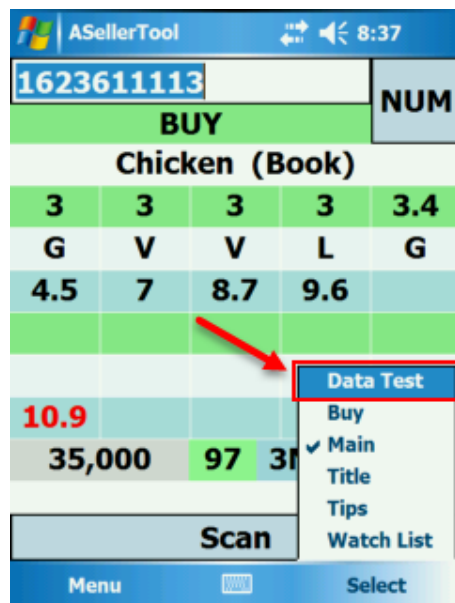

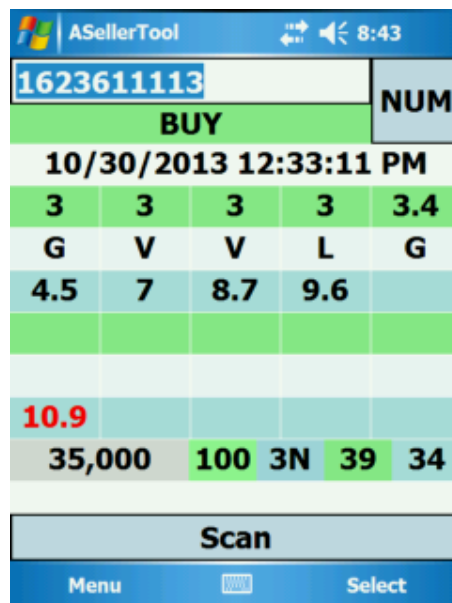

If data appears on the screen, with a date and time on the top where the title is normally listed, data is properly stored on the SD card at this time. If you do get an error message instead (such as 'Config File is Missing', 'Wrong License', or 'An error message is'), you will want to conduct a fresh data download to clear it. If you get this error message after more than one fresh data download, your SD card may be defective.

The date and time listed on the top is the date the database currently on the SD card was generated. This is **not** the same as when the database was last downloaded; the generated database may be a few hours older than the time you last initiated your download. If it's more than 24 hours older than the last download you started, you will want to download again; if the date is still off by that much, please try another SD card, or contact support

Title Search

For old books that do not have ISBN barcode, you can perform title search by tapping Select ->Title.

✿ Please make sure you have already downloaded data with the title search information included before using Title Search.

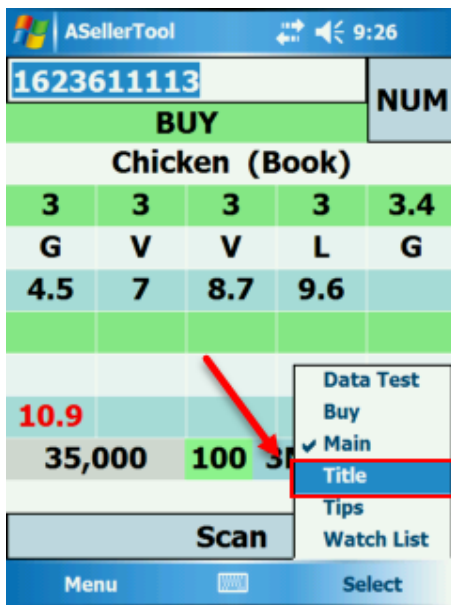

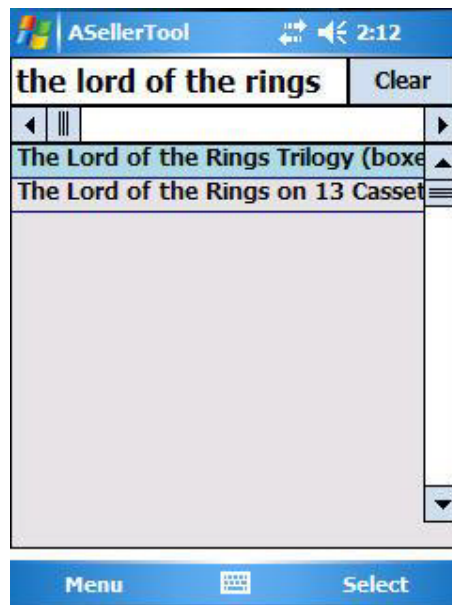

Tap the keyboard symbol at the bottom center of the screen to enter the title. Our program will start to search when you tap the 'Space Bar' after each word. The returned candidate list will be refined after each additional word entered and the Space Bar is pressed.

Use vertical scroll bar to go through the candidate list. You can also use the horizontal scroll bar to go view the rest of a long title.

If you want to clear your current search and start anew, press the 'Clear' button on the top right hand side to clear the title search box.

To return to the Main Screen, tap a title that appears, or tap 'Select' on the bottom right hand side, followed by 'Main'.

In various parts of the program, you may need to enter text and/or numbers into certain fields. In order to do this, you can use the Virtual Keyboard that is included in the Windows Mobile Operating System.

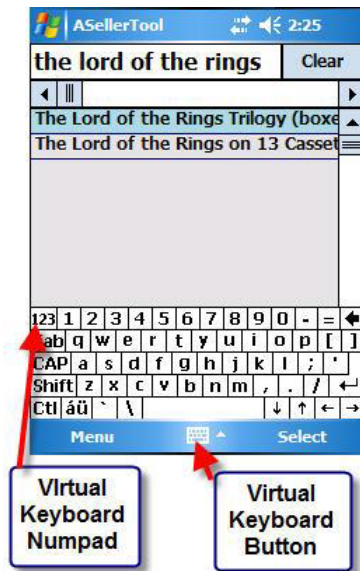

To activate the keyboard, tap the 'Virtual Keyboard Button' with your stylus, then tap the letters and numbers you wish to enter into the text box. You may have to tap the text box you wish to input in first, so a blinking cursor appears in that field.

Some configurations may have numbers running across the top of the Virtual Keyboard. If you wish to enter the numbers from a different format, you can go to the Virtual Keyboard Numpad by pressing the '123' button on the virtual keyboard.

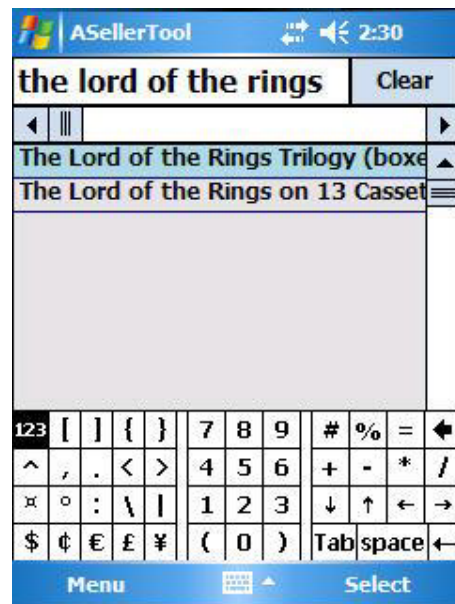

To return to the normal keyboard, simply press the '123' button again.

Tips Screen

The Tips screen shows useful tips and tricks for getting the most out of the PDA software. It is set to come up automatically on start-up, and can also be accessed through the Select menu.

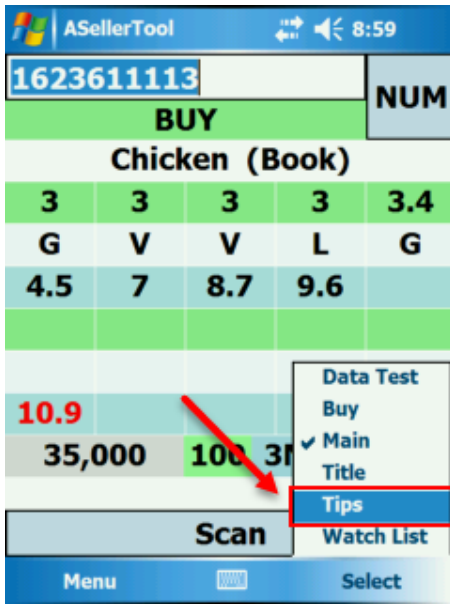

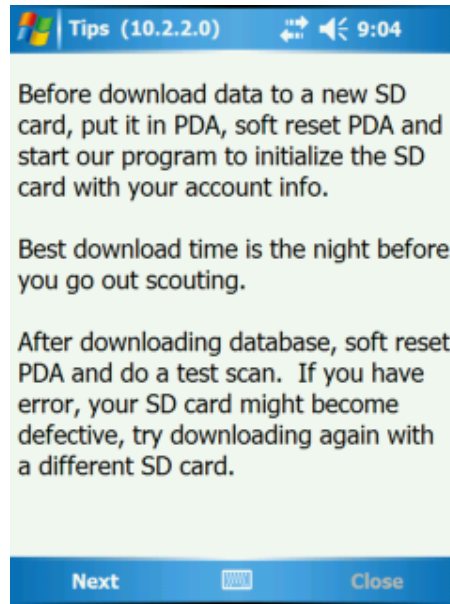

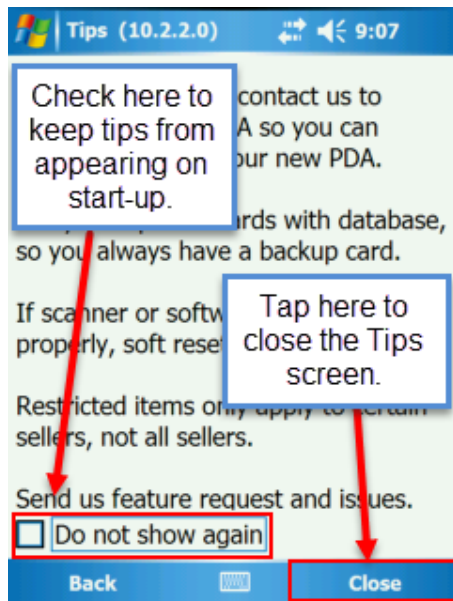

The Tips screen will display the version number of the PDA program at the very top, next to 'Tips'. There are some interesting tips on both screens listed here. Clicking Next on the first screen will bring you to the second, where you can both close the Tips screen, and ensure that the screen does not appear on Start-up if you do not wish it to.

Watch List

The Watch List section allows you to add ISBNs that would when scanned normally come up as a 'BUY' or as a 'REJECT' will instead come up as 'WATCH LIST'.

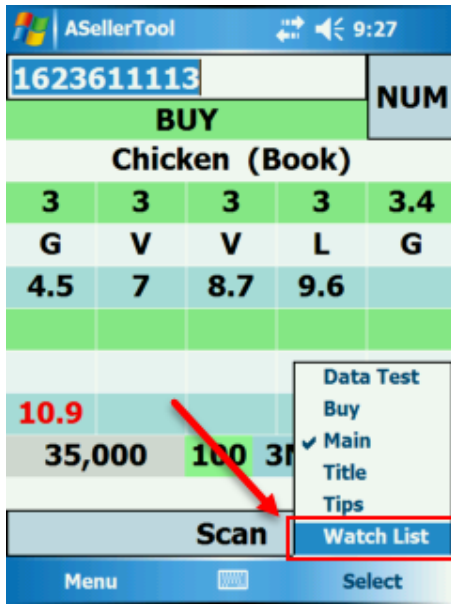

Top Text Box: Either the PDA's virtual keyboard, or the scanner connected to the PDA can be used. The scanner should automatically add scanned barcodes to the Watch List, while manually entering them using the virtual keyboard will require you to press the 'Enter' key, or using the 'Add New Watch' option in the Watch List's Menu.

My Watch List: This list contains all the barcodes that you current have added to the

Watch List. They can be selected by tapping on them.

Add New Watch: Tapping this button with a barcode entered into the Top Text Box will add that barcode to the 'My Watch List' section.

Remove a Watch: Tapping this button with a barcode selected on the 'My Watch List' section will remove that item from the Watch List itself.

Clear Watch List: Tapping this button will bring up a warning dialog box asking if you would like to clear your whole Watch List. Tapping 'No' will return you to the intact Watch List. Tapping 'Yes' will return you to a cleared 'Watch List' section.

Close: This button on the bottom right hand side will close the Watch List section, and bring you back to the main ASellerTool screen.



The 'Enable Watch List' checkbox must be checked and saved on the Program Setting screen in order for the 'Watch List' result to come up. If this is not checked, the Watch List will be set, but items on the Watch List will come up with the standard 'BUY' or 'REJECT' rating.

Troubleshooting

Config File Missing

Get “Config File Missing” error message

There are 2 solutions to this error message:

Solution 1: Your current SD card is defective.

1. Take out SD card
2. Replace with your back up SD card.
3. Try to scan again.

We recommend you always have multiple SD cards with you. Please see [here](#).

Solution 2: (If you do not have a backup card)

1. Complete a successful data download.
2. Soft Reset PDA.
3. Try scanning again.

Wrong or Invalid License

Get “Invalid License” error message

Solution 1: Your current SD card is defective. If you follow our [Multiple SD Cards](#) recommendation, you can quickly switch to your another SD card.

1. Take out SD card
2. Replace with your back up SD card.
3. Try to scan again.

We recommend you always have multiple SD cards with you. Please see [here](#).

Solution 2: The database on the SD card is for a different PDA to use. [Here is a video](#) to show you the whole process.

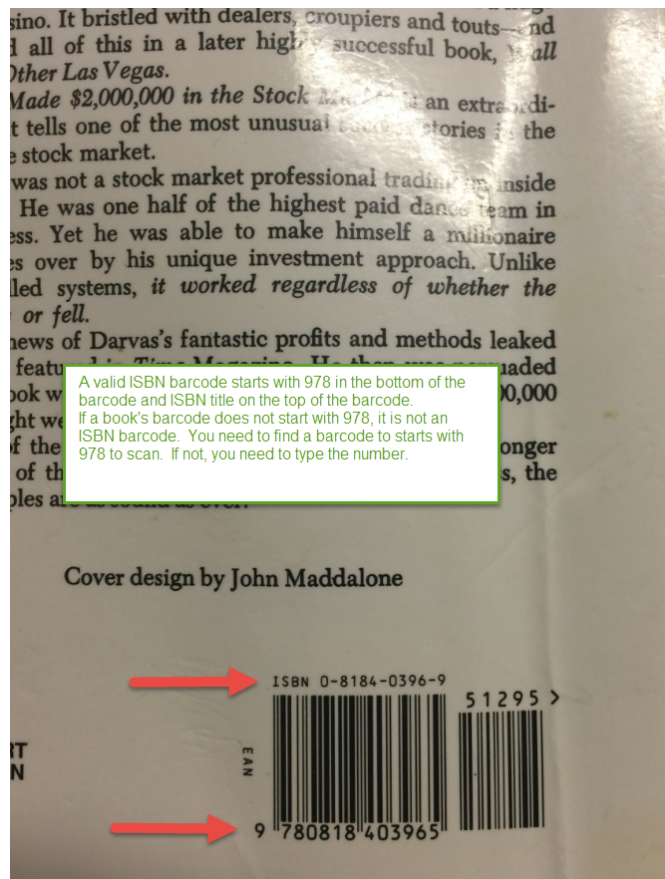
1. Make sure the SD card is in the current PDA you are going to use.
2. Open ASellerTool program on that PDA.
3. Tap **Menu** then **Account**.
4. Verify the account information is correct, then tap **Save**. This will save your account information and current PDA machine key to the SD card, so the PC downloader can read from.
5. Pull out SD card from the PDA and use PC downloader to download to the SD card again.

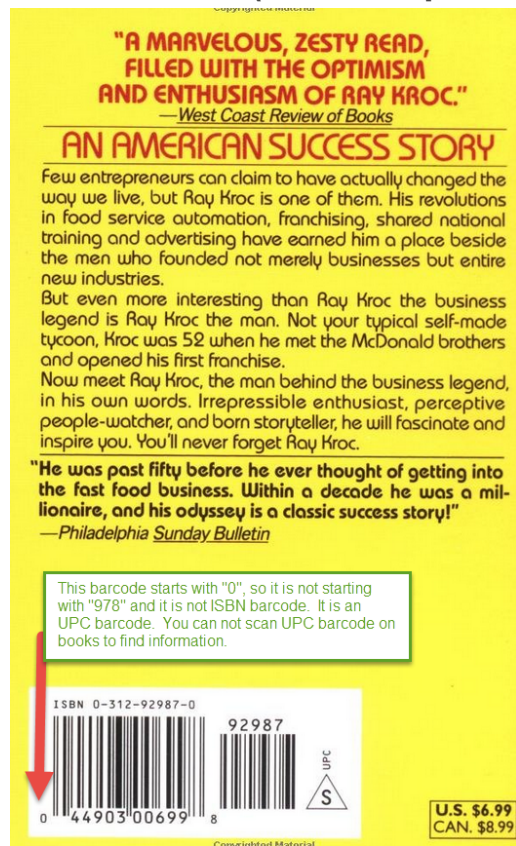

1. When scanning books, make sure you scan the ISBN barcode starting with **978**, and not the UPC barcode starting with 0 or 1.
2. For pocket sized books (**Mass Market Paperback**), the ISBN barcode is on the first page. The barcode on the back of the book is UPC code.
3. Make sure you select at least these symbology in Socket scanner settings from PDA. How to video is [here](#).

Soft Reset Dell Axim X51 PDA

There is a little hole on the back of your Dell Axim X51 PDA. It is above the battery compartment. You use stylus to press the little hole. This will cause the PDA to soft reset.

Best Practice

Multiple SD Cards

You download the pricing database to a SD card. Our program on PDA will search this database on the SD card to return the pricing information.

So it is **Mission Critical** to have **multiple SD cards** with you when you go out scouting. If your current SD card fail in the field, you can quickly switch to another SD card with a bit older data.



If you have **only one SD card** inside the PDA with no backup SD cards available and that SD card gives you an error, then you can not scan items to get pricing information and ruin your business opportunity.

We recommend users to do the following:

- Day 1, download data to SD card A.
- Day 2, download data to SD card B.
- Day 3, download data to SD card C.
- Day 4, download data to SD card A again.

When you go out scouting, bring SD card A, B and C with you. So if SD card A fail or PDA give you weird error message, you can switch to SD card B or C with a bit older data to try again.



It is very important to keep minimum 3 working SD cards with database. You can order extra 2GB SD card [here](#)

After you get a new SD card, make sure you [setup the SD card](#) with your current PDA first before downloading database to the card.

PC Downloader

Our PC Downloader software will allow you to download the database to the SD card via a SD card reader. Then you can insert the SD card into your PDA. After you scan an item, ASellerTool program on the PDA will be able to search the database from the SD card and return the pricing information.

Setting up your New SD Card or Old Card from Another PDA

* Please make sure your SD card size is 2 GB. If your SD card is larger than 2GB, it is called SDHC card and you need to install [this software](#) on your PDA before your PDA can read the SDHC card. 1GB or less SD card is not large enough to hold database.

You need to setup the SD card when you meet these scenarios below:

1. Get a new SD card.
2. Use a SD card from another PDA.
3. You changed to another PDA. If you can not download, contact us to unlock your user ID from your previous PDA.
4. When you try to download to a SD card, PC downloader gives you an error message.

You need to setup this SD card with your current PDA before you can use PC Downloader to download database to this SD card. Otherwise your current PDA cannot read database from the SD card

[Here is a video](#) on how to do it.

Please follow the steps below to setup your new SD card:

1. Insert your SD card into the PDA you are currently using.
2. Open ASellerTool program on the PDA, tap 'Menu' on the bottom left, followed by 'Account'.
3. Confirm that your **user ID** and **password** are correctly entered on the PDA, then tap 'Save' at the bottom left. The new SD card now contains your account and current PDA information, which will be used by PC Downloader to download correct database for this PDA to use.

! Having **multiple SD cards** with you during scouting is very critical. SD card can stop functioning at any time. When that happens, our program can no longer read pricing info from the database on the SD card. So when you download database, you should alternate between SD cards (we recommend having 3 SD cards). Having several extra SD cards with recent database allows you to continue scanning with a different card when your current card suddenly stops working. You can order more SD cards [here](#).

Downloading to the SD Card (Recommended)

Please follow the steps below:

1. If it is a new SD card, or a SD card from a different PDA, or you just change to a different PDA, you need to **setup your SD card** with your current PDA before you can use PC downloader to download the **compatible database** to this SD card for your current PDA to use. Instruction is [here](#).
2. Take the SD card out of the PDA.
 - a. The card is underneath a top-mounted (Socket CF) scanner on the PDA.
 - b. You need to **gently** pull the scanner out first. Do not use force or bend scanner. This will cause scanner to be wobbly after a few times.
 - c. After you pull out scanner, you will see the SD card. Push the SD card down, then release. The SD slot is spring-loaded, so this will pop the SD card away from the PDA.
3. Insert the SD card into your computer's SD/MMC slot, or into a USB SD card reader.
4. Insert the USB SD card reader into a USB port of your computer.

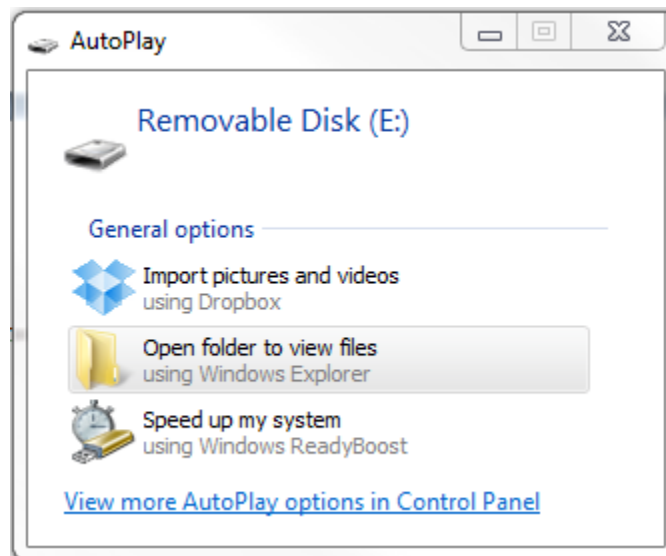


SD Card with USB SD Card Reader



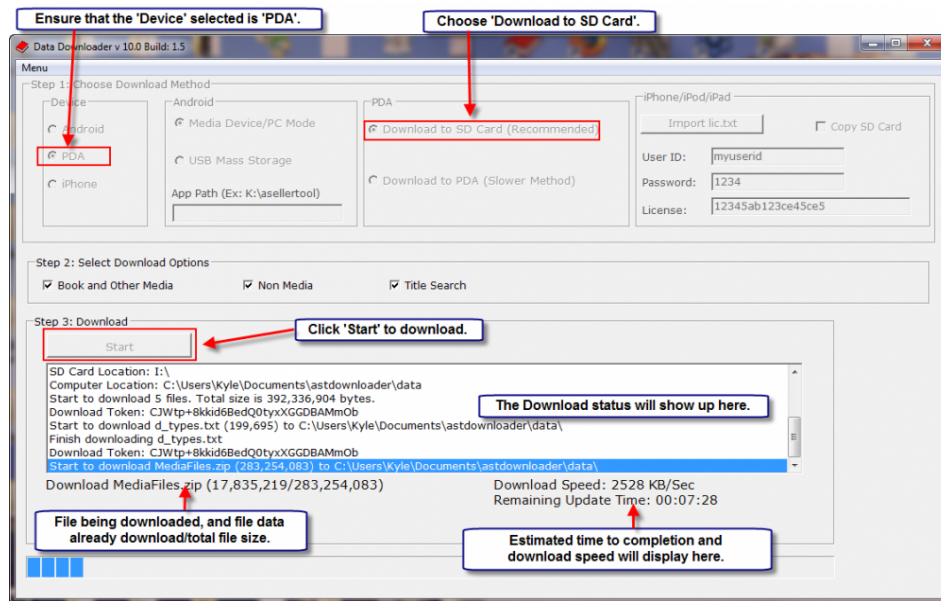
Inserting the USB SD Card Reader or SD Card into the Computer

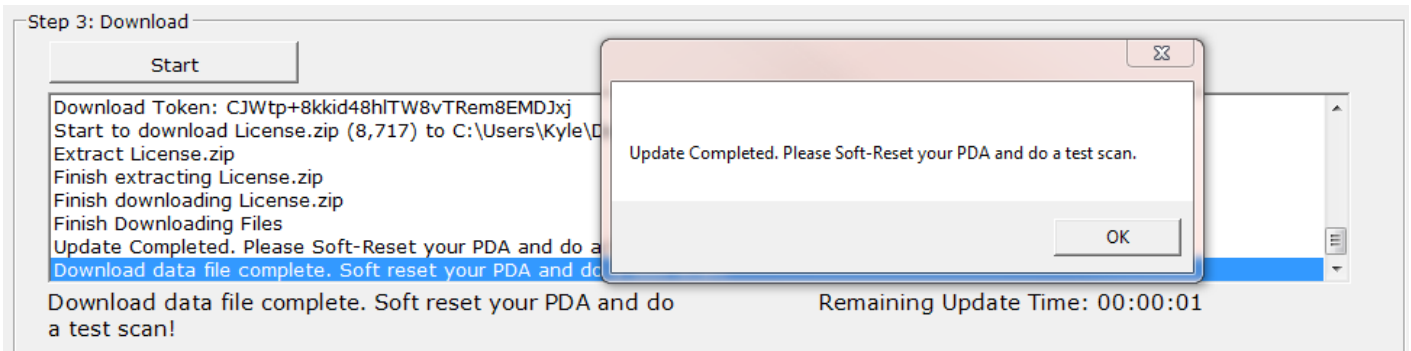
SD Card AutoPlay Window

10. When the program runs again, you can scan several familiar items to make sure the price is correct.



It is important to always soft reset the PDA and test the data after a download so our program can read the new database correctly. We also recommend alternating the cards you use to download, and carrying multiple SD cards when out scouting (see Setting Up Your SD Card).

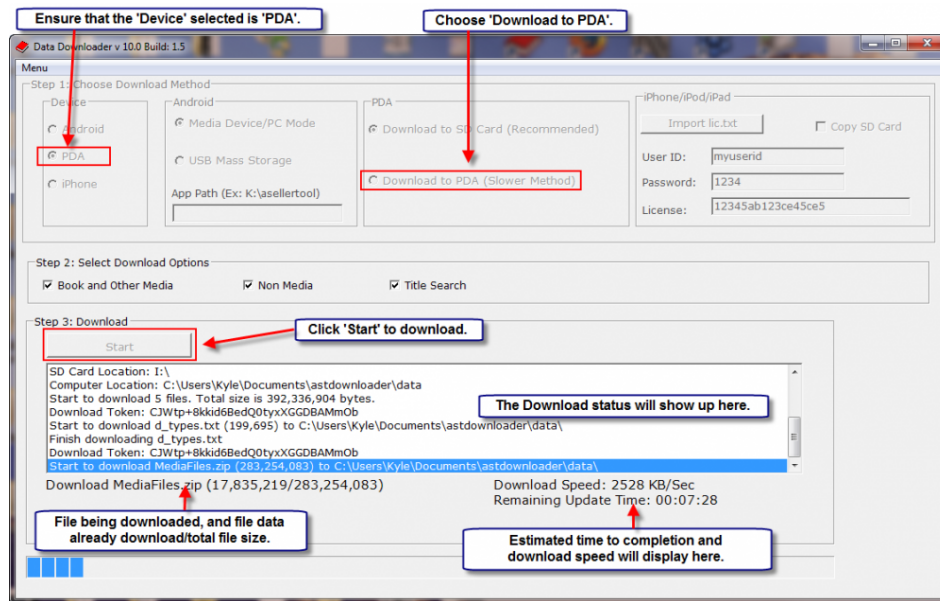

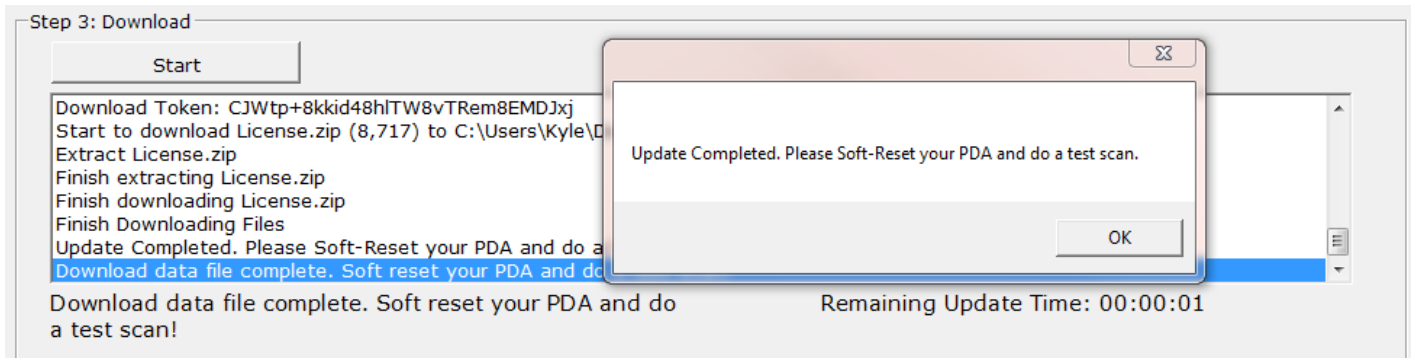

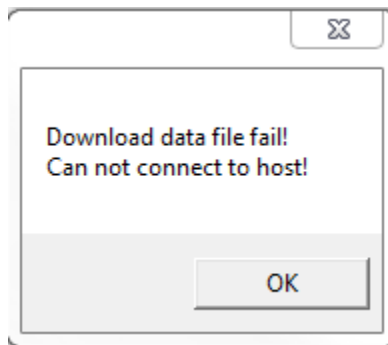

Download Failed: Cannot Connect to host

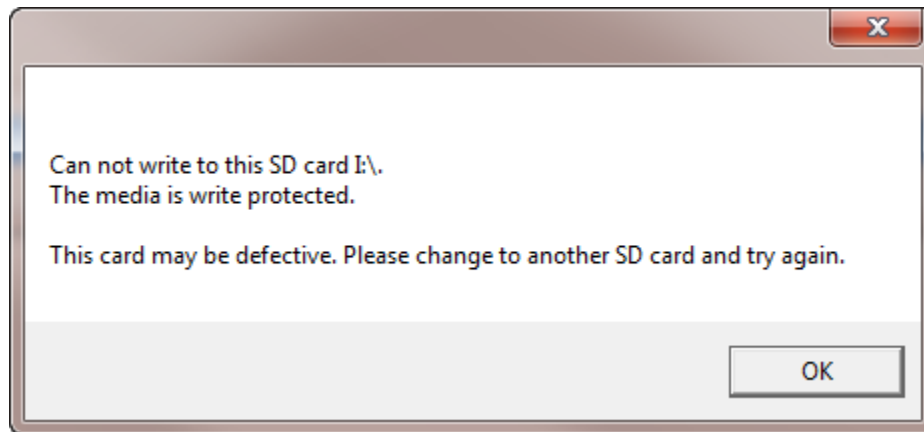


Verify your computer has an active internet connection by going to a popular website, like www.google.com. If you can get to this website, most likely a firewall/anti-virus program is blocking our program from downloading. Disable any Firewall/Anti-Virus software on the PC and attempt the download again.

Download Failed: Account is inactive

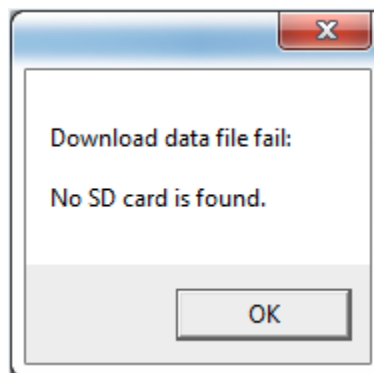
Download Failed: PDA not 9.5

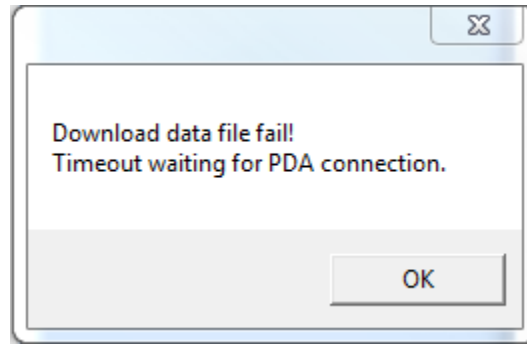
If you do have 9.5 or above on your PDA, your SD card is not set up with your account yet. You need to insert the card into the PDA, tapping 'Menu', and then 'Account', followed by 'Save'. Attempt the download to the SD card once more after this.

Download Failed: No SD card found



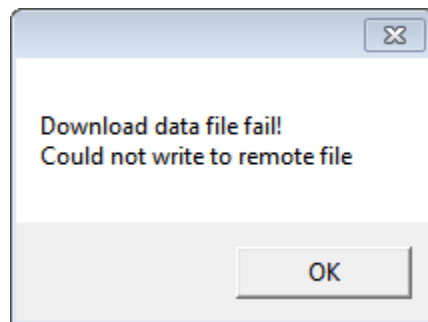
The PC does not have an SD card inserted or the SD card itself has become defective. Plug in a new 2 GB SD card into PDA and perform a soft reset to set it up, and then try the download again.

Download Failed: Timeout



Your PDA is NOT connected to your PC through Windows Mobile Device Center. Disconnect the USB cord and perform a Soft Reset on PDA. Once PDA boots up, reconnect the USB cord and check ActiveSync/WMDC for connection status to ensure the show as connected, such as in Figures 7 or 8. After this, you can attempt the download again.

Download Failed: Could not write to Remote File



This error message appears when the program cannot copy the downloaded data from the computer to the SD card. Check the SD card's lock slider to ensure the card isn't write protected. If the card isn't write protected, reinsert the SD card and do a soft reset on the PDA, before reconnecting it to the computer, and trying the download again. If this doesn't work, the SD card may be defective. You should attempt to use a new 2 GB card and try the download again.

NORTON ANTI-VIRUS USERS: Norton SONAR opens, and program will not open afterward

This error can appear when running Norton anti-virus, where the installation or running of the PC Downloader on this computer causes a 'false positive' to show up on Norton. The next time you run the PC Downloader, it tries to access the PC Downloader program, but asks that you select the installer file to reinstall certain components.

If you reach this message, you will want to close this dialog box, and add the C:\Program Files (x86)\Asellertool Inc. folder to Norton's exclusions for both normal and SONAR virus scanning, before reinstalling PC Downloader.



While this is a recorded issue with Norton Anti-Virus programs, it may be present in other AV programs as well. If you do have a problem with PC Downloader, you may want to disable your Anti-Virus for a short while, or add PC Downloader to the excluded list to see if that improves the issue.

Setting up your Android Smartphone

Perquisites

In order to use the PC Downloader, customers must have a computer running a Windows Operating system, using Windows XP, Vista, 7, or 8. Customers using Mac computers should follow our instructions at [Mac Downloader for Android](#).

Android devices will require our FBAScan for Android app, version 3.0 or above. If you have FBAScan installed, enter FBAScan on your device, then tap the Menu button on the device itself. The version number is on top of this page.

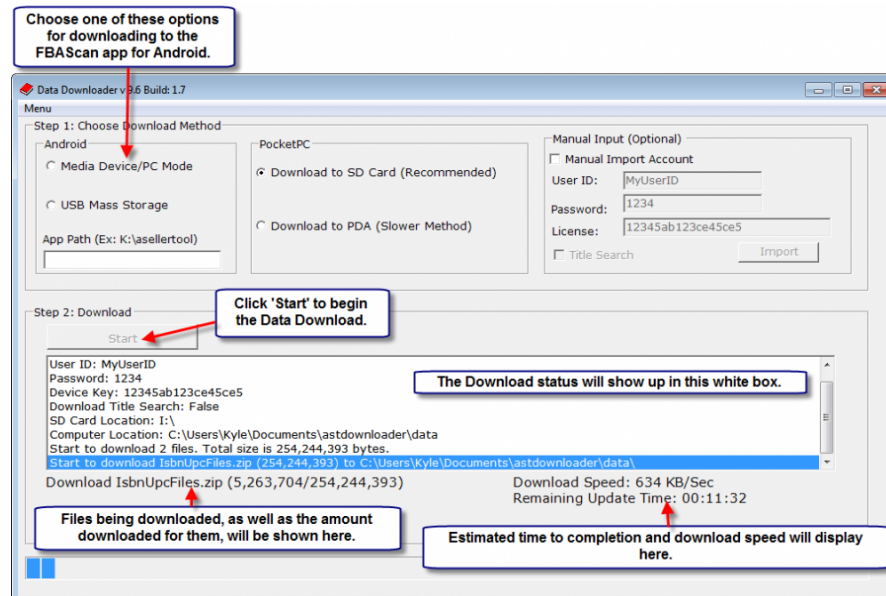
If you don't have FBAScan installed, or the current version is not 3.0 or higher, please go to the Google Play Store, and search for 'FBAScan'. This should allow you to install FBAScan or update it to the latest version.

Setup

Ensure that your device is not connected to your computer before changing the User ID or Password. If you do change the User ID and Password with the PDA connected, disconnect and reconnect the device before attempting a download. 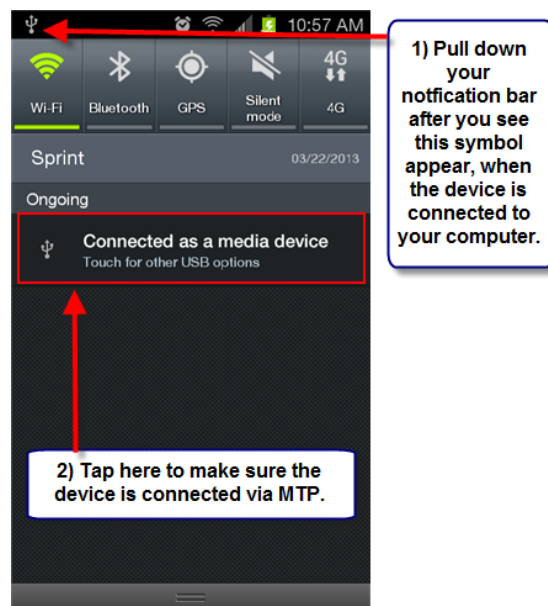

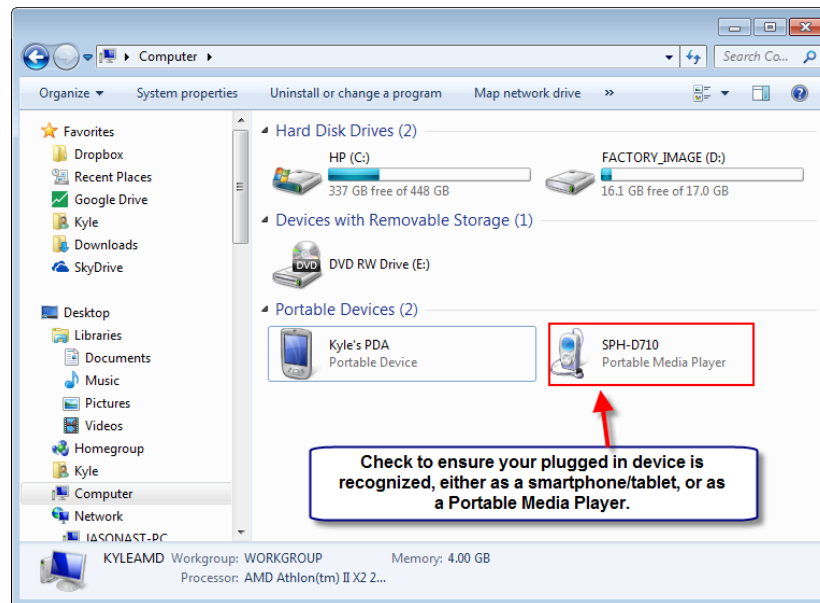

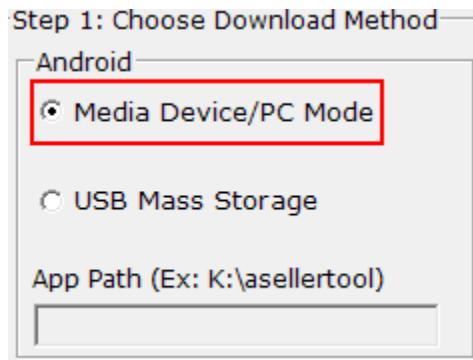
To setup your device in Media Device (MTP)/PC Mode, follow the steps below after connecting the device to the computer.

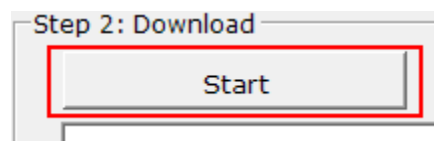

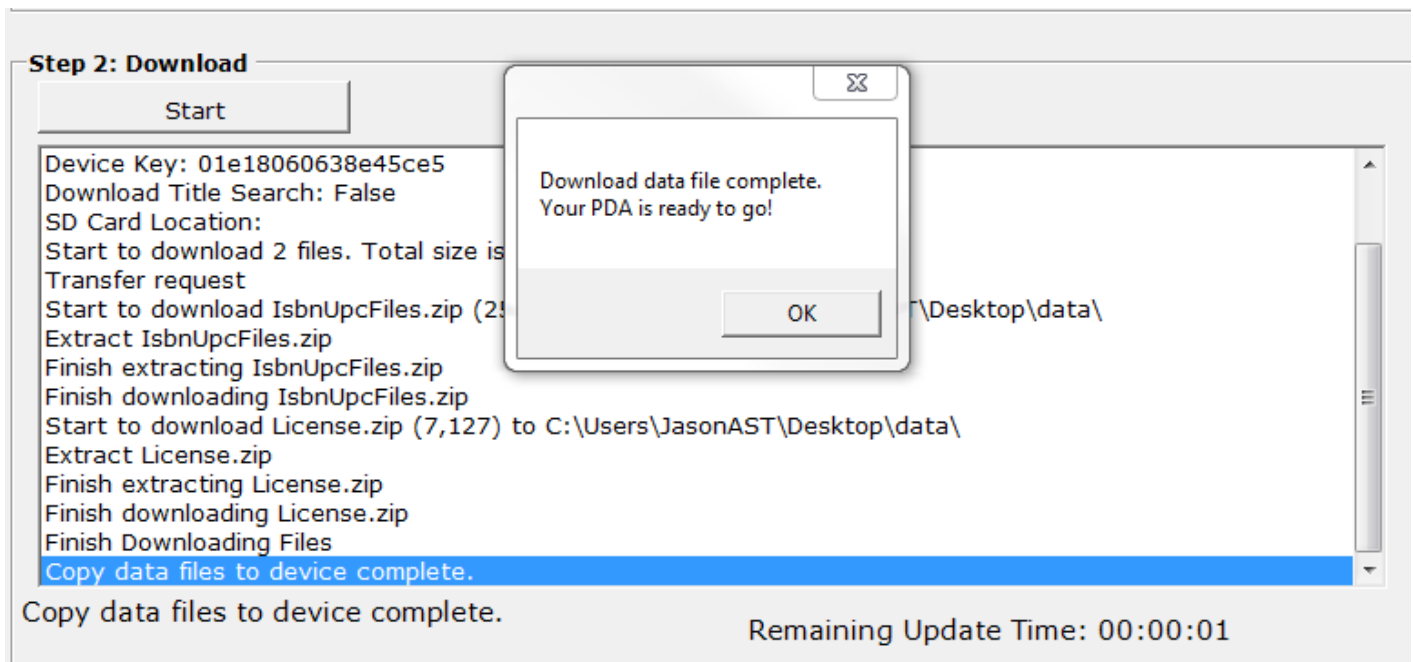

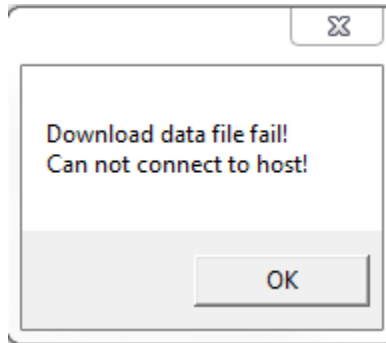
USB Mass Storage

Troubleshooting

Download Failed: Cannot Connect to Host

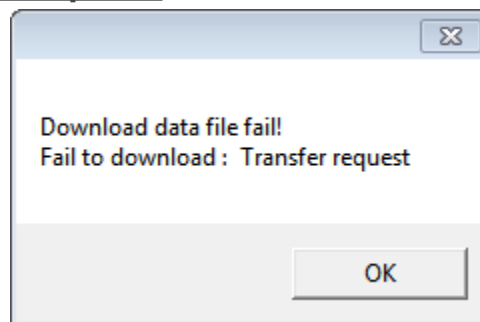


PC Downloader cannot connect to Asellertool hosting servers. Verify your computer has an active internet connection by using a browser. If an internet connection is present but download does not start, most likely a firewall/anti-virus program is blocking it. Disable any Firewall/Anti-Virus software on the computer and attempt the download again.



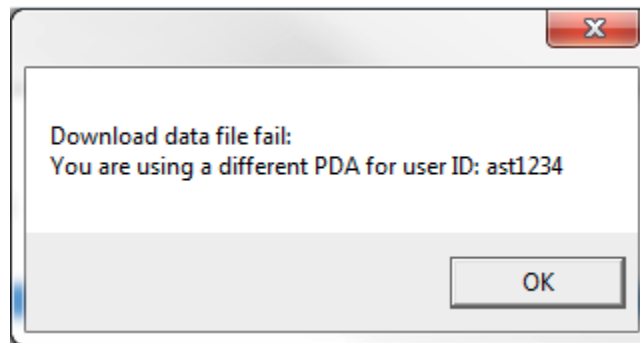

Download Failed: Transfer Request.



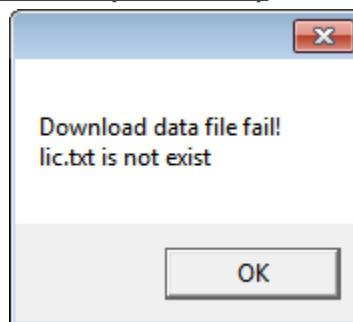
If you receive this error, it usually means that your connection with the download server was broken in the middle of downloading, and the program was not able to reconnect with it. This normally indicates that your internet connection went down in the middle of the download itself. Please make sure to check you are still connected to the internet before attempting the download again. If you have problems connecting to the Internet, you may wish to contact your Internet service provider.

Download Failed: Wrong License



This message indicates the license key on your PDA does not match your account info from our servers. If you have recently changed PDAs or want to transfer your account to a new PDA, please contact Asellertool Support at www.asellertool.com/support/Contact.htm.

Download Failed: Lic.txt is not exist (Android)

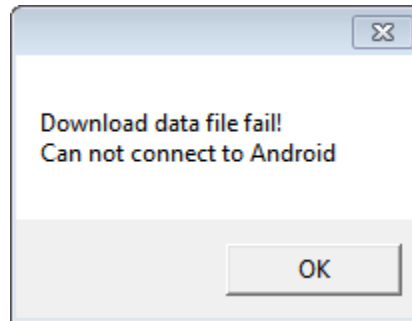


This error message will appear when attempting to download to a device in USB Mass Storage mode, like an Android smartphone. It means that there is no lic.txt file in the path typed in. Please make sure you:

- 2) Have the proper path to the 'asellertool' folder typed in, without any typos.

Download Failed: No Android Connection



This error message will appear if the Downloader does not detect an attached Android device when attempting to download in Media Device/PC Mode. If it does not show up in the 'Computer' window when it is connect, please try another USB port or cord, or look to see if drivers have to be updated.

Alternative Download Methods

We do have a backup method of downloading called a 'Web Download'. This will have you log into a website and download the data files directly through your Web Browser, and then manually copy them from the computer to the SD card, or to the proper directory on your Android device. A tutorial on downloading to the SD card in this way can be found at www.asellertool.com/support/WebDownload.htm, and the download itself can be found at www.asellertool3.com/WebDownload90/Download.aspx.



The Web Download method should **only** be used if you are unable to download to the smartphone via WiFi or PC Downloader, as it has more steps and can be more complicated. If you feel you may need to do a Web Download, please contact us at www.asellertool.com/contact.html.

Mac Downloader for Android



Unfortunately, there is no automated program on the Mac like PC Downloader, which can download and transfer the database files to your Android phone automatically. It is strongly suggested that, if you cannot download the database through WiFi, customers with access to a Windows computer use that computer to do the download.

If you must download onto a Mac, you will need an SD card that's 2 GB or larger.

1. In the FBAScan program on your Android device, tap your device's Menu button, and then 'Account'.
2. On this page, tap the 'Email account button to Email a copy of your account information to yourself.
3. Locate this e-mail, and download the attached lic.txt file. Place this file on the SD card.
4. Follow the instructions in Section 2 of <http://www.asellertool.com/support/PCDownload.htm> to both install and run the Mac Data Downloader. Start to download data with the SD card inserted into the computer, and wait until it says the data has been successfully downloaded.
5. Download and install the Android File Transfer software for Mac, located at <http://www.android.com/filetransfer/> . Follow the instructions here to both install and use the file transfer software.
6. Using the software above, locate the current 'data' folder on your Android device, normally located at /sdcard/asellertool/data . Delete this folder.
7. On your computer in a Finder window, go to your Downloads folder, and then into the 'astdownloader' folder. Copy the 'data' folder here into the /sdcard/asellertool folder on your Android Device.
8. Wait for this information to copy over completely. Once you have the data fully downloaded, make sure to test it by pressing the 'Menu' button on your device, and then the 'Data Test' option. If the device displays data for a test barcode at that time, the database has been downloaded successfully, and you may start using FBAScan with an updated database.

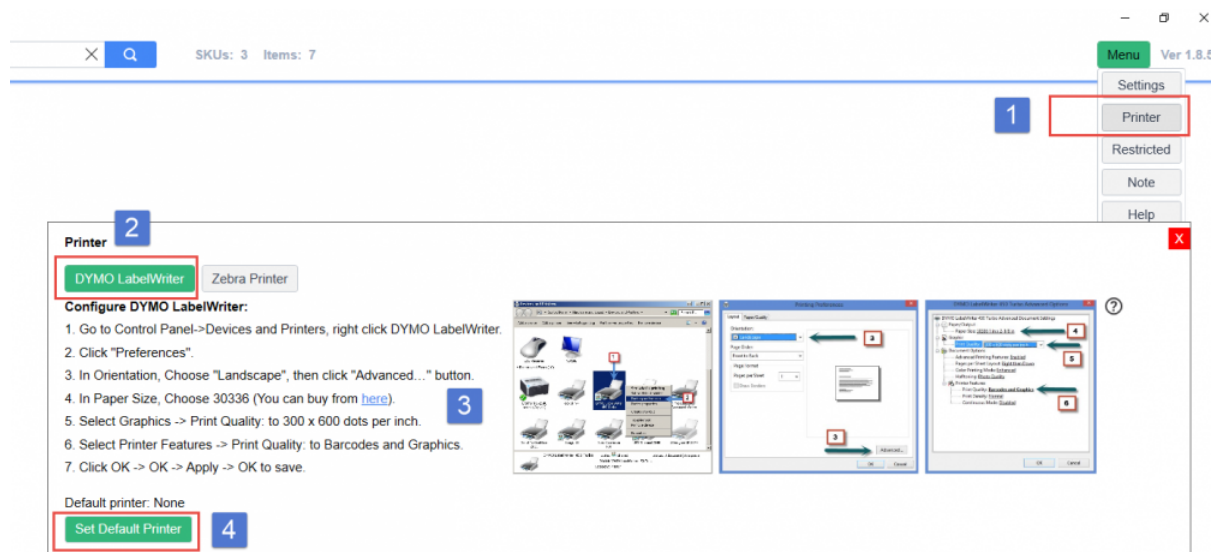

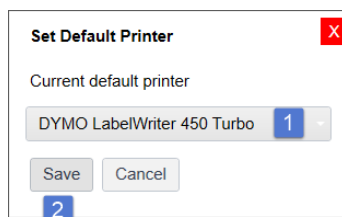



Reason:

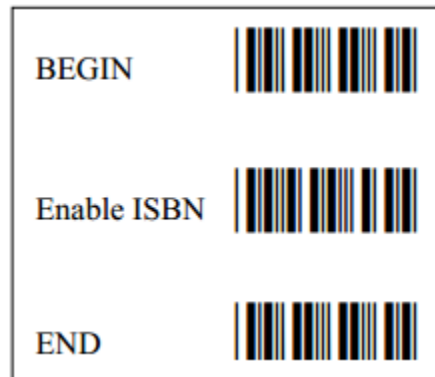
4. When using OPN2002 scanner to scan the pin number during pairing, make sure you scan the **End** barcode as last.



Some users of the Opticon 2002 may see issues with scanning after connecting their scanner in HID mode. You may need to update the firmware of your Opticon 2002 to the most recent version for the device to work properly with FBAScan. Scanfob 2002/2005

✿ If you use Android phone, you can connect scanner via SPP mode. This will allow you to use phone's keyboard and scanner at the same time. HID mode will not allow you to use phone's keyboard when scanner is connected. We do not provide support on connecting scanner via SPP mode.

Opticon OPN-2006 or Scanfob 2006

1. From your phone, go to **Settings** -> **Bluetooth**, then disable Bluetooth on your phone. This will make sure the scanner is **Not** connected to the phone during the factory reset or configuration of the scanner.
2. Turn on your scanner, print the HID barcode below and scan it.

3. Turn on the Bluetooth and Connect scanner to your phone. Navigate to **Settings** -> **Bluetooth**. Turn the Bluetooth and search device. If you find the device's name starting with OPN in the device list, tap it to connect.

SerialMagic Gears for Scanfob

If you have a Scanfob scanner from SerialIO, you can connect the scanner to the phone with Serial Magic Gears.

To connect:

1. Print out the SPP Quickstart Guide from <https://serialio.com/support>.
2. Install and then open Serial Magic Gears on your phone.
3. Hold down the small button on the Scanfob scanner until the blue light starts blinking rapidly. Release the button, and wait for your scanner name to appear under 'Bluetooth devices' in the Wizard.
4. Tap the scanner name, and then tap 'OK' when asked if you would like to pair the scanner to the phone.
5. The scanner will beep once to indicate that it's connected. You swipe the arrow icon (A) left until you are at the last screen, then tap 'Apply Settings'.
6. Test that the scanner can scan inside Serial Magic Gears app.
7. Open FBAScan and scan items into the program.

To reconnect the scanner to the phone, Open Serial Magic Gears, hold down the large button on the scanner until the blue light starts blinking, and then tap on the scanner on the first page of the wizard; the scanner will connect automatically.

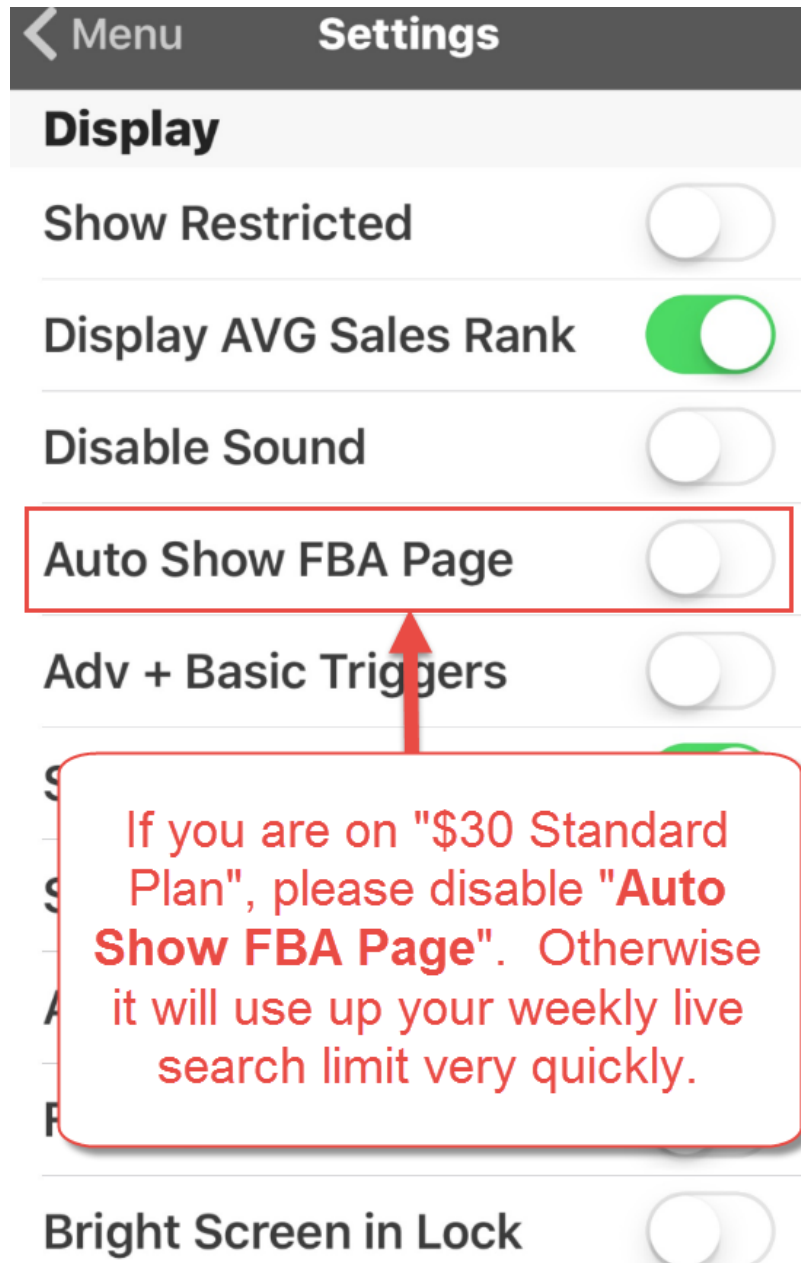

Error Code 11 If you are on standard plan and scan a lot of non media item, do not enable "Auto Show FBA Page". Otherwise you will use up your weekly live search limit very quickly and you will receive **Error Code 11** weekly live search limit reached. This is because for non media item, you scan UPC barcode. But on Amazon side, it uses ASIN to identify and that ASIN is different from UPC code. Our app needs to do live search behind the scene to

get the ASIN value for the non media item, then go to Amazon site with that ASIN to show you the FBA page for this item.

Issue

After scanning an item, I used to be able to select the column heading “FBA”, “New” and “Used” and you would display live additional details. Now no details are shown, just a close button with blank screen. Please [see video here](#) to understand this issue.

You need to upgrade your Android System Webview from Google Play Store.

Receive the message “not supported content type”

Issue:

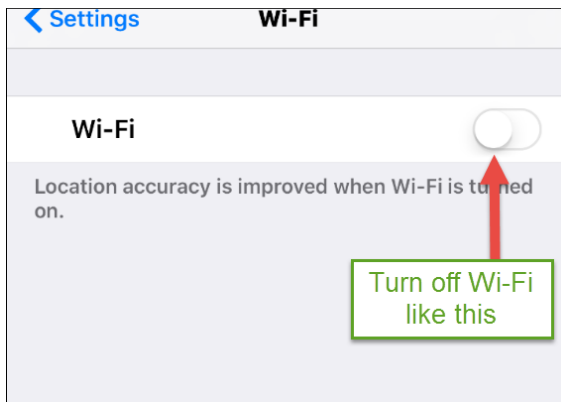
When you check item on your phone, the screen shows the message “**not supported content type**”

Cause:

If your phone connects to a public WiFi hot spot, it may ask for a security authentication or term agreement before an Internet connection can be made on this phone.

Solution:

- The easier way is just to disable WiFi on your phone, so you only use your phone company’s cellular data service. To turn off WiFi, go to phone -> Settings -> Wi-Fi and turns it off.

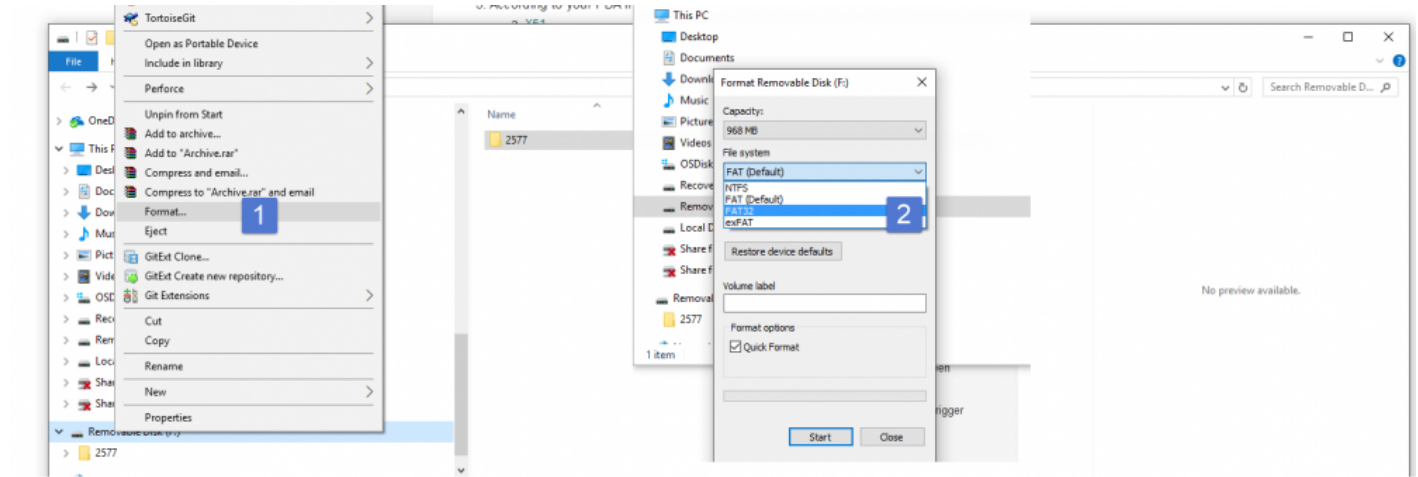


- The harder way is you start a browser, go to a website like <http://www.google.com>. The public WiFi will redirect you to a page either you need to login or agree to the term, before an Internet connection can be established in this WiFi network.

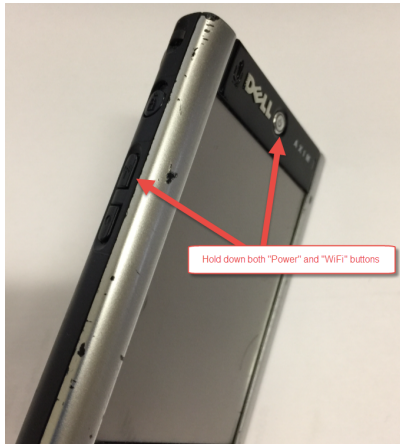
Upgrade Dell X51/X51V PDA to Rom A12

1. Backup all personal data from your PDA, as this will wipe out all your data.
2. Prepare a FAT32 SD Card (SDHC Cards do not work). 1GB or 2GB SD cards are fine.

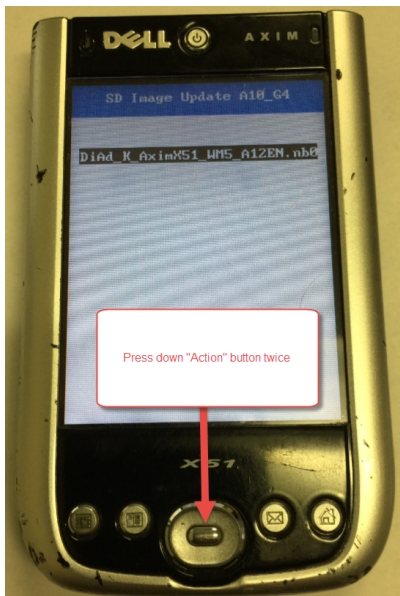


3. According to your PDA model, download zip file below and [unzip](#) your computer.
 - a. [X51](#)
 - b. [X51V](#)
4. Transfer 2 files to the SD Card.
 - a. X51: DiAd_K_AximX51_WM5_A12EN.nb0, DiAd_K_AximX51_WM5_A12EN_nb0.crc
 - b. X51V: DiAd_K_AximX51v_WM5_A12EN.nb0, DiAd_K_AximX51v_WM5_A12EN_nb0.crc
5. Insert SD card to your PDA and make sure either PDA is on AC charger or have full battery.
6. Holding down both “Power” and “WiFi” buttons, and press the “Reset” pin with a stylus. Continue to hold down “Power” and “WiFi” buttons until you see the SD Image updater screen.

7. Press the action key twice and wait for the Rom update to finish.



SDHC Card

Dell Axim X51/X51V PDA does not officially support SD card larger than 2GB. They are called SDHC card.

We found a software that allows your PDA to read SDHC card. Since this software is not officially supported by Dell, please use it at your own risk.

[Here is a video](#) to show you how to copy the driver to your SD card. Please make sure this installing SD card size is 2GB or less, so your PDA can recognize it.

1. Download the software [here](#).
2. Copy the cab file to a SD card
3. Insert the SD card to your PDA
4. Follow the instruction on your PDA to install this software
5. Your PDA should be able to read database from a SDHC card.

Can not Write to this SD Card during Downloading

If you see this error message: "Can not write to this SD card G:\. The media is write protected. This card may be defective. Please change to another SD card.

It is possible the SD card is locked. Please refer to this image to make sure the SD card is in **Unlocked** position.




If it is already in unlocked position, then try with a different SD card, different USB port and different SD card reader.

Remote Desktop Support

If you have issues with our desktop software like PC Downloader, Mac downloader, FBAListing or other software, it is best to allow us to remote to your desktop to troubleshoot.

IO Exception (IOException)

When you scan a book and the program reads **IO Exception**. It means either your SD card is defective or you did not download database properly.

To troubleshoot, please follow the steps below:

1. If you follow our [Multiple SD cards](#) recommendations, you can immediately try with your another card loaded with older database.
2. If you do not have a backup SD card, you need to go home and find a different SD card to download database. Make sure you setup your SD card.
3. If there is no IO Exception on your new card and you can scan items properly. Then your old card is defective and needs to be thrown away.
4. If there is still an IO Exception, then contact us so you can try with a different PDA.

Move to Another PDA

If you current PDA is defective and you want to use another PDA, please follow the instructions below:

1. Install our software on your new PDA. The best way to do that is to [clone](#) your PDA with our clone software if your PDA is Dell Axim X51 or X51V.
2. [Setup](#) all the SD cards you are using with your new PDA.
3. Doing a fresh download to the SD card that is already setup with your new PDA.
4. Insert SD card into the new PDA and test scan.

 If you have any error message during the steps above, please contact us.



If you just download database to your old PDA or already did a transfer within the next 6 months (except you bought PDA from us), we may have to wait for 7 days or charge a \$20 fee.

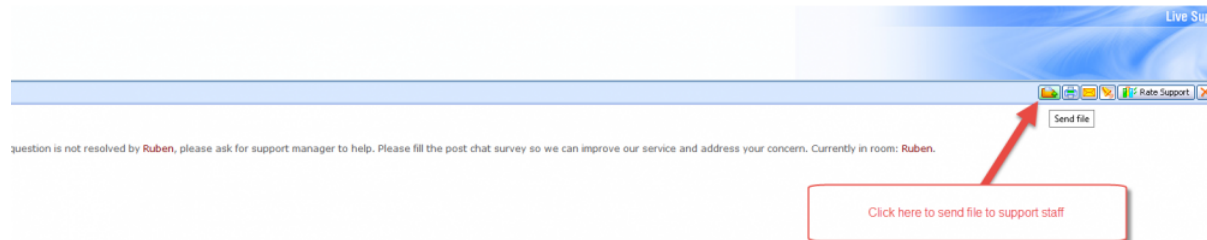
1. Go to Settings -> Buttons

You need to perform a factory reset on your scanner by following steps below:

1. Download the instruction [here](#)
2. Print out that document from a printer and scan the 2nd barcode to perform a factory reset on your scanner.
3. Check mark “*EAN Boolkand” symbology in Socket Symbology Selector by following [this video](#).
4. Pull the scanner **gently** from the PDA and insert again to finish.
5. Scan some items to make sure the scanner is now working properly.
