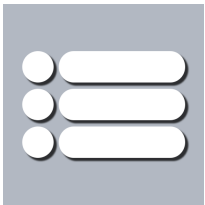

Below is a list of commonly used IPS buttons and their actions.

Activity Menu



The Activity Menu button will open a list of resource's for the book you are viewing. These include a [media list](#) (which contains all audio and video files for the book), a [glossary](#), [flash cards](#), and [a link to launch the IPS Help page](#).

Back



Tap this button to return to the previous screen.

Connections



Connections will launch fun facts, photos, illustrations, maps and more. Keep an eye out for Connections, and be sure to tap the star to learn a little about the lesson.

Delete Recording



Tap the trash icon to delete a recording you no longer wish to keep saved.

Email



Tap the email icon to [email your recording](#).

Flash Cards



[Flash Cards](#) are a set of cards with musical terms and definitions found throughout your book. Many of these terms and definitions are from the book's [Glossary](#).

Glossary



The [Glossary](#) contains a list of musical terms and symbols used throughout the book.

Help



Help will get you here! Tap the help button to view the [IPS App Help page](#).

Kjos Store



The store button will open a catalog of Kjos books you may purchase for the Interactive Practice Studio.

Kjos Home



Tap the Kjos Home button to visit the [Kjos website](#). The Kjos website will open in your browser.

Log Out



Log out will sign you out of the Interactive Practice Studio. Once logged out, you will need to log in again to view any saved work.

Loop



LOOP

Loop will play the audio again once the audio has finished, and will continue to play until you tell it to stop. You can disable loop by tapping the Loop button.

Media List



The [Media List](#) contains all video and audio for the selected book. You can play any audio or video by selecting it from the Media List.

Main Menu



The [Main Menu](#) button contains the main menu for the Interactive Practice Studio. From here, you can view your [book list](#) and [recordings](#), change [settings](#) for IPS, visit the [Kjos website](#), visit the [Help page](#), and log out of IPS.

My Recordings



[Access your saved recordings](#) for playback and sharing.

My Settings



In [My Settings](#) you will find options for editing your name, display language, and clearing your device's cache.

PDF



Tap to launch a PDF file, such as a quiz.

Personal Studio



[Create recordings](#) of yourself playing that you can save and email to friends, family, and your teacher.

Practice Tracks



Tap to [hear each line of music](#) in your book performed. Most tracks will include two mixes. On the first mix, you'll hear the student part with the accompaniment. On the second mix of each track, you'll hear the accompaniment only. Playing along with this mix allows you to perform as a true soloist!

Playback Speed



Playback has 3 speed settings: normal, slower, and slowest. Tap the playback speed button to slow down the tempo.

Save Recording



Once you have recorded yourself playing, you can tap [Save Recording](#) button to save your recording.

Student Part

The Student Part button enables the student's part to be played during audio playback. When Student Part is disabled, playback will only play the accompaniment.

Video Lessons




Tap to watch various lessons covering topics such as playing tips and instrument maintenance.

Logging In

When you open the Interactive Practice Studio, you will be prompted to log in to view your book(s).

New User

When using IPS for the first time, you'll need to create a log in. Select **Add your name here...** from the menu. The following screen will appear:



Login Name is your login or username. This can be whatever you wish.


First Name should be your first name.

Last Name should be your last name.

Once you have entered your information in all fields, press **Save**. You will then return to the Log In screen. At this point, you can select your **Login Name** from the menu, then press **Enter** to begin.

Existing User

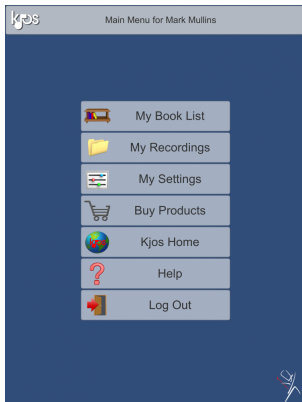
To log in as an existing user, select your **Login Name** from the menu, then press  to begin.

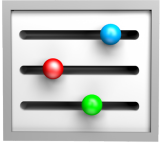

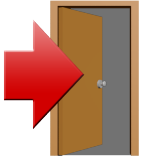

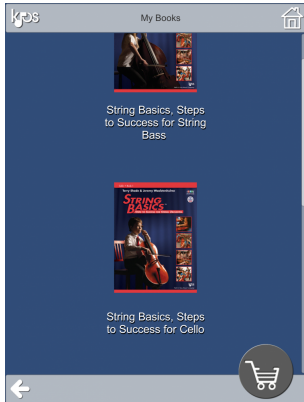
Log Out

Open a Book

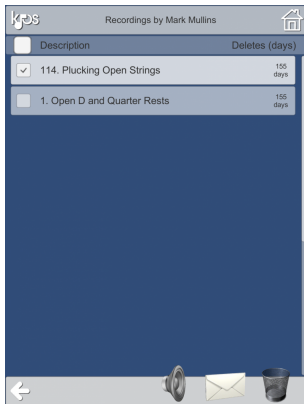
Tap any book in your book list to open the book and view its content.


Get More Books

Books are added to IPS by purchasing a book through the Kjos Store. Tap the  button to visit the store.


My Recordings

My Recordings shows a list of all currently saved recordings on your device.




You can access My Recordings at any time by tapping the  button in the [Main Menu](#).

Listen to a Recording

To listen to one of your recordings, select the recording to listen to by tapping the recording in the list, then tap the  button.

Email a Recording

To email a recording, select the recording by tapping the recording in the list, then tap the  button. See [Email Recording](#) for more information.



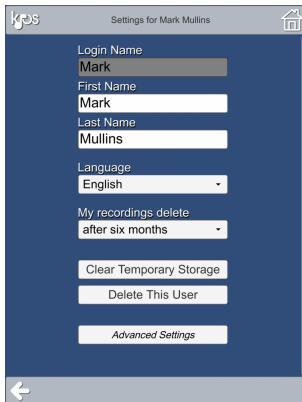
Due to the recording's file size, recordings must be emailed one at a time.


Delete a Recording

To delete a recording, select the recording by tapping the recording in the list, then tap the  button.

My Settings

In [My Settings](#) you will find options for editing your name, display language, and clearing your device's cache.



You can access My Settings at any time by tapping the  button in the [Main Menu](#).

Edit Your Name

To change your first or last name in IPS, tap in the appropriate text box, and replace the name with your changes.

Clear Temporary Storage

Clear Temporary Storage will delete any downloaded IPS media and data (such as audio, videos, images, etc.) from your device. This is helpful if you would like to free up space on your device.

✿ Clearing your temporary storage will NOT delete any recordings you have saved.

Delete This User

Selecting Delete This User will delete your user login, your profile, and all recordings you have saved.

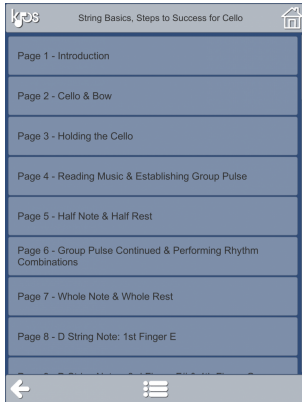
Advanced Settings

The settings found in the Advanced Settings screen are to account for hardware that doesn't perform at your expected level. For example, if you find that your device appears to be "lagging" during playback or recording, you may want to edit the recording latency.

If you are low on available free storage space on your device, you may want to reduce the cache size to accommodate.

Table of Contents

Much like a regular book, the Table of Contents shows every page available in the book you have open.



To view the Table of Contents, you must select a book from [My Book List](#).


View a Page


Tap any page in the Table of Contents to view that particular page in IPS.

Main Menu


While viewing the Table of Contents, you can tap the  button in the upper right corner to return to the [Main Menu](#).

Activity Menu

The  opens the book's [Activity Menu](#).

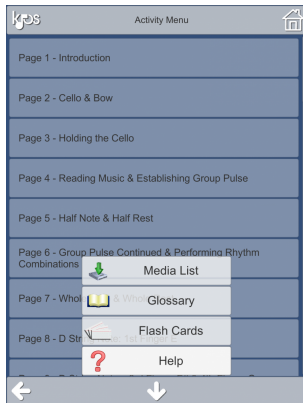
Tap  to hide the Activity Menu.


Return to Book List

To get back to your list of available books, tap the  button.

Activity Menu

The Activity Menu button will open a list of resource's for the book you are viewing. These include a [media list](#) (which contains all audio and video files for the book), a [glossary](#), [flash cards](#), and [a link to launch the IPS Help page](#).



The Activity Menu can only be opened while viewing a book's [Table of Contents](#). To view the Activity Menu, tap the  button. Below are a list of options you'll find in a book's Activity Menu.

Media List

The [Media List](#) contains all video and audio for the selected book. You can play any audio or video by selecting it from the Media List.

Glossary

The [Glossary](#) contains a list of musical terms and symbols used throughout the book.

Flash Cards

Help

Help will get you here! Tap the help button to view the [IPS App Help page](#).

Play Exercise


Hear each exercise in your book performed by professionals, with an accompaniment specifically composed for that piece! Most tracks will include two mixes. On the first mix, you'll hear the student part with the accompaniment. On the second mix of each track, you'll hear the accompaniment only. Playing along with this mix allows you to perform as a true soloist!



Tap the  button whenever it's available to listen to that particular lesson. Lessons can be accessed by selecting a page in the [Table of Contents](#), or by selecting the track directly from the [Media List](#).

You can tap the  button to return to the book's Table of Contents.


Play

Tap  to listen to the exercise.


Stop


Tapping  will stop the audio playback.

Record



To record yourself playing the exercise, tap the  button. This enables the [Record Exercise](#) portion of IPS.

Loop

 will play the audio again once the audio has finished, and will continue to play until you tell it to stop.

You can disable loop by tapping the  button.

Student Part

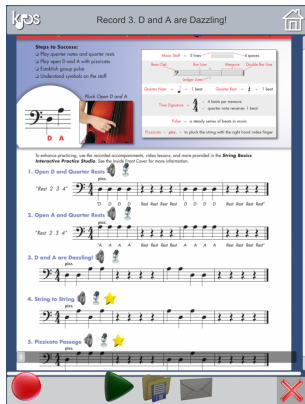
Tapping the  button enables the student's part to be played during audio playback. When you see , playback will only play the accompaniment.



Playback Speed

Playback has 3 speed settings: , , and . Tap the playback speed button to cycle between tempos.

Record Exercise


Create recordings of yourself playing that you can save and email to friends, family, and your teacher.





To record yourself playing a lesson, tap the  button on the lesson page. This will take you to the Record Exercise portion of IPS. In Record Exercise, tap  to begin recording.

Record

Tap  to begin recording yourself playing the lesson.

 If you would like to rerecord yourself playing, you can stop your current recording, then press  again to start over. You can rerecord as many times as you would like before saving your recording.

Stop

To stop recording or playback of a recording, tap the  button.

Play Recording

To listen to your recording, tap . The  button is disabled until you make a recording.


Accompaniment Volume

The Accompaniment slider adjusts the volume of the accompaniment when played. Move the slider all the way to the right for max volume, or all the way left to silence the accompaniment.


My Recording Volume

The My Recording slider adjusts the volume of your recording when played. Move the slider all the way to the right for max volume, or all the way left to silence your recording.


Save Recording



Once you're satisfied with your recording, you can save the recording by tapping . See [Save Recording](#) for more details.

Email Recording

Tapping  will allow you to share your recording via email. See [Email Recording](#) for more details.


Save Recording

Once you're satisfied with your recording, you can save the recording by tapping .

To record yourself playing a lesson, tap the  button on the lesson page. This will take you to the [Record Exercise](#) portion of IPS. In Record Exercise, tap  to begin recording.


* Lessons can be accessed by selecting a page in the [Table of Contents](#), or by selecting the audio track directly from the [Media List](#).


When the save button is pressed, IPS will begin mixing your recording. This process includes saving the recording with the volume that you set for both [Accompaniment](#) and [My Recording](#) sliders, so be sure to adjust the volume levels to your liking before saving the recording!

* You can rerecord as many times as you like before saving your recording. Just press  again to rerecord.

Once a recording is saved, you can still rerecord the recording. If you attempt to save over an existing recording, you will be asked if you would like to overwrite the existing recording. **Yes** will overwrite your existing recording, while **No** will discard your newest recording and keep your previous save.

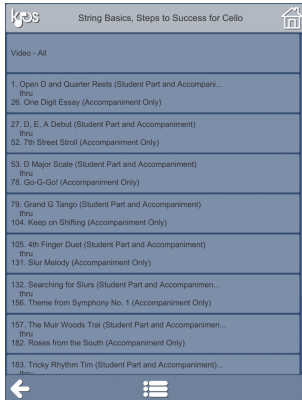
Email Recording

Once you have [saved your recording](#), you can email the recording to teachers, friends and family by tapping the  button. Recordings can be emailed from both [Record Exercise](#) and [My Recordings](#).



After tapping the  button, a menu will appear at the bottom of your screen. Tap the **Mail** icon to launch your email app and create a new email. Be sure to enter the email address you are sending the the recording to, as well as any message in the body of the email. Tap **send** whenever it's ready to mail!

Media List

The Media List contains all video and audio for the selected book. You can play any audio or video by selecting it from the Media List.




To open the Media List, select the [Activity Menu](#) from a book's [Table of Contents](#).

The menu at the top of the Media List contains all  (Video Lessons) and  (Practice Tracks) files. To play a lesson, tap the lesson in the Media List. If the lesson is a video, the video will begin to play once it has loaded. If the lesson is an audio file, the [Play Exercise](#) portion of IPS will load.

The Glossary contains a list of musical terms and symbols used throughout the book.

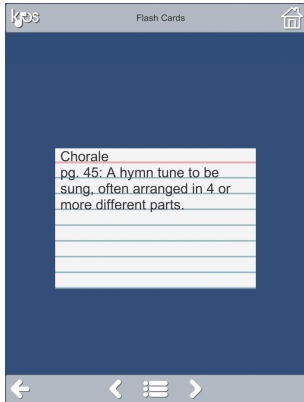



String Basics, Steps to Success for Cello	
1st & 2nd Ending	pg. 35: Play the 1st ending the first time through. Repeat the same music. Skip the 1st ending and play the 2nd ending.
Accent	pg. 44: To place a special emphasis on a note.
Allegro	pg. 43: (Italian) A fast and lively speed.
Andante	pg. 43: (Italian) term meaning a moderately slow, walking speed.
Arco	pg. 14: (Italian) Play with the bow.
Bar Line	pg. 4: A vertical line dividing the staff into measures.
Beat	pg. 4: A steady, regular pulse in music.
Bow Lift	pg. 16: Lift the bow and set it back towards the frog.

Viewing Flash Cards

When first viewing a flash card, the musical term will display. Tap on the card to see the definition of the musical term. Tap the  button to cycle to the next flash card.
