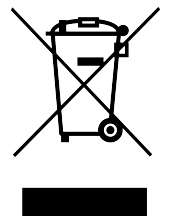
The device must be manipulated only by **qualified and skilled professionals** with specific technical knowledge to avoid a failure of the device due to an inappropriate manipulation.

Nayar Systems S.L. is not responsible for damage as a result of ignoring the indications and recommendations included in this manual.

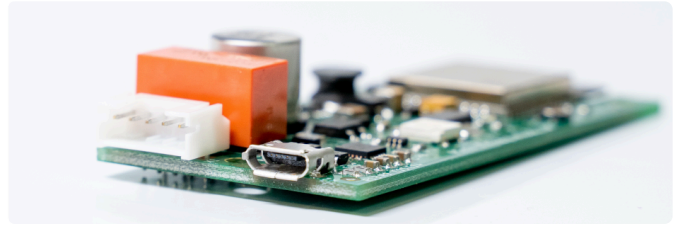
The device must not be wet neither installed in **humid places**.

2. Description of the product

nearkey



Nearkey is an access control device for electric drives using the smartphone. It substitutes keys and physical remotes for virtual ones. The system allows the management of users and groups in the cloud, ensuring maximum security in the facilities.

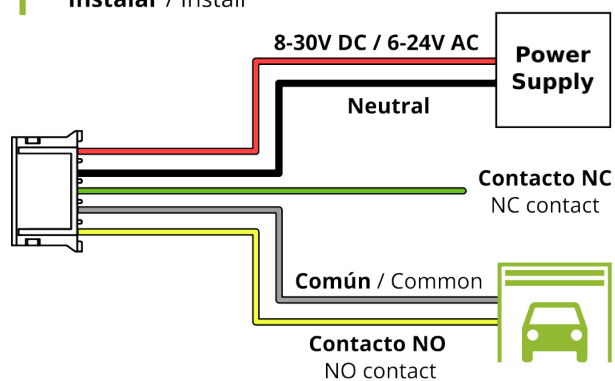
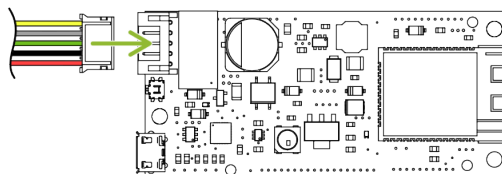

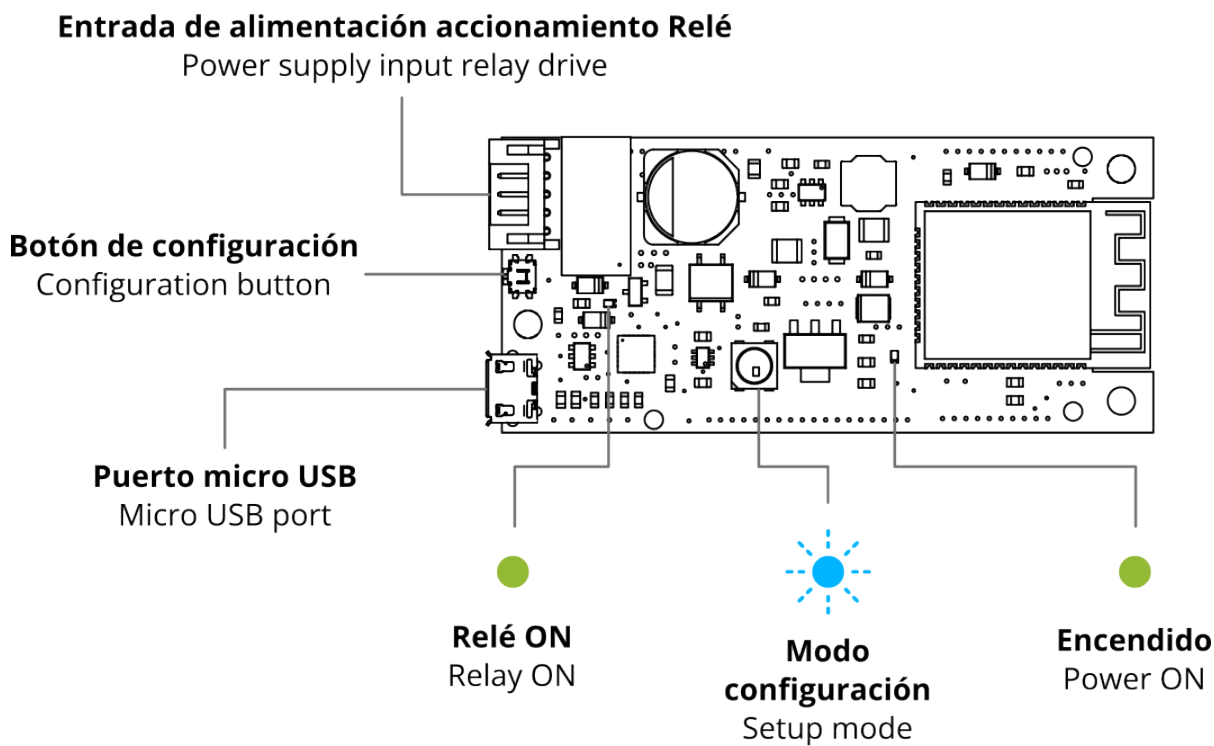

3. Installation and start-up

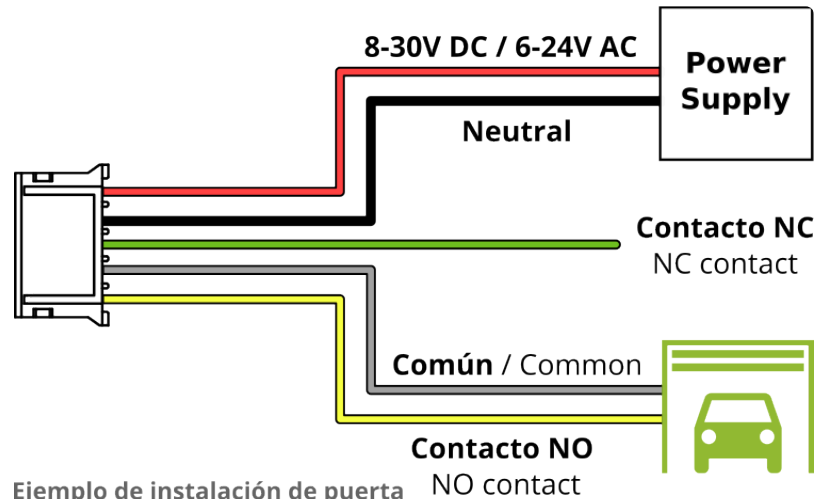
1. Before to install Nearkey, refer to the user's manual of the control unit. If it is going to be instal LED in a door's control unit, it must have a connection output for accessories.
2. Deactivate the power supply of the installation and make sure that the area where you are going to work is safe.
3. Access the control unit and search for the drive terminals indicated in the respective user manual.
4. Take the 5-way cable from the box.



5. Connect the grey cable (COM contact) and yellow cable (NO contact) or the green cable (NC contact), depending on the installation, to the terminals specified in the manual of your control unit to carry out the drive.

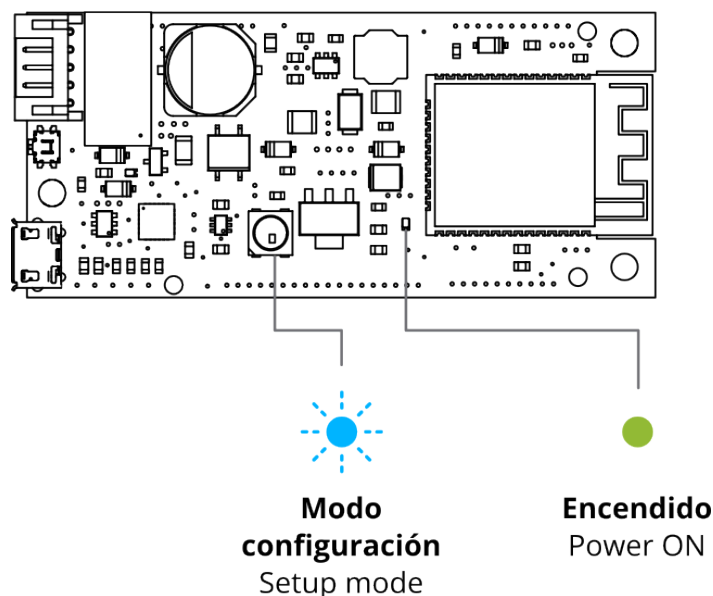
Connect the power input.

- If the installation has a power output between 8-30V DC or 6-24V AC, connect the red and black cables to this output, it does not influence the position of the cables, it is polarity independent.
- If your unit does not have a power output, we must provide Nearkey with an external power supply with a voltage between 8-30V DC or 6-24V AC. If you have a 220V socket, you must install a transformer with the following characteristics: 8 to 30V direct current (DC) or 6 to 24V alternating current (AC) that supplies more than 200Ma.

6. Install the device in a place insulated from water and humidity, making sure that the cables reach the device without exerting tension.
7. Use M3 screws for fixing if necessary.
8. Insulate unused cables with insulating tape or a hot shrink.
9. Connect the 5-way cable to the Nearkey connector.
10. Activate the power supply to the installation and check that the power LED is lit with green light. If Nearkey has never been configured, the blue configuration LED will be flashing.



If Nearkey only shows the green power light, this device has already been configured. If you do not have the necessary access permissions consider reading section [4.5. Nearkey reset](#).

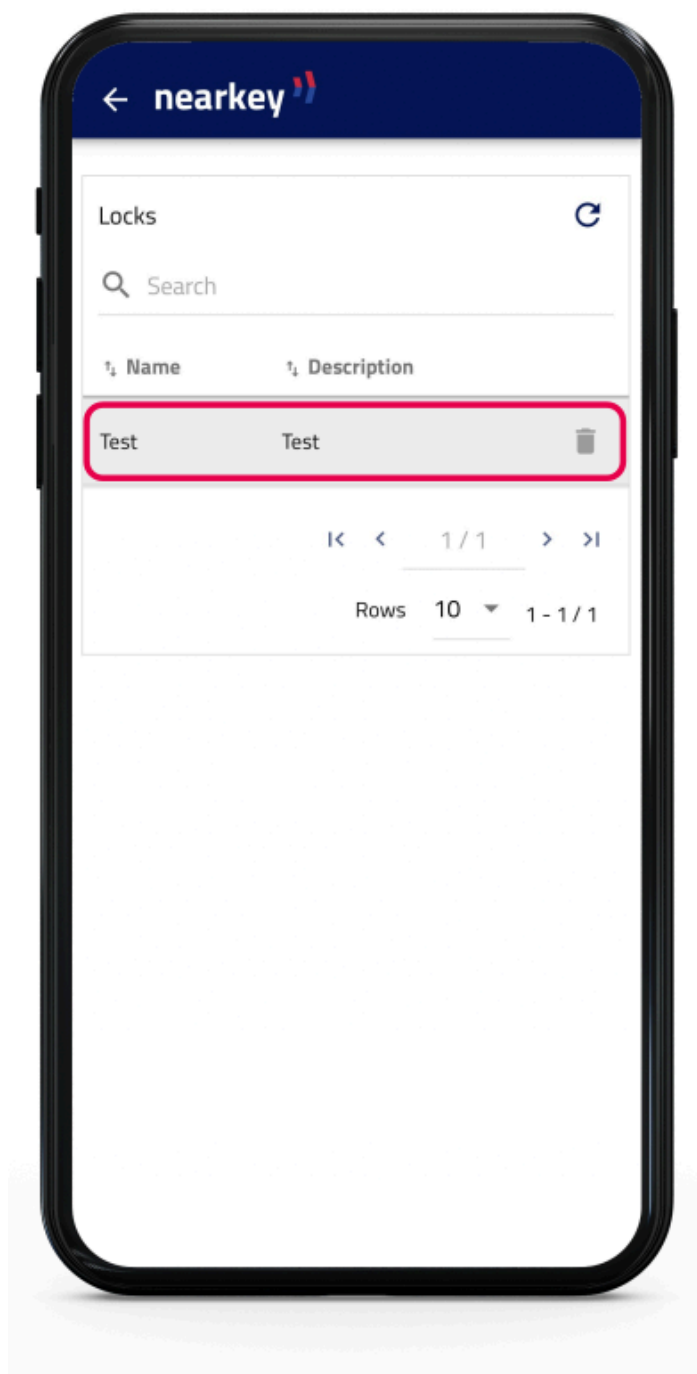


- Select the lock in which you want to add users

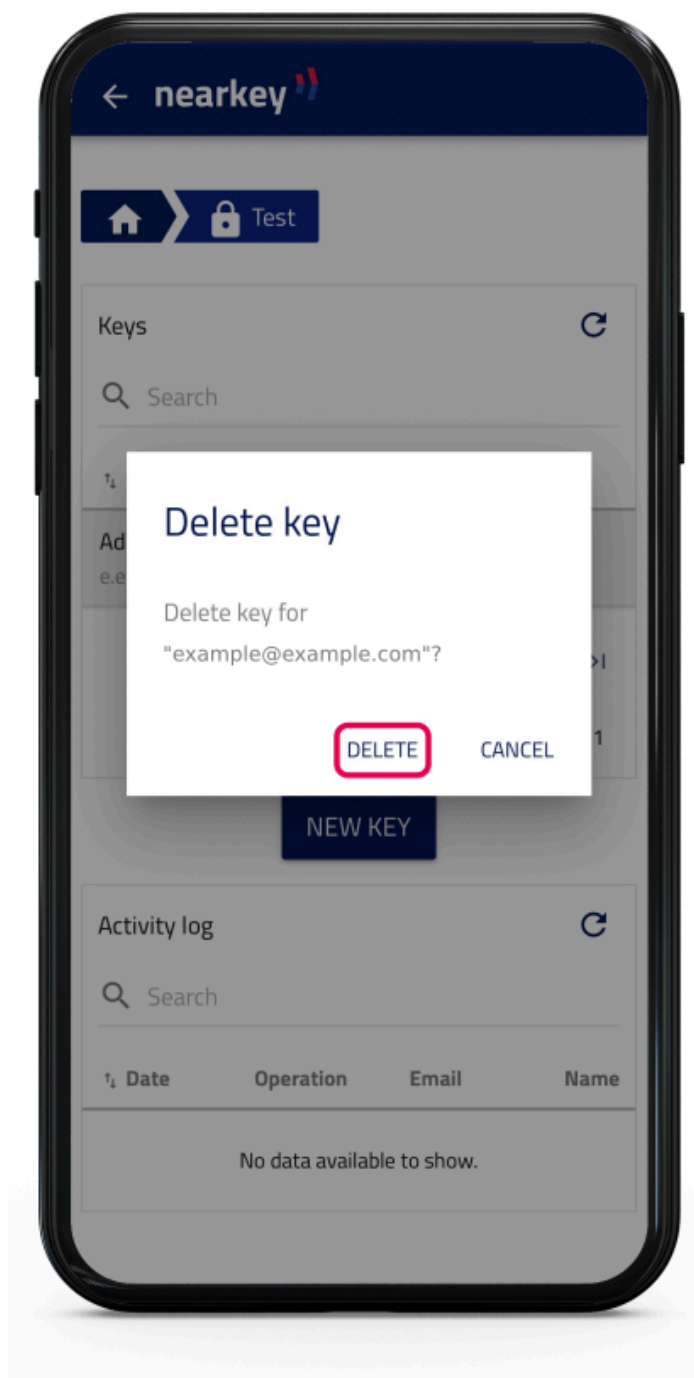
- Select the lock in which you want to delete users.

- Confirm the operation.

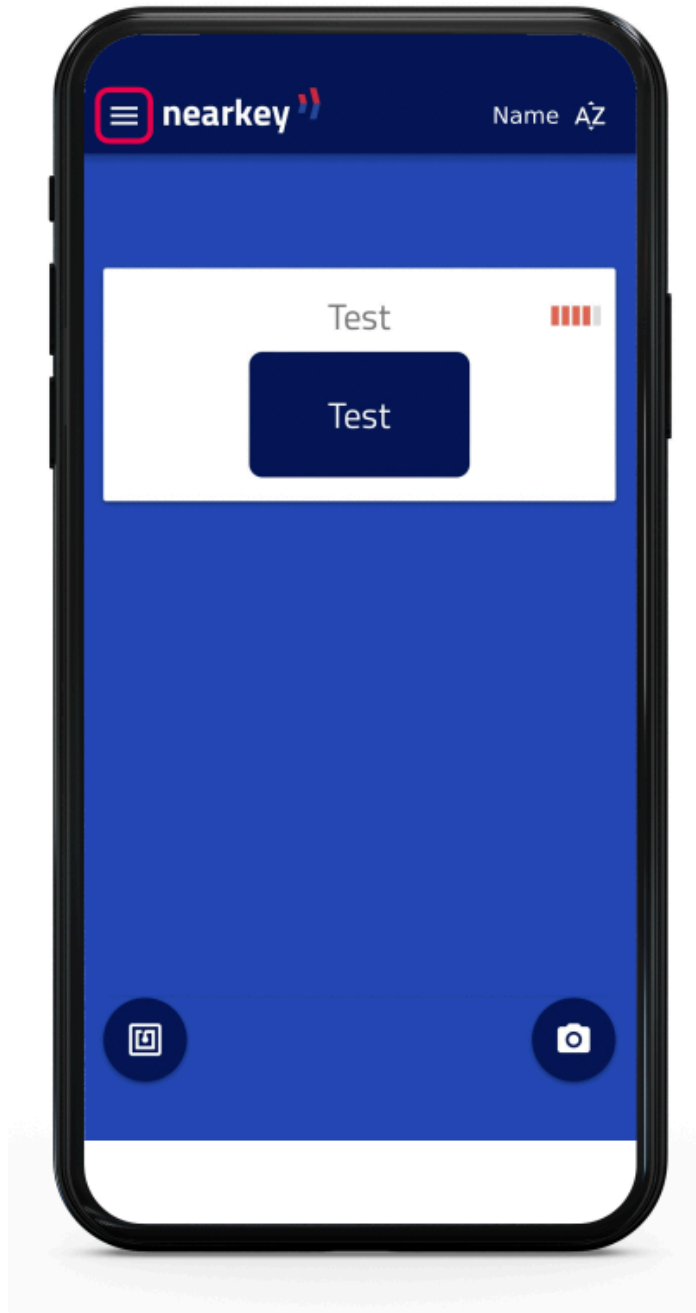

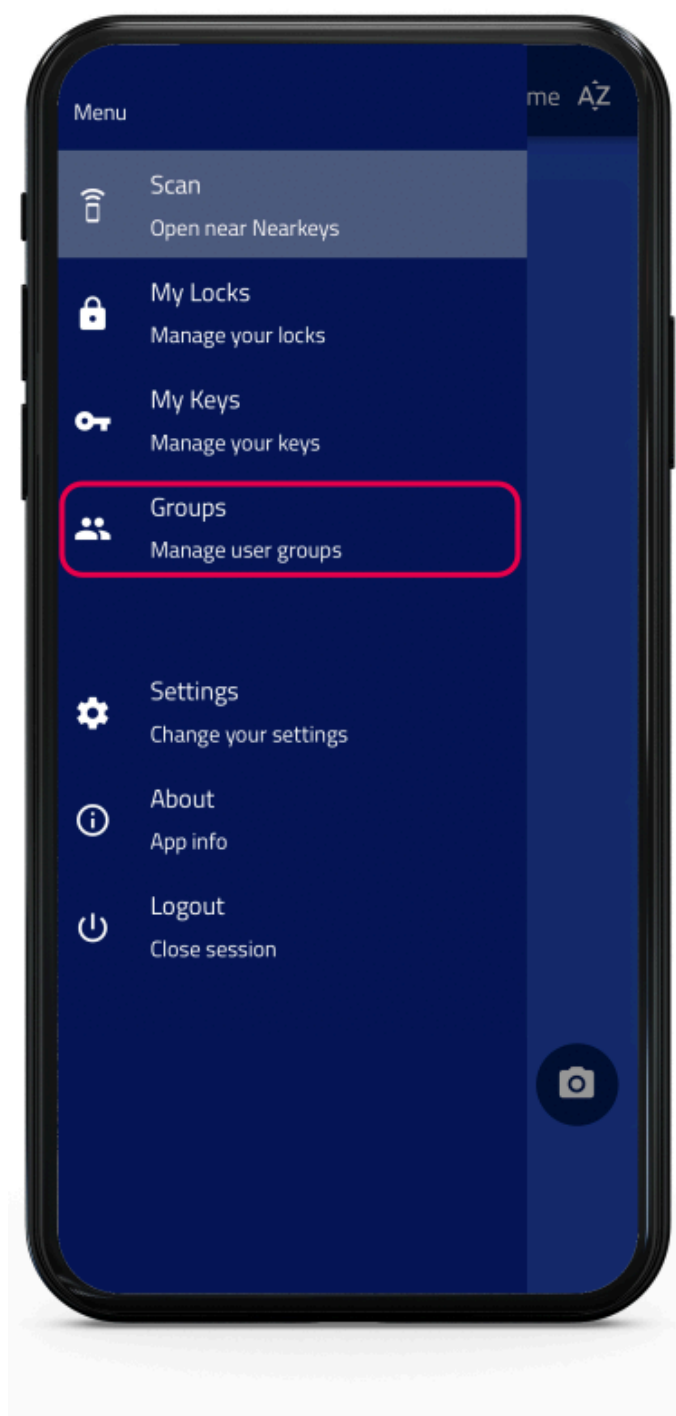
4.3.3. Create groups

The creation of groups is used to bring together users with common characteristics. To create a group, please read the following steps:

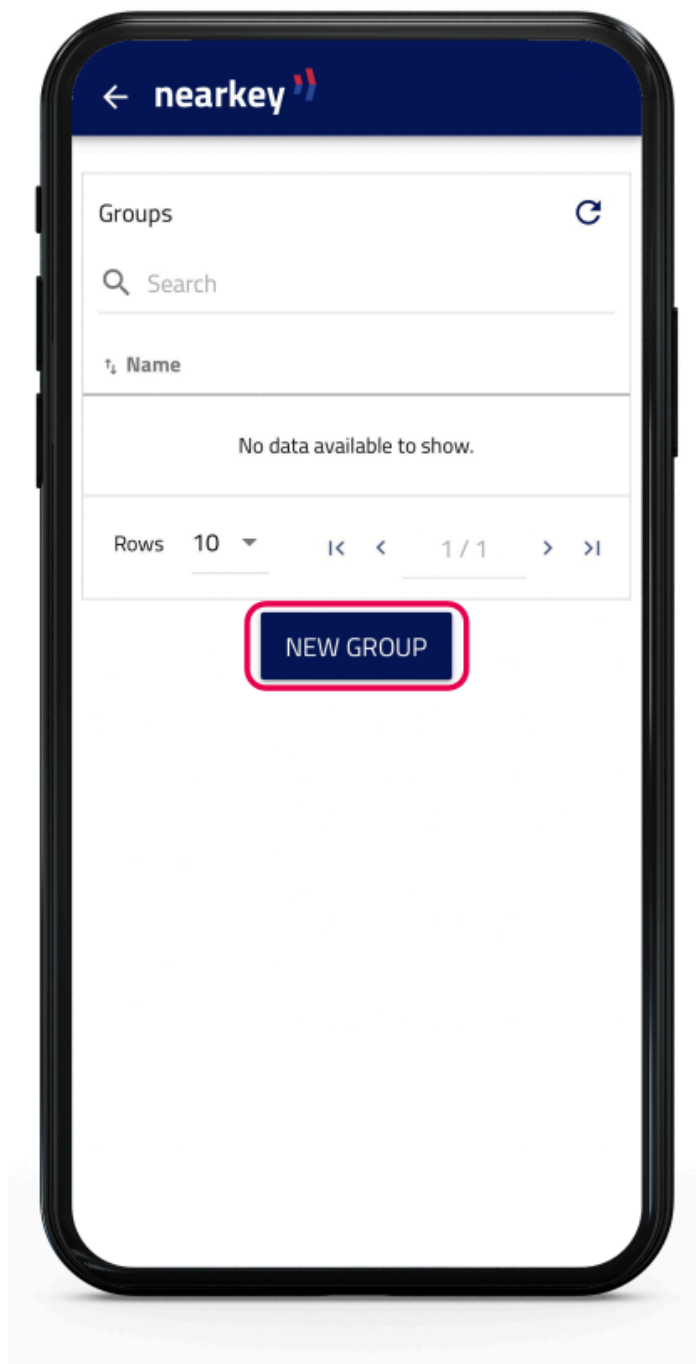
- From the application or from the web in the `Admin area` section.



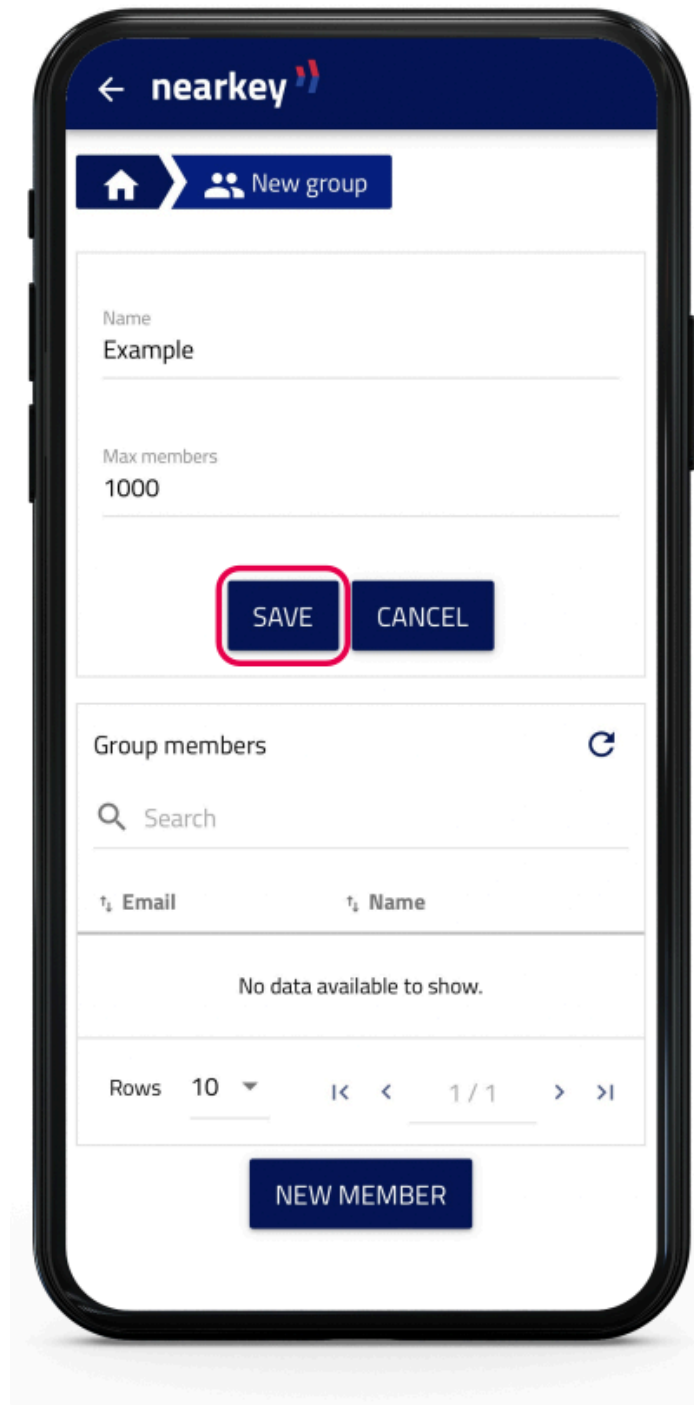
- Access to `Groups` section of the menu

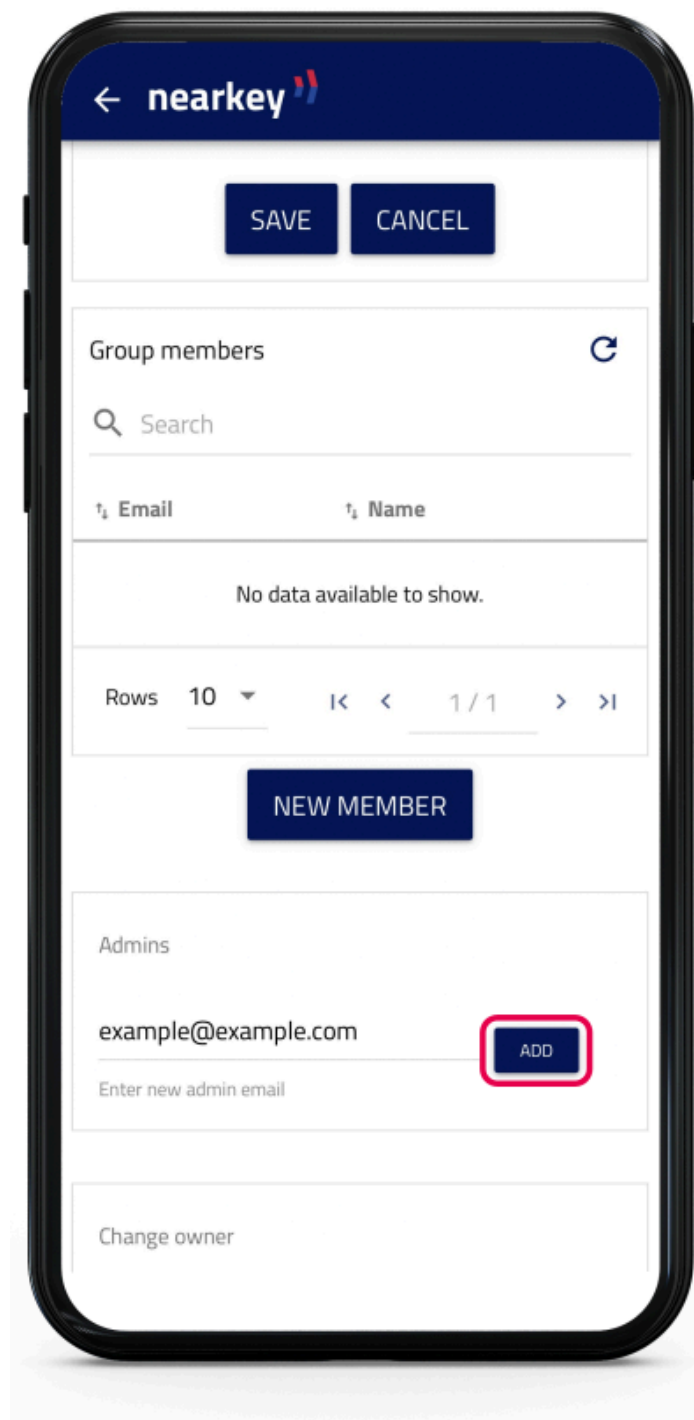

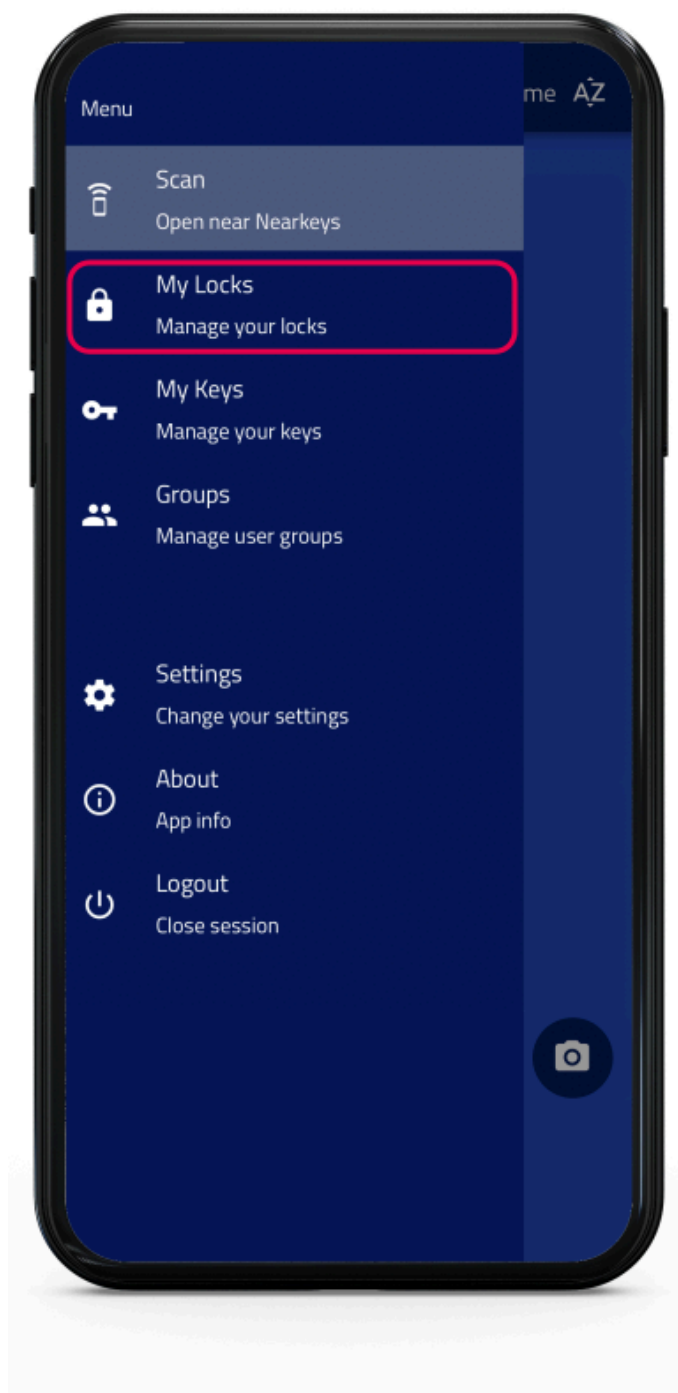
- If you need to add other group administrators, enter the e-mail of the new administrator in the Administrators section and press the Add button. The administrator must be a member of the group.



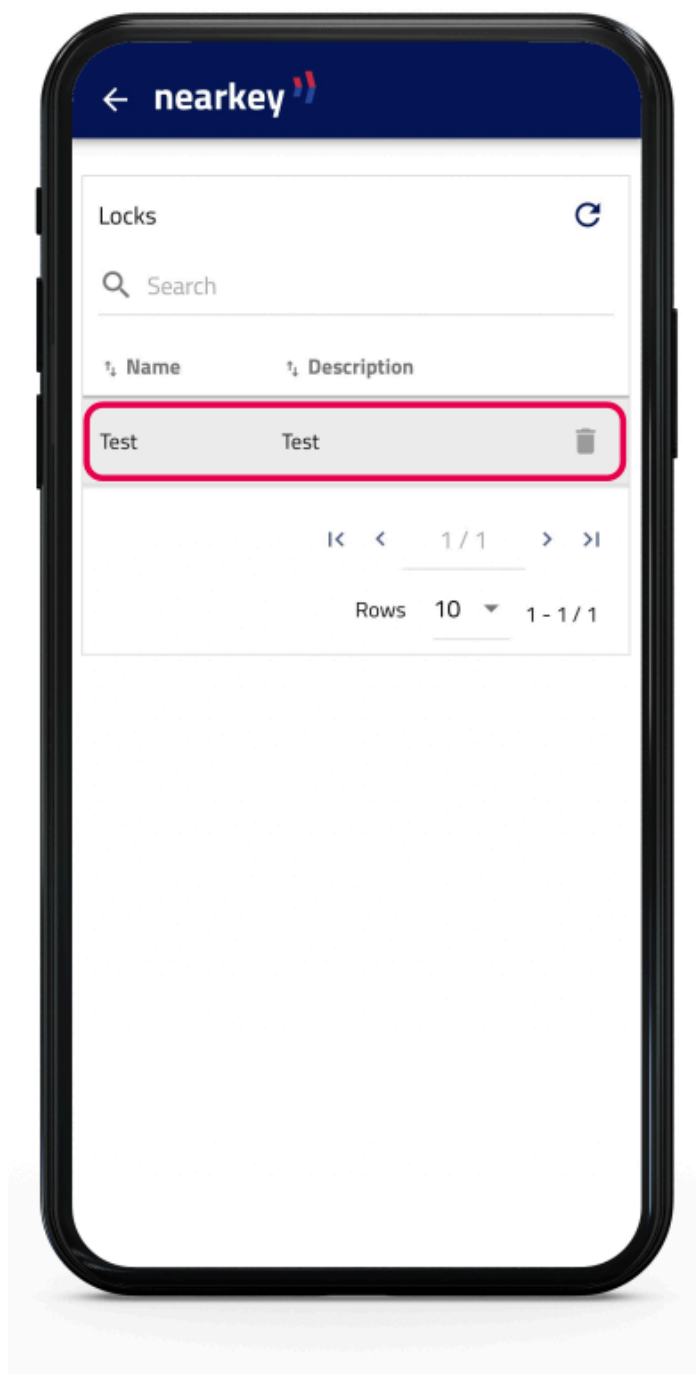

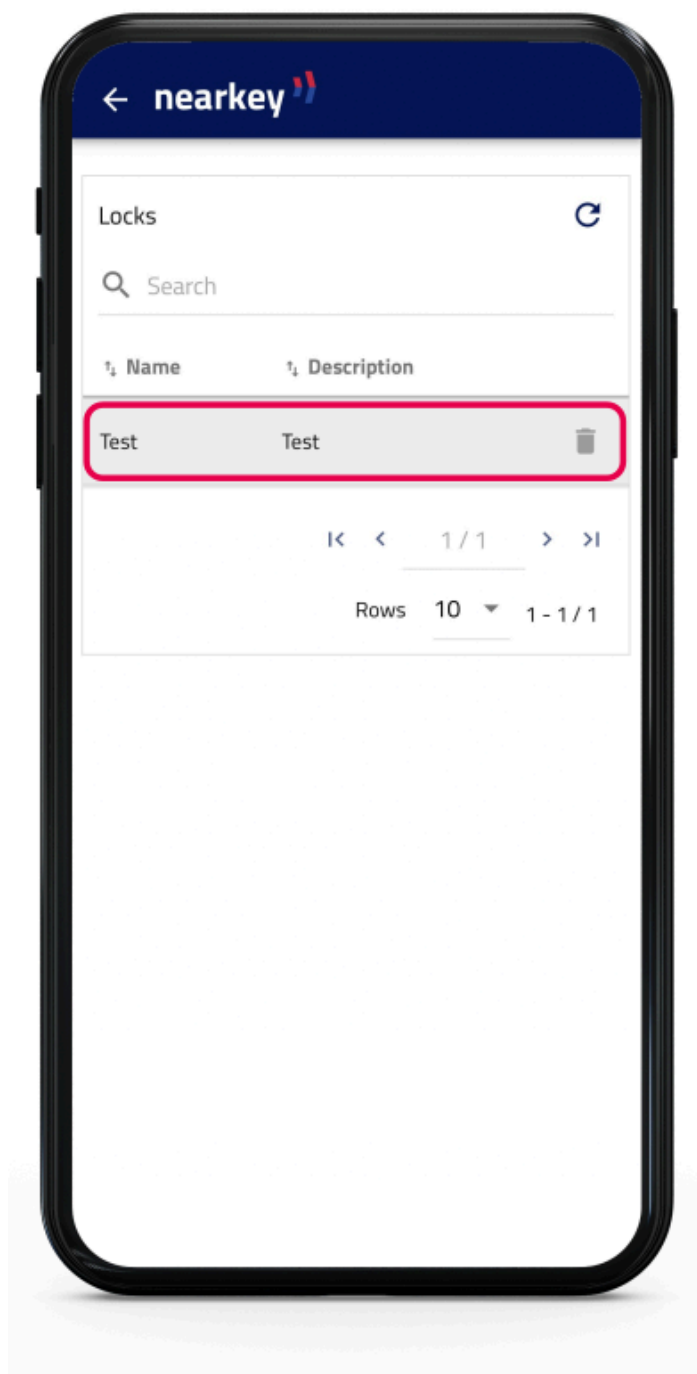

Some of the options listed below are only modifiable by owners, in which case they will be specified in parentheses.

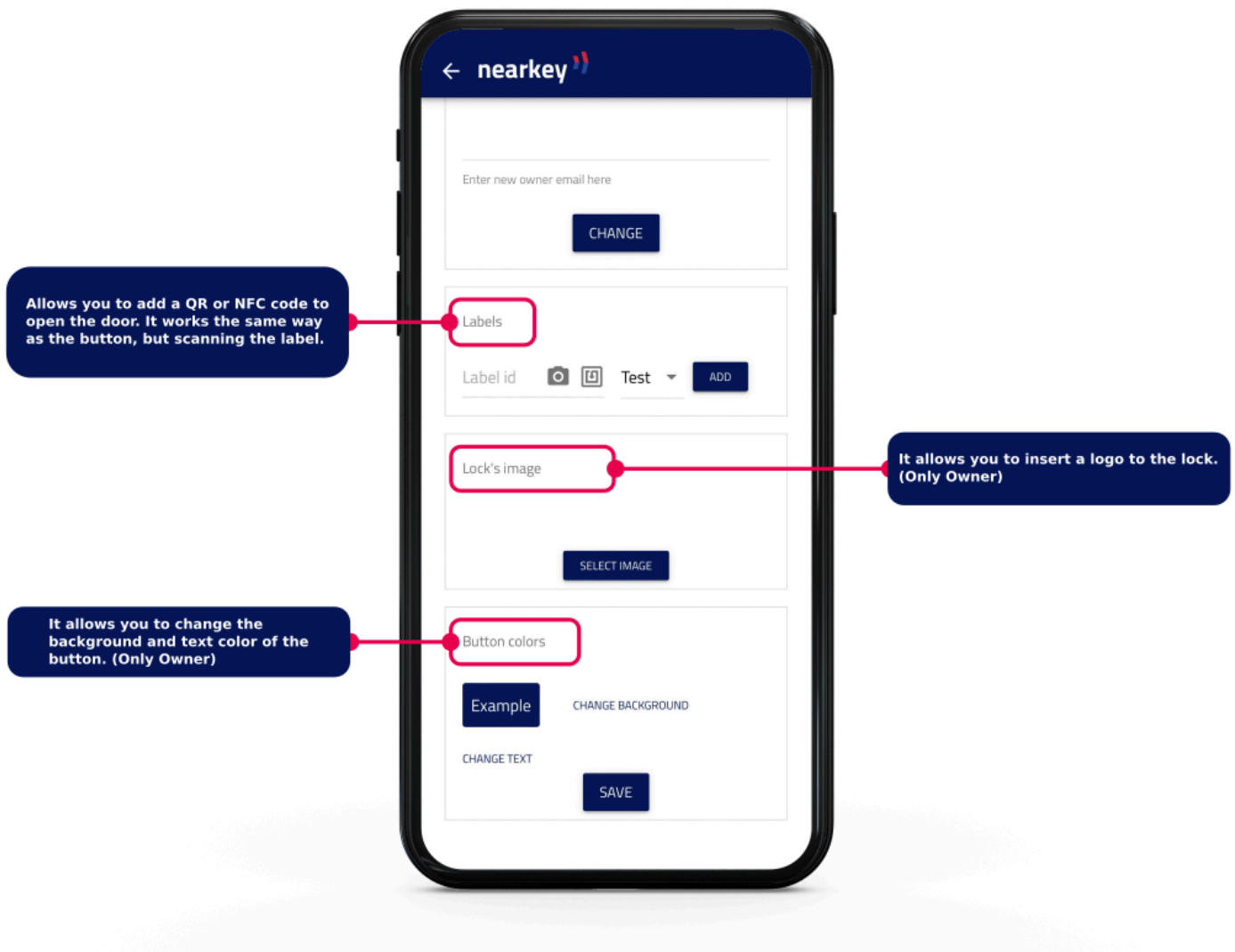
The following options will be displayed:





Once the change has been made, the previous owner will still have access. This user can be deleted from the lock, please read section [4.3.2. Delete users](#).

The user to whom the property has been transferred will become owner without access permission. In case you need to access the installation you must create a key for yourself.



To add a QR tag:

1. Create a QR code with the following format: <https://api.nearkey.io/a/shot?label=open>. Make sure there are no spaces between letters. The word `open` can be modified to other.
2. The name that has been chosen after the `=`, in this case `open`, is the one that will be added in the labels section.

To add an NFC tag:

1. Purchase a label, card, or similar NFC compatible with smartphone readers. (e.g.: NTag 213)
2. Download a mobile APP that allows you to record NFC tags, NFC tools mobile APP, or similar.
3. Save on the label: <https://api.nearkey.io/a/shot?label=open>. Make sure there are no spaces between letters. The word `open` can be modified to other.

4. The name that has been chosen after the =, in this case `open`, is the one that will be added in the labels section.

4.4. Users

Once access permissions are granted to users, if they are already registered in Nearkey and have the APP, they will be able to access the installation. If they are new users, they will have to download the APP to be able to access the installation. This can be done in two ways:

- Searching Nearkey in the APP Store or Google Play as indicated in section [4.7. Nearkey APP](#).
- Clicking on the download link they will receive in the email that new Nearkey users will receive when an owner or administrator give them access.

First steps for new users:

1. Download the Nearkey APP available in APP store and Google Play.
2. Open the APP and introduce the email in which we the permission or in which we are going to be register.
3. Nearkey will send an email to the address you entered to verify the identity of the user.



Please check the email inbox and spam.

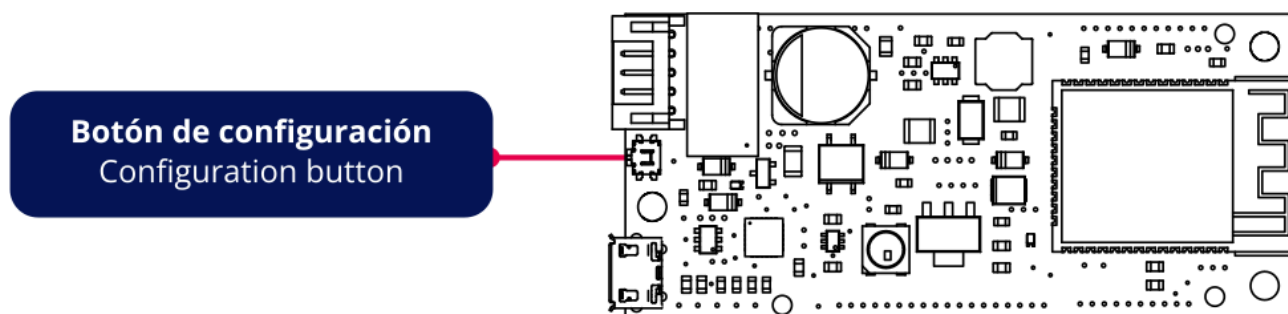
4. Press the `enter` button that will appear in the email, it will redirect you to the Nearkey APP.

4.5. Nearkey reset

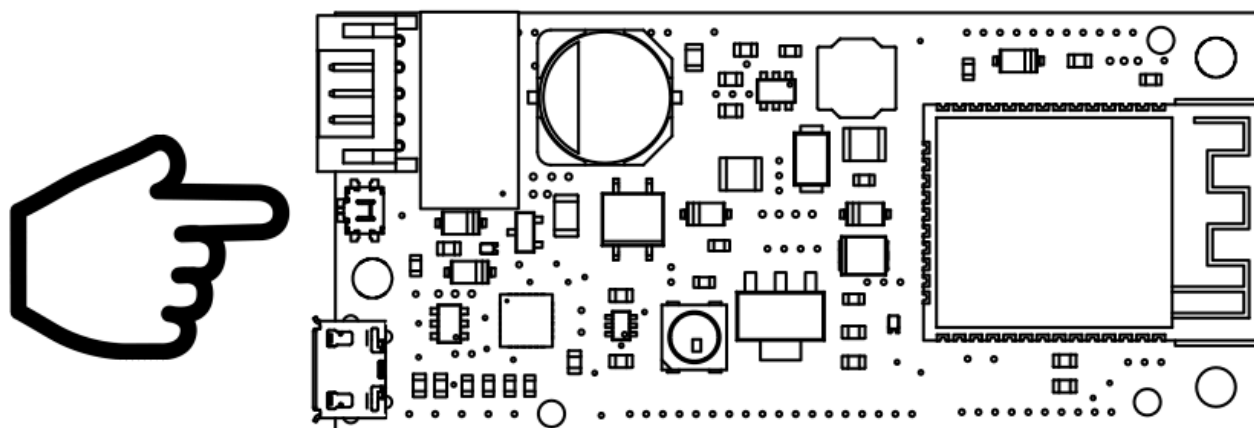
The reset of the device is used to restore Nearkey to factory settings, it removes the configuration of the device including the owner, administrators and users of that lock. From the time of restart, the lock must be reconfigured.

To restart the device we should:

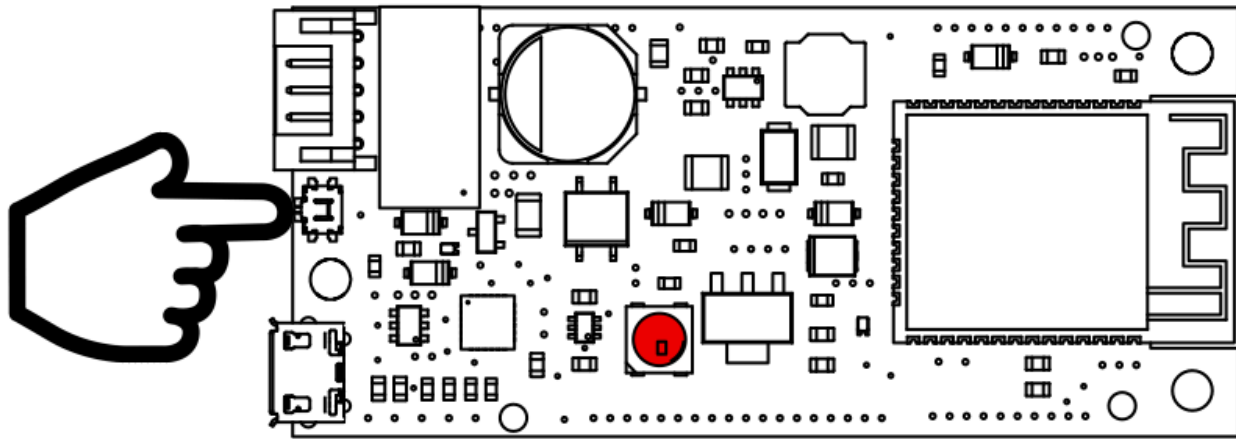
1. Identify the configuration button.



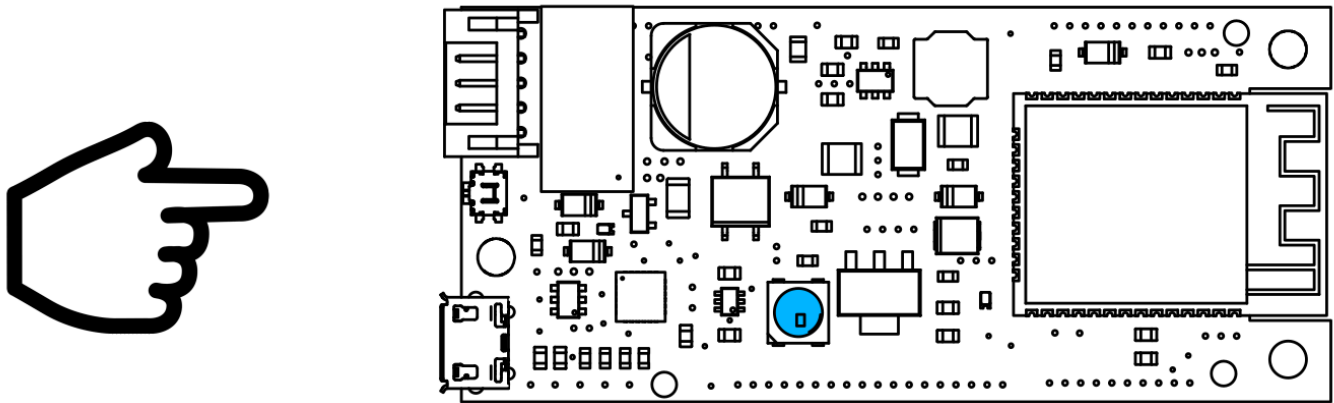
2. Press the button with the finger or an element that cannot damage the device.



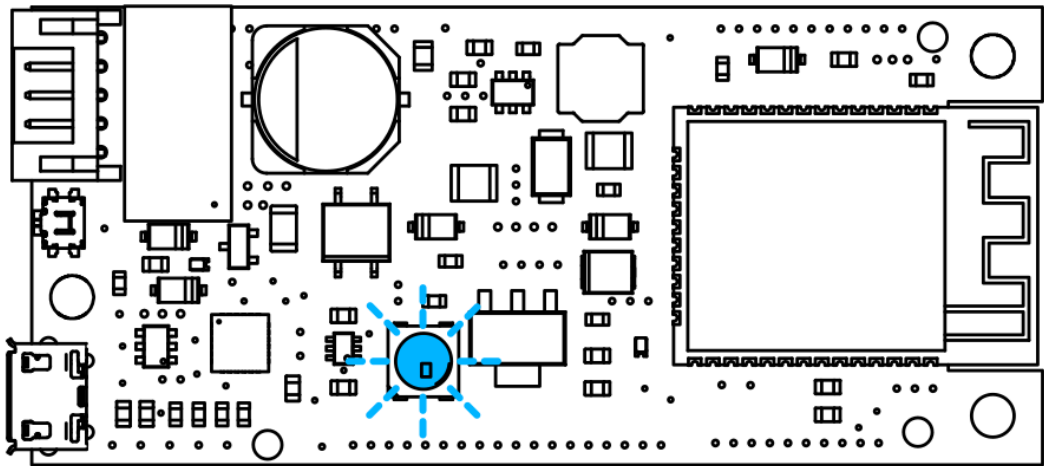
3. Press and hold the button for approximately 3 seconds.



4. The configuration LED will emit a red light, when this light goes out and the LED turns blue, stop pressing the button.



5. If the operation has been correct, the configuration LED will start flashing with blue light, if this light does not appear, please repeat the process.



4.6. Interaction with Nearkey

The interaction with Nearkey is made through short-range wireless technology. Therefore, we must place ourselves at a distance between 5 and 10 meters of the place where is Nearkey installed. If we have the access permission and we are close to the device, the APP will show a lock like the following one:



At the top of the lock we can observe two things:



It indicates the proximity of our smartphone to the device, with a minimum of one bar and a maximum of five.

It indicates the connection to the lock, if we did not pressed the button it will be displayed in red. If we interact with the lock the icon colour will change to green.

4.7. Nearkey APP

To configure and use your device, download the Nearkey app from the APP Store or Google Play. It can also be done through the following QR codes:

4.8. Basic setup

As to setup Nearkey, place yourself close to the device. If you are already a Nearkey user, open the APP and read from to point [4. Product configuration](#).

1. Open the app and accept the location permissions required by Nearkey.
2. Introduce the email in which you have access permission at the time of configuration.
3. Nearkey will send an email to the address entered to verify the user's identity.

 Check the email inbox and spam.

4. Press the enter button that will appear in the email, it will redirect you to the Nearkey application.
5. Activate the wireless connection required by the app.
6. Press the configuration button that will show the application. If the Nearkey app does not display any devices, make sure of the following:
 - You are at a distance where between 5 and 10 meters of the place where is Nearkey installed.
 - Nearkey has not been configured previously and you do not have access permissions, in this case the green power LED will be on. Consider reading section [4.5. Reset the device](#).
 - Nearkey has power, if the green power led is not lit, we recommend to read section [3. Installation and star-up](#).
7. Introduce a name that allows the logical association to the facilities.
8. Specify the time zone where the device will be installed.
9. Specify a name for `Actuator 1`, this will appear in the app button.
10. Modify the characteristics of `Actuator 1` depending on the needs of the door. You can choose between the following modes:
 - **Pulse**, punctual activation of the relay, is the most common option of activation (door motors, automatic entryphones, gates or electronic buttons among others). When the app button is pressed, the relay will go from the NC position to NO for the seconds specified in the `Duration` section.
 - **Switch**, static on/off mode. When the app button is pressed, the relay will change from the NC position to NO permanently until the button is pressed again.

11. Check the functioning of Nearkey.

- If pressing the app button it generates a drive in the installation (the door opens, the key is activated, etc.), the configuration has been carried out correctly.
- If pressing the app button it does not produce a drive, check the installation cables, please read section [3. Installation and start-up](#) and compare it with the user manual of your installation.

The installation and basic configuration of Nearkey will be complete. This configuration can later be modified from My Locks/Advanced Configuration.

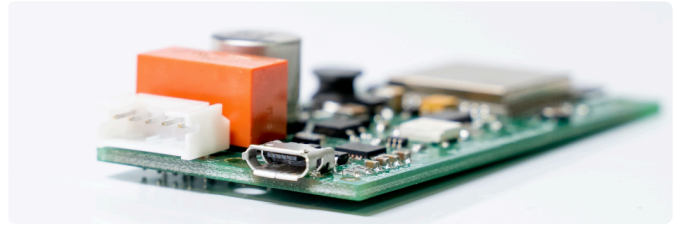

5.1. Nearkey

nearkey™



Nearkey is an access control device mainly used to **activate electric doors, buttons and elevators keypad** using the Smartphone and the Bluetooth technology. It substitutes keys and physical remotes for virtual ones.

5.2. First steps for new users

1. Once you have been registered for the first time in an installation that requires Nearkey for access, a welcome email will be sent from the address **no-reply@nearkey.io** with the links to download the APP.

You can also download Nearkey in the APP Store and Google Play Store, looking for Nearkey or through the following QR codes and links:

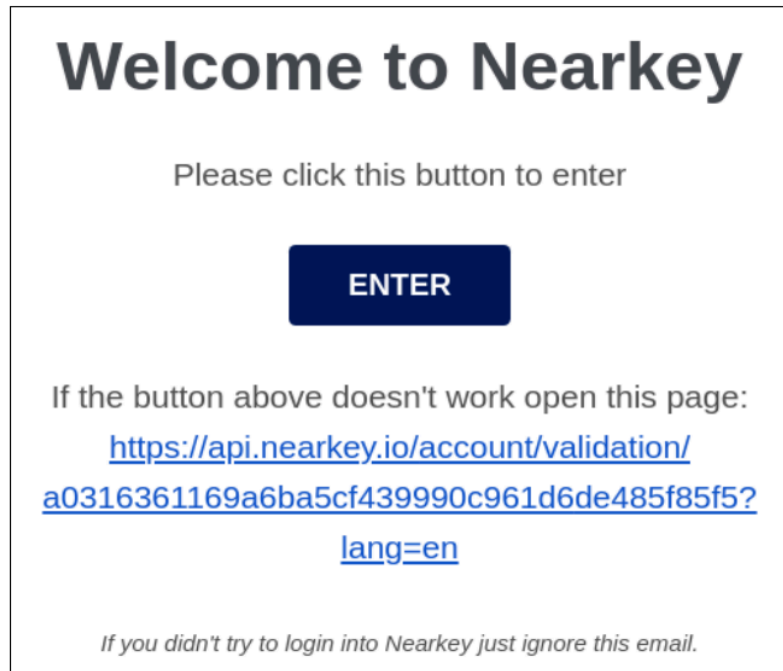

2. Open the APP and introduce the email in which you have access permission.
3. Nearkey will send a verification email to the address introduced.

 Check the inbox and spam.

A verification email will arrive from the address **no-reply@nearkey.io** as the following:



4. Press the `Enter` button which will appear in the email, this will redirect you to the Nearkey APP.
5. Activate the Bluetooth connection.
6. Place yourself at a distance where the Bluetooth of your Smartphone can detect the Nearkey device of your facilities. If you have the necessary permissions and you are close to the device, the APP will show one or more locks such as the following:



7. Press the button and access.

If nothing of the above appears, check that you are close to the device and that you have access to the lock. It can be checked in the section of the menu **My Keys** menu section. Otherwise, contact the person in charge of Nearkey in your facilities.

5.3. Usual Nearkey users

When registering in a new facility, if the email which we have been registered is the same as the one that we have registered in Nearkey, we should only place ourselves close to the door or keypad and press the button of the APP.

To check that the access email matches with the one that we have registered in Nearkey, go to the section *Settings of the menu*. In this section, the email with which we have started the session is displayed.
